husbandman 43\_JOH\_15\_01 # I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.

husbandmen a servant <u>41\_MAR\_12\_02</u> # And at the season he sent to the husbandmen a servant, that he might receive from the husbandmen of the fruit of the vineyard.

husbandmen also and 14 2CH 26 10 # Also he built towers in the desert, and digged many wells: for he had much cattle, both in the low country, and in the plains: husbandmen [also], and vine dressers in the mountains, and in Carmel: for he loved husbandry.

husbandmen and shall <u>42\_LUK\_20\_16</u># He shall come and destroy these husbandmen, and shall give the vineyard to others. And when they heard [it], they said, God forbid.

Husbands love your <u>49\_EPH\_05\_25</u># Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

husbands nay my <u>08\_RUT\_01\_13</u> # Would ye tarry for them till they were grown? would ye stay for them from having husbands? nay, my daughters; for it grieveth me much for your sakes that the hand of the LORD is gone out against me.

husbands of one <u>54\_1TI\_03\_12</u># Let the deacons be the husbands of one wife, ruling their children and their own houses well.

husbands that if <u>60\_1PE\_03\_01</u> # Likewise, ye wives, [be] in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives;

husbands that the <u>56\_TIT\_02\_05</u># [To be] discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

husbands to love <u>56\_TIT\_02\_04</u># That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,

husbands <u>60\_1PE\_03\_05</u> # For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands:

husbands <u>08\_RUT\_01\_11</u># And Naomi said, Turn again, my daughters: why will ye go with me? [are] there yet [any more] sons in my womb, that they may be your husbands?
