dishonest gain which <u>26\_EZE\_22\_13</u># Behold, therefore I have smitten mine hand at thy dishonest gain which thou hast made, and at thy blood which hath been in the midst of thee.

dishonest gain 26\_EZE\_22\_27 # Her princes in the midst thereof [are] like wolves ravening the prey, to shed blood, [and] to destroy souls, to get dishonest gain.

dishonesty not walking <u>47\_2CO\_04\_02</u> # But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

honest among the <u>60\_1PE\_02\_12</u># Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by [your] good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation.

honest and good <u>42\_LUK\_08\_15</u># But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep [it], and bring forth fruit with patience.

honest in the <u>45\_ROM\_12\_17</u># Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men.

honest report full <u>44\_ACT\_06\_03</u> # Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.

honest things not <u>47\_2CO\_08\_21</u># Providing for honest things, not only in the sight of the Lord, but also in the sight of men.

honest though we <u>47\_2CO\_13\_07</u> # Now I pray to God that ye do no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that ye should do that which is honest, though we be as reprobates.

honest whatsoever things <u>50\_PHP\_04\_08</u> # Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things [are] honest, whatsoever things [are] just, whatsoever things [are] pure, whatsoever things [are] lovely, whatsoever things [are] of good report; if [there be] any virtue, and if [there be] any praise, think on these things.

honestly as in <u>45\_ROM\_13\_13</u> # Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying.

honestly toward them <u>52\_1TH\_04\_12</u># That ye may walk honestly toward them that are without, and [that] ye may have lack of nothing.

honestly <u>58\_HEB\_13\_18</u># Pray for us: for we trust we have a good conscience, in all things willing to live honestly.

honesty <u>54\_1TI\_02\_02</u># For kings, and [for] all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
