whither they go <u>05\_DEU\_31\_16</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Behold, thou shalt sleep with thy fathers; and this people will rise up, and go a whoring after the gods of the strangers of the land, whither they go [to be] among them, and will forsake me, and break my covenant which I have made with them.

whither they had 24 JER\_43 05 # But Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces, took all the remnant of Judah, that were returned from all nations, whither they had been driven, to dwell in the land of Judah;

whither they have 14 2CH 06 38 # If they return to thee with all their heart and with all their soul in the land of their captivity, whither they have carried them captives, and pray toward their land, which thou gavest unto their fathers, and [toward] the city which thou hast chosen, and toward the house which I have built for thy name:

whither they have 24\_JER\_22\_12 # But he shall die in the place whither they have led him captive, and shall see this land no more.

whither they shall 26 EZE 06 09 # And they that escape of you shall remember me among the nations whither they shall be carried captives, because I am broken with their whorish heart, which hath departed from me, and with their eyes, which go a whoring after their idols: and they shall loathe themselves for the evils which they have committed in all their abominations.

whither they went <u>10\_2SA\_17\_18</u> # Nevertheless a lad saw them, and told Absalom: but they went both of them away quickly, and came to a man's house in Bahurim, which had a well in his court; whither they went down.

whither they went <u>26\_EZE\_36\_20</u> # And when they entered unto the heathen, whither they went, they profaned my holy name, when they said to them, These [are] the people of the LORD, and are gone forth out of his land.

whither they went <u>26\_EZE\_36\_21</u># But I had pity for mine holy name, which the house of Israel had profaned among the heathen, whither they went.

whither they went 43\_JOH\_06\_21 # Then they willingly received him into the ship: and immediately the ship was at the land whither they went.

whither they went <u>42\_LUK\_24\_28</u> # And they drew nigh unto the village, whither they went: and he made as though he would have gone further.

whither they were <u>11\_1KI\_08\_47</u># [Yet] if they shall bethink themselves in the land whither they were carried captives, and repent, and make supplication unto thee in the land of them that carried them captives, saying, We have sinned, and have done perversely, we have committed wickedness;

whither they were <u>26\_EZE\_29\_13</u> # Yet thus saith the Lord GOD; At the end of forty years will I gather the Egyptians from the people whither they were scattered:

whither they were **24\_JER\_40\_12** # Even all the Jews returned out of all places whither they were driven, and came to the land of Judah, to Gedaliah, unto Mizpah, and gathered wine and summer fruits very much.

whither thou goest <u>05\_DEU\_07\_01</u> # When the LORD thy God shall bring thee into the land whither thou goest to possess it, and hath cast out many nations before thee, the Hittites, and the Girgashites, and the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than thou;

whither thou goest <u>05\_DEU\_11\_10</u># For the land, whither thou goest in to possess it, [is] not as the land of Egypt, from whence ye came out, where thou sowedst thy seed, and wateredst [it] with thy foot, as a garden of herbs:

whither thou goest <u>05\_DEU\_11\_29</u># And it shall come to pass, when the LORD thy God hath brought thee in unto the land whither thou goest to possess it, that thou shalt put the blessing upon mount Gerizim, and the curse upon mount Ebal.

whither thou goest <u>05\_DEU\_12\_29</u> # When the LORD thy God shall cut off the nations from before thee, whither thou goest to possess them, and thou succeedest them, and dwellest in their land;

whither thou goest <u>05\_DEU\_23\_20</u> # Unto a stranger thou mayest lend upon usury; but unto thy brother thou shalt not lend upon usury: that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all that thou settest thine hand to in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

whither thou goest <u>05\_DEU\_28\_21</u> # The LORD shall make the pestilence cleave unto thee, until he have consumed thee from off the land, whither thou goest to possess it.

whither thou goest <u>05\_DEU\_28\_63</u> # And it shall come to pass, [that] as the LORD rejoiced over you to do you good, and to multiply you; so the LORD will rejoice over you to destroy you, and to bring you to nought; and ye shall be plucked from off the land whither thou goest to possess it.

