ignorance against any [03 LEV 04 02](#) # Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If a soul shall sin through ignorance against any of the commandments of the LORD [concerning things] which ought not to be done, and shall do against any of them:

ignorance against any [03 LEV 04 22](#) # When a ruler hath sinned, and done [somewhat] through ignorance [against] any of the commandments of the LORD his God [concerning things] which should not be done, and is guilty;

ignorance and the [03 LEV 04 13](#) # And if the whole congregation of Israel sin through ignorance, and the thing be hid from the eyes of the assembly, and they have done [somewhat against] any of the commandments of the LORD [concerning things] which should not be done, and are guilty;

ignorance and they [04 NUM 15 25](#) # And the priest shall make an atonement for all the congregation of the children of Israel, and it shall be forgiven them; for it [is] ignorance: and they shall bring their offering, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD, and their sin offering before the LORD, for their ignorance:

ignorance before the [04 NUM 15 28](#) # And the priest shall make an atonement for the soul that sinneth ignorantly, when he sinneth by ignorance before the LORD, to make an atonement for him; and it shall be forgiven him.

ignorance both for [04 NUM 15 29](#) # Ye shall have one law for him that sinneth through ignorance, [both for] him that is born among the children of Israel, and for the stranger that sojourneth among them.

ignorance God winked [44 ACT 17 30](#) # And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

ignorance in the [03 LEV 05 15](#) # If a soul commit a trespass, and sin through ignorance, in the holy things of the LORD; then he shall bring for his trespass unto the LORD a ram without blemish out of the flocks, with thy estimation by shekels of silver, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for a trespass offering:

ignorance of foolish [60 IPE 02 15](#) # For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:

ignorance that is [49 EPH 04 18](#) # Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:

ignorance then he [04 NUM 15 27](#) # And if any soul sin through ignorance, then he shall bring a she goat of the first year for a sin offering.

ignorance wherein he [03 LEV 05 18](#) # And he shall bring a ram without blemish out of the flock, with thy estimation, for a trespass offering, unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his ignorance wherein he erred and wist [it] not, and it shall be forgiven him.

ignorance while he [03 LEV 04 27](#) # And if any one of the common people sin through ignorance, while he doeth [somewhat against] any of the commandments of the LORD [concerning things] which ought not to be done, and be guilty;

ignorance without the [04 NUM 15 24](#) # Then it shall be, if [ought] be committed by ignorance without the knowledge of the congregation, that all the congregation shall offer one young bullock for a burnt offering, for a sweet savour unto the LORD, with his meat offering, and his drink offering, according to the manner, and one kid of the goats for a sin offering.

ignorance ye did [44 ACT 03 17](#) # And now, brethren, I wot that through ignorance ye did [it], as [did] also your rulers.

ignorance [60 IPE 01 14](#) # As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance:

ignorance [04 NUM 15 25](#) # And the priest shall make an atonement for all the congregation of the children of Israel, and it shall be forgiven them; for it [is] ignorance: and they shall bring their offering, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD, and their sin offering before the LORD, for their ignorance:

ignorance [04 NUM 15 26](#) # And it shall be forgiven all the congregation of the children of Israel, and the stranger that sojourneth among them; seeing all the people [were] in ignorance.
