impossible but not [41 MAR 10 27](#) # And Jesus looking upon them saith, With men [it is] impossible, but not with God: for with God all things are possible.

impossible but that [42 LUK 17 01](#) # Then said he unto the disciples, It is impossible but that offences will come: but woe [unto him], through whom they come!

impossible but with [40 MAT 19 26](#) # But Jesus beheld [them], and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.

impossible for God [58 HEB 06 18](#) # That by two immutable things, in which [it was] impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

impossible for those [58 HEB 06 04](#) # For [it is] impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost,

impossible to please [58 HEB 11 06](#) # But without faith [it is] impossible to please [him]: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and [that] he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

impossible unto you [40 MAT 17 20](#) # And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

impossible with men [42 LUK 18 27](#) # And he said, The things which are impossible with men are possible with God.

impossible [42 LUK 01 37](#) # For with God nothing shall be impossible.