whither thou goest <u>05\_DEU\_30\_16</u># In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

whither thou goest <u>05\_DEU\_32\_50</u> # And die in the mount whither thou goest up, and be gathered unto thy people; as Aaron thy brother died in mount Hor, and was gathered unto his people:

whither thou goest <u>21\_ECC\_09\_10</u> # Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do [it] with thy might; for [there is] no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest.

whither thou goest <u>02\_EXO\_34\_12</u> # Take heed to thyself, lest thou make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land whither thou goest, lest it be for a snare in the midst of thee:

whither thou goest <u>01\_GEN\_28\_15</u># And, behold, I [am] with thee, and will keep thee in all [places] whither thou goest, and will bring thee again into this land; for I will not leave thee, until I have done [that] which I have spoken to thee of.

whither thou goest <u>24\_JER\_45\_05</u> # And seekest thou great things for thyself? seek [them] not: for, behold, I will bring evil upon all flesh, saith the LORD: but thy life will I give unto thee for a prey in all places whither thou goest.

whither thou goest <u>43\_JOH\_14\_05</u> # Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?

whither thou goest <u>08\_RUT\_01\_16</u># And Ruth said, Entreat me not to leave thee, [or] to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people [shall be] my people, and thy God my God:

whither thou hast <u>27\_DAN\_09\_07</u># O Lord, righteousness [belongeth] unto thee, but unto us confusion of faces, as at this day; to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and unto all Israel, [that are] near, and [that are] far off, through all the countries whither thou hast driven them, because of their trespass that they have trespassed against thee.

whither thou passest <u>05\_DEU\_03\_21</u> # And I commanded Joshua at that time, saying, Thine eyes have seen all that the LORD your God hath done unto these two kings: so shall the LORD do unto all the kingdoms whither thou passest.

whither thou passest <u>05\_DEU\_30\_18</u> # I denounce unto you this day, that ye shall surely perish, [and that] ye shall not prolong [your] days upon the land, whither thou passest over Jordan to go to possess it.

whither thou sentest <u>04\_NUM\_13\_27</u> # And they told him, and said, We came unto the land whither thou sentest us, and surely it floweth with milk and honey; and this [is] the fruit of it.

whither thou shalt <u>05\_DEU\_23\_12</u> # Thou shalt have a place also without the camp, whither thou shalt go forth abroad:

whither thou wouldest <u>43\_JOH\_21\_18</u># Verily, verily, I say unto thee, When thou wast young, thou girdedst thyself, and walkedst whither thou wouldest: but when thou shalt be old, thou shalt stretch forth thy hands, and another shall gird thee, and carry [thee] whither thou wouldest not.

whither thou wouldest <u>43\_JOH\_21\_18</u> # Verily, verily, I say unto thee, When thou wast young, thou girdedst thyself, and walkedst whither thou wouldest: but when thou shalt be old, thou shalt stretch forth thy hands, and another shall gird thee, and carry [thee] whither thou wouldest not.

whither we flee 23\_ISA\_20\_06 # And the inhabitant of this isle shall say in that day, Behold, such [is] our expectation, whither we flee for help to be delivered from the king of Assyria: and how shall we escape?

whither we shall <u>01\_GEN\_20\_13</u> # And it came to pass, when God caused me to wander from my father's house, that I said unto her, This [is] thy kindness which thou shalt show unto me; at every place whither we shall come, say of me, He [is] my brother.

Whither went ye <u>09\_1SA\_10\_14</u> # And Saul's uncle said unto him and to his servant, Whither went ye? And he said, To seek the asses: and when we saw that [they were] no where, we came to Samuel.

