honeycomb and her <u>20_PRO_05_03</u># For the lips of a strange woman drop [as] an honeycomb, and her mouth [is] smoother than oil:

honeycomb and put <u>09_1SA_14_27</u># But Jonathan heard not when his father charged the people with the oath: wherefore he put forth the end of the rod that [was] in his hand, and dipped it in an honeycomb, and put his hand to his mouth; and his eyes were enlightened.

honeycomb but to <u>20_PRO_27_07</u> # The full soul loatheth an honeycomb; but to the hungry soul every bitter thing is sweet.

honeycomb honey and 22_SON_04_11 # Thy lips, O [my] spouse, drop [as] the honeycomb: honey and milk [are] under thy tongue; and the smell of thy garments [is] like the smell of Lebanon.

honeycomb sweet to <u>20_PRO_16_24</u> # Pleasant words [are as] an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

honeycomb which is <u>20_PRO_24_13</u> # My son, eat thou honey, because [it is] good; and the honeycomb, [which is] sweet to thy taste:

honeycomb with my <u>22_SON_05_01</u> # I am come into my garden, my sister, [my] spouse: I have gathered my myrrh with my spice; I have eaten my honeycomb with my honey; I have drunk my wine with my milk: eat, O friends; drink, yea, drink abundantly, O beloved.

honeycomb 42_LUK_24_42 # And they gave him a piece of a broiled fish, and of an honeycomb.

honeycomb <u>19_PSA_19_10</u> # More to be desired [are they] than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.
