holden in cords 18 JOB 36 08 # And if [they be] bound in fetters, [and] be holden in cords of affliction;

holden me by 19 PSA 73 23 Mevertheless I [am] continually with thee: thou hast holden [me] by my right hand.

holden me up 19 PSA 18 35 # Thou hast also given me the shield of thy salvation; and thy right hand hath holden me up, and thy gentleness hath made me great.

holden my peace 23 ISA 42 14# I have long time holden my peace; I have been still, [and] refrained myself: [now] will I cry like a travailing woman; I will destroy and devour at once.

holden of it 44 ACT 02 24# Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it.

holden such a 12 2KI 23 22 # Surely there was not holden such a passover from the days of the judges that judged Israel, nor in all the days of the kings of Israel, nor of the kings of Judah;

holden that they 42 LUK 24 16 # But their eyes were holden that they should not know him.

holden to subdue 23 ISA 45 01 # Thus saith the LORD to his anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have holden, to subdue nations before him; and I will loose the loins of kings, to open before him the two leaved gates; and the gates shall not be shut;

holden to the 12 2KI 23 23 # But in the eighteenth year of king Josiah, [wherein] this passover was holden to the LORD in Jerusalem.

holden up for 45 ROM 14 04 # Who art thou that judgest another man's servant? to his own master he standeth or falleth. Yea, he shall be holden up: for God is able to make him stand.

holden up from 19 PSA 71 06 # By thee have I been holden up from the womb: thou art he that took me out of my mother's bowels: my praise [shall be] continually of thee.

holden with the 20 PRO 05 22 # His own iniquities shall take the wicked himself, and he shall be holden with the cords of his sins.

upholden by mercy 20 PRO 20 28 # Mercy and truth preserve the king: and his throne is upholden by mercy.

withholden and the 18 JOB 38 15 # And from the wicked their light is withholden, and the high arm shall be broken.

withholden and there 24 JER 03 03 # Therefore the showers have been withholden, and there hath been no latter rain; and thou hadst a whore's forehead, thou refusedst to be ashamed.

withholden bread from 18 JOB 22 07 # Thou hast not given water to the weary to drink, and thou hast withholden bread from the hungry.

withholden from the 29 JOE 01 13 # Gird yourselves, and lament, ye priests: howl, ye ministers of the altar: come, lie all night in sackcloth, ye ministers of my God: for the meat offering and the drink offering is withholden from the house of your God.

withholden from thee 18 JOB 42 02 # I know that thou canst do every [thing], and [that] no thought can be withholden from thee,

withholden good things 24 JER 05 25 # Your iniquities have turned away these [things], and your sins have withholden good [things] from you.

withholden the pledge 26 EZE 18 16 # Neither hath oppressed any, hath not withholden the pledge, neither hath spoiled by violence, [but] hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment,

withholden the rain 30 AMO 04 07 # And also I have withholden the rain from you, when [there were] yet three months to the harvest: and I caused it to rain upon one city, and caused it not to rain upon another city: one piece was rained upon, and the piece whereupon it rained not withered.

withholden the request 19 PSA 21 02 # Thou hast given him his heart's desire, and hast not withholden the request of his lips. Selah.

withholden thee from 09 1SA 25 26 # Now therefore, my lord, [as] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, seeing the LORD hath withholden thee from coming to [shed] blood, and from avenging thyself with thine own hand, now let thine enemies, and they that seek evil to my lord, be as Nabal.