Whither will he <u>43\_JOH\_07\_35</u># Then said the Jews among themselves, Whither will he go, that we shall not find him? will he go unto the dispersed among the Gentiles, and teach the Gentiles?

whither wilt thou <u>01\_GEN\_16\_08</u> # And he said, Hagar, Sarai's maid, whence camest thou? and whither wilt thou go? And she said, I flee from the face of my mistress Sarai.

whither ye be <u>24\_JER\_44\_08</u> # In that ye provoke me unto wrath with the works of your hands, burning incense unto other gods in the land of Egypt, whither ye be gone to dwell, that ye might cut yourselves off, and that ye might be a curse and a reproach among all the nations of the earth?

whither ye desire 24\_JER\_42\_22# Now therefore know certainly that ye shall die by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence, in the place whither ye desire to go [and] to sojourn.

whither ye go <u>05\_DEU\_04\_05</u> # Behold, I have taught you statutes and judgments, even as the LORD my God commanded me, that ye should do so in the land whither ye go to possess it.

whither ye go <u>05\_DEU\_04\_14</u># And the LORD commanded me at that time to teach you statutes and judgments, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go over to possess it.

whither ye go <u>05\_DEU\_06\_01</u> # Now these [are] the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do [them] in the land whither ye go to possess it:

whither ye go 05\_DEU\_11\_08 # Therefore shall ye keep all the commandments which I command you this

day, that ye may be strong, and go in and possess the land, whither ye go to possess it;

whither ye go <u>05\_DEU\_11\_11</u># But the land, whither ye go to possess it, [is] a land of hills and valleys, [and] drinketh water of the rain of heaven:

whither ye go <u>05\_DEU\_31\_13</u> # And [that] their children, which have not known [any thing], may hear, and learn to fear the LORD your God, as long as ye live in the land whither ye go over Jordan to possess it.

whither ye go <u>05\_DEU\_32\_47</u># For it [is] not a vain thing for you; because it [is] your life: and through this thing ye shall prolong [your] days in the land, whither ye go over Jordan to possess it.

whither ye have 29\_JOE\_03\_07 # Behold, I will raise them out of the place whither ye have sold them, and will return your recompense upon your own head:

whither ye went <u>26\_EZE\_36\_22</u> # Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord GOD; I do not [this] for your sakes, O house of Israel, but for mine holy name's sake, which ye have profaned among the heathen, whither ye went.

whither <u>11\_1KI\_02\_36</u># And the king sent and called for Shimei, and said unto him, Build thee an house in Jerusalem, and dwell there, and go not forth thence any whither.

whither 12 2KI 05 25 # But he went in, and stood before his master. And Elisha said unto him, Whence [comest thou], Gehazi? And he said, Thy servant went no whither.

whithersoever he entered <u>41 MAR\_06\_56</u># And whithersoever he entered, into villages, or cities, or country, they laid the sick in the streets, and besought him that they might touch if it were but the border of his garment: and as many as touched him were made whole.

whithersoever he goeth <u>66\_REV\_14\_04</u># These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, [being] the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb.

whithersoever he turned <u>09\_1SA\_14\_47</u> # So Saul took the kingdom over Israel, and fought against all his enemies on every side, against Moab, and against the children of Ammon, and against Edom, and against the kings of Zobah, and against the Philistines: and whithersoever he turned himself, he vexed [them].

whithersoever he went <u>13\_1CH\_18\_06</u> # Then David put [garrisons] in Syriadamascus; and the Syrians became David's servants, [and] brought gifts. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

whithersoever he went <u>13\_1CH\_18\_13</u> # And he put garrisons in Edom; and all the Edomites became David's servants. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

whithersoever he went 12\_2KI\_18\_07 # And the LORD was with him; [and] he prospered whithersoever he went forth: and he rebelled against the king of Assyria, and served him not.

whithersoever he went <u>10\_2SA\_08\_06</u> # Then David put garrisons in Syria of Damascus: and the Syrians became servants to David, [and] brought gifts. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

whithersoever he went <u>10\_2SA\_08\_14</u> # And he put garrisons in Edom; throughout all Edom put he garrisons, and all they of Edom became David's servants. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

whithersoever he will <u>20\_PRO\_21\_01</u> # The king's heart [is] in the hand of the LORD, [as] the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will.

