imagination of his [24 JER 16 12](#) # And ye have done worse than your fathers; for, behold, ye walk every one after the imagination of his evil heart, that they may not hearken unto me:

imagination of his [24 JER 18 12](#) # And they said, There is no hope: but we will walk after our own devices, and we will every one do the imagination of his evil heart.

imagination of his [24 JER 23 17](#) # They say still unto them that despise me, The LORD hath said, Ye shall have peace; and they say unto every one that walketh after the imagination of his own heart, No evil shall come upon you.

imagination of man's [01 GEN 08 21](#) # And the LORD smelled a sweet savour; and the LORD said in his heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart [is] evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done.

imagination of mine [05 DEU 29 19](#) # And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst:

imagination of the [13 1CH 29 18](#) # O LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, our fathers, keep this for ever in the imagination of the thoughts of the heart of thy people, and prepare their heart unto thee:

imagination of the [01 GEN 06 05](#) # And God saw that the wickedness of man [was] great in the earth, and [that] every imagination of the thoughts of his heart [was] only evil continually.

imagination of their [24 JER 03 17](#) # At that time they shall call Jerusalem the throne of the LORD; and all the nations shall be gathered unto it, to the name of the LORD, to Jerusalem: neither shall they walk any more after the imagination of their evil heart.

imagination of their [24 JER 07 24](#) # But they hearkened not, nor inclined their ear, but walked in the counsels [and] in the imagination of their evil heart, and went backward, and not forward.

imagination of their [24 JER 09 14](#) # But have walked after the imagination of their own heart, and after Baalim, which their fathers taught them:

imagination of their [24 JER 11 08](#) # Yet they obeyed not, nor inclined their ear, but walked every one in the imagination of their evil heart: therefore I will bring upon them all the words of this covenant, which I commanded [them] to do; but they did [them] not.

imagination of their [24 JER 13 10](#) # This evil people, which refuse to hear my words, which walk in the imagination of their heart, and walk after other gods, to serve them, and to worship them, shall even be as this girdle, which is good for nothing.

imagination of their [42 LUK 01 51](#) # He hath showed strength with his arm; he hath scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts.

imagination which they [05 DEU 31 21](#) # And it shall come to pass, when many evils and troubles are befallen them, that this song shall testify against them as a witness; for it shall not be forgotten out of the mouths of their seed: for I know their imagination which they go about, even now, before I have brought them into the land which I swear.

imaginings against me [25 LAM 03 60](#) # Thou hast seen all their vengeance [and] all their imaginings against me.

imaginings against me [25 LAM 03 61](#) # Thou hast heard their reproach, O LORD, [and] all their imaginings against me;

imaginings and every [47 2CO 10 05](#) # Casting down imaginings, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

imaginings and their [45 ROM 01 21](#) # Because that, when they knew God, they glorified [him] not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginings, and their foolish heart was darkened.

imaginings feet that [20 PRO 06 18](#) # An heart that deviseth wicked imaginings, feet that be swift in running to mischief,

imaginings of the [13 1CH 28 09](#) # And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginings of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee; but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever.
