hither that I <u>10\_2SA\_14\_32</u> # And Absalom answered Joab, Behold, I sent unto thee, saying, Come hither, that I may send thee to the king, to say, Wherefore am I come from Geshur? whit and hid <u>09\_18A\_03\_18</u> # And Samuel told him every whit, and hid nothing from him. And he said, It [is] the LORD: let him do what seemeth him good.

whit behind the 47\_2CO\_11\_05 # For I suppose I was not a whit behind the very chiefest apostles.

whit whole on 43 JOH 07 23 # If a man on the sabbath day receive circumcision, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are ye angry at me, because I have made a man every whit whole on the sabbath day?

white already to 43\_JOH\_04\_35 # Say not ye, There are yet four months, and [then] cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.

white and black <u>17\_EST\_01\_06</u># [Where were] white, green, and blue, [hangings], fastened with cords of fine linen and purple to silver rings and pillars of marble: the beds [were of] gold and silver, upon a pavement of red, and blue, and white, and black, marble.

whither thou goest <u>43\_JOH\_14\_05</u> # Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?

whither thou goest <u>08\_RUT\_01\_16</u> # And Ruth said, Entreat me not to leave thee, [or] to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people [shall

be] my people, and thy God my God:

whithersoever I go 46\_1CO\_16\_06 # And it may be that I will abide, yea, and winter with you, that ye may bring me on my journey whithersoever I go.

whithersoever it turneth <u>20 PRO 17 08 # A gift [is as]</u> a precious stone in the eyes of him that hath it: whithersoever it turneth, it prospereth.

whithersoever Saul sent <u>09\_1SA\_18\_05</u># And David went out whithersoever Saul sent him, [and] behaved himself wisely: and Saul set him over the men of war, and he was accepted in the sight of all the people, and also in the sight of Saul's servants.

whithersoever the governor <u>59\_JAM\_03\_04</u># Behold also the ships, which though [they be] so great, and [are] driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth.

Zarhites man by <u>06\_JOS\_07\_17</u># And he brought the family of Judah; and he took the family of the Zarhites: and he brought the family of the Zarhites man by man; and Zabdi was taken:

Zarhites of Shaul <u>04\_NUM\_26\_13</u># Of Zerah, the family of the Zarhites: of Shaul, the family of the Shaulites.

Zarhites <u>04\_NUM\_26\_20</u># And the sons of Judah after their families were; of Shelah, the family of the Shelanites: of Pharez, the family of the Pharzites: of Zerah, the family of the Zarhites.

Ziphites came unto <u>09\_1SA\_26\_01</u> # And the Ziphites came unto Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself in the hill of Hachilah, [which is] before Jeshimon?

Ziphites to Saul <u>09\_1SA\_23\_19</u># Then came up the Ziphites to Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself with us in strong holds in the wood, in the hill of Hachilah, which [is] on the south of Jeshimon?

Zorathites <u>13\_1CH\_04\_02</u> # And Reaiah the son of Shobal begat Jahath; and Jahath begat Ahumai, and Lahad. These [are] the families of the Zorathites.