whithersoever I go 46\_1CO\_16\_06 # And it may be that I will abide, yea, and winter with you, that ye may bring me on my journey whithersoever I go.

whithersoever it turneth <u>20\_PRO\_17\_08</u> # A gift [is as] a precious stone in the eyes of him that hath it: whithersoever it turneth, it prospereth.

whithersoever Saul sent <u>09\_1SA\_18\_05</u># And David went out whithersoever Saul sent him, [and] behaved himself wisely: and Saul set him over the men of war, and he was accepted in the sight of all the people, and also in the sight of Saul's servants.

whithersoever the governor <u>59\_JAM\_03\_04</u># Behold also the ships, which though [they be] so great, and [are] driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth.

whithersoever the king's <u>17\_EST\_04\_03</u># And in every province, whithersoever the king's commandment and his decree came, [there was] great mourning among the Jews, and fasting, and weeping, and wailing; and many lay in sackcloth and ashes.

whithersoever the king's <u>17\_EST\_08\_17</u># And in every province, and in every city, whithersoever the king's commandment and his decree came, the Jews had joy and gladness, a feast and a good day. And many of the people of the land became Jews; for the fear of the Jews fell upon them.

whithersoever the rivers <u>26\_EZE\_47\_09</u> # And it shall come to pass, [that] every thing that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: for they shall be healed; and every thing shall live whither the river cometh.

Whithersoever the spirit <u>26\_EZE\_01\_20</u> # Whithersoever the spirit was to go, they went, thither [was their] spirit to go; and the wheels were lifted up over against them: for the spirit of the living creature [was] in the wheels.

whithersoever they could <u>09\_1SA\_23\_13</u># Then David and his men, [which were] about six hundred, arose and departed out of Keilah, and went whithersoever they could go. And it was told Saul that David was escaped from Keilah; and he forbare to go forth.

Whithersoever they went <u>07\_JUD\_02\_15</u># Whithersoever they went out, the hand of the LORD was against them for evil, as the LORD had said, and as the LORD had sworn unto them: and they were greatly distressed.

whithersoever thou goest <u>06\_JOS\_01\_07</u># Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it [to] the right hand or [to] the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest.

whithersoever thou goest <u>06\_JOS\_01\_09</u> # Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God [is] with thee whithersoever thou goest.

whithersoever thou goest <u>42\_LUK\_09\_57</u> # And it came to pass, that, as they went in the way, a certain [man] said unto him, Lord, I will follow thee whithersoever thou goest.

whithersoever thou goest <u>40\_MAT\_08\_19</u># And a certain scribe came, and said unto him, Master, I will follow thee whithersoever thou goest.

whithersoever thou hast <u>13\_1CH\_17\_08</u># And I have been with thee whithersoever thou hast walked, and have cut off all thine enemies from before thee, and have made thee a name like the name of the great men that [are] in the earth.

whithersoever thou sendest <u>06\_JOS\_01\_16</u># And they answered Joshua, saying, All that thou commandest us we will do, and whithersoever thou sendest us, we will go.

whithersoever thou shalt <u>11\_1KI\_08\_44</u># If thy people go out to battle against their enemy, whithersoever thou shalt send them, and shall pray unto the LORD toward the city which thou hast chosen, and [toward] the house that I have built for thy name:

whithersoever thou turnest <u>11\_1KI\_02\_03</u># And keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself:

whithersoever thou wentest <u>10\_2SA\_07\_09</u> # And I was with thee whithersoever thou wentest, and have cut off all thine enemies out of thy sight, and have made thee a great name, like unto the name of the great [men] that [are] in the earth.

whithersoever thy face <u>26\_EZE\_21\_16</u># Go thee one way or other, [either] on the right hand, [or] on the left, whithersoever thy face [is] set.
