ivory and all <u>66_REV_18_12</u># The merchandise of gold, and silver, and precious stones, and of pearls, and fine linen, and purple, and silk, and scarlet, and all thyine wood, and all manner vessels of ivory, and all manner vessels of most precious wood, and of brass, and iron, and marble,

ivory and apes 11_1KI_10_22# For the king had at sea a navy of Tharshish with the navy of Hiram: once in three years came the navy of Tharshish, bringing gold, and silver, ivory, and apes, and peacocks.

ivory and apes 14_2CH_09_21 # For the king's ships went to Tarshish with the servants of Huram: every three years once came the ships of Tarshish bringing gold, and silver, ivory, and apes, and peacocks.

ivory and ebony <u>26_EZE_27_15</u> # The men of Dedan [were] thy merchants; many isles [were] the merchandise of thine hand: they brought thee [for] a present horns of ivory and ebony.

ivory and overlaid <u>11_1KI_10_18</u># Moreover the king made a great throne of ivory, and overlaid it with the best gold.

ivory and overlaid <u>14_2CH_09_17</u> # Moreover the king made a great throne of ivory, and overlaid it with pure gold.

ivory and stretch <u>30_AMO_06_04</u> # That lie upon beds of ivory, and stretch themselves upon their couches, and eat the lambs out of the flock, and the calves out of the midst of the stall;

ivory brought out <u>26_EZE_27_06</u> # [Of] the oaks of Bashan have they made thine oars; the company of the Ashurites have made thy benches [of] ivory, [brought] out of the isles of Chittim.

ivory house which <u>11_1KI_22_39</u># Now the rest of the acts of Ahab, and all that he did, and the ivory house which he made, and all the cities that he built, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

ivory overlaid with <u>22_SON_05_14</u> # His hands [are as] gold rings set with the beryl: his belly [is as] bright ivory overlaid [with] sapphires.

ivory palaces whereby 19_PSA_45_08 # All thy garments [smell] of myrrh, and aloes, [and] cassia, out of the ivory palaces, whereby they have made thee glad.

ivory shall perish <u>30_AMO_03_15</u> # And I will smite the winter house with the summer house; and the houses of ivory shall perish, and the great houses shall have an end, saith the LORD.

ivory thine eyes <u>22_SON_07_04</u># Thy neck [is] as a tower of ivory; thine eyes [like] the fishpools in Heshbon, by the gate of Bathrabbim: thy nose [is] as the tower of Lebanon which looketh toward Damascus.
