

# KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Abijah and Attai <u>14\_2CH\_11\_20</u># And after her he took Maachah the daughter of Absalom; which bare him Abijah, and Attai, and Ziza, and Shelomith.

Abijah and his <u>14\_2CH\_13\_17</u># And Abijah and his people slew them with a great slaughter: so there fell down slain of Israel five hundred thousand chosen men.

Abijah and his <u>14\_2CH\_13\_22</u> # And the rest of the acts of Abijah, and his ways, and his sayings, [are] written in the story of the prophet Iddo.

Abijah and Jeroboam <u>14\_2CH\_13\_02</u> # He reigned three years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Michaiah the daughter of Uriel of Gibeah. And there was war between Abijah and Jeroboam.

Abijah and Judah <u>14\_2CH\_13\_15</u># Then the men of Judah gave a shout: and as the men of Judah shouted, it came to pass, that God smote Jeroboam and all Israel before Abijah and Judah.

Abijah and the <u>14\_2CH\_13\_20</u># Neither did Jeroboam recover strength again in the days of Abijah: and the LORD struck him, and he died.

Abijah his son <u>14\_2CH\_12\_16</u># And Rehoboam slept with his fathers, and was buried in the city of David: and Abijah his son reigned in his stead.

Abijah Mijamin <u>16\_NEH\_10\_07</u> # Meshullam, Abijah, Mijamin,

Abijah pursued after <u>14\_2CH\_13\_19</u> # And Abijah pursued after Jeroboam, and took cities from him, Bethel with the towns thereof, and Jeshanah with the towns thereof, and Ephrain with the towns thereof.

Abijah set the <u>14\_2CH\_13\_03</u> # And Abijah set the battle in array with an army of valiant men of war, [even] four hundred thousand chosen men: Jeroboam also set the battle in array against him with eight hundred thousand chosen men, [being] mighty men of valour.

Abijah slept with <u>14\_2CH\_14\_01</u> # So Abijah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city of David: and Asa his son reigned in his stead. In his days the land was quiet ten years.

Abijah stood up <u>14\_2CH\_13\_04</u> # And Abijah stood up upon mount Zemaraim, which [is] in mount Ephraim, and said, Hear me, thou Jeroboam, and all Israel;

Abijah the daughter <u>14\_2CH\_29\_01</u> # Hezekiah began to reign [when he was] five and twenty years old, and he reigned nine and twenty years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Abijah, the daughter of Zechariah.

Abijah the son <u>11\_1KI\_14\_01</u># At that time Abijah the son of Jeroboam fell sick.

Abijah the son <u>14\_2CH\_11\_22</u># And Rehoboam made Abijah the son of Maachah the chief, [to be] ruler among his brethren: for [he thought] to make him king.

Abijah to reign <u>14\_2CH\_13\_01</u> # Now in the eighteenth year of king Jeroboam began Abijah to reign over Judah.

Abijah waxed mighty <u>14\_2CH\_13\_21</u># But Abijah waxed mighty, and married fourteen wives, and begat twenty and two sons, and sixteen daughters.

Abijah Zichri of <u>16\_NEH\_12\_17</u># Of Abijah, Zichri; of Miniamin, of Moadiah, Piltai;

Abijah <u>13\_1CH\_24\_10</u># The seventh to Hakkoz, the eighth to Abijah,

Abijah <u>16\_NEH\_12\_04</u> # Iddo, Ginnetho, Abijah,

Adonijah and all <u>11\_1KI\_01\_41</u># And Adonijah and all the guests that [were] with him heard [it] as they had made an end of eating. And when Joab heard the sound of the trumpet, he said, Wherefore [is this] noise of the city being in an uproar?

Adonijah And the <u>11\_1KI\_02\_19</u># Bathsheba therefore went unto king Solomon, to speak unto him for Adonijah. And the king rose up to meet her, and bowed himself unto her, and sat down on his throne, and caused a seat to be set for the king's mother; and she sat on his right hand.

Adonijah and Tobijah <u>14\_2CH\_17\_08</u># And with them [he sent] Levites, [even] Shemaiah, and Nethaniah, and Zebadiah, and Asahel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehonathan, and Adonijah, and Tobijah, and Tobadonijah, Levites; and with them Elishama and Jehoram, priests.

Adonijah ask for <u>11\_1KI\_02\_22</u># And king Solomon answered and said unto his mother, And why dost thou ask Abishag the Shunammite for Adonijah? ask for him the kingdom also; for he [is] mine elder brother; even for him, and for Abiathar the priest, and for Joab the son of Zeruiah.

Adonijah Bigvai Adin <u>16\_NEH\_10\_16</u># Adonijah, Bigvai, Adin,

Adonijah feared because <u>11\_1KI\_01\_50</u># And Adonijah feared because of Solomon, and arose, and went, and caught hold on the horns of the altar.

Adonijah feareth king <u>11\_1KI\_01\_51</u># And it was told Solomon, saying, Behold, Adonijah feareth king Solomon: for, lo, he hath caught hold on the horns of the altar, saying, Let king Solomon swear unto me to day that he will not slay his servant with the sword.

Adonijah have not <u>11\_1KI\_02\_23</u># Then king Solomon sware by the LORD, saying, God do so to me, and more also, if Adonijah have not spoken this word against his own life.

Adonijah helped him <u>11\_1KI\_01\_07</u># And he conferred with Joab the son of Zeruiah, and with Abiathar the priest: and they following Adonijah helped [him].

Adonijah reign <u>11\_1KI\_01\_13</u># Go and get thee in unto king David, and say unto him, Didst not thou, my lord, O king, swear unto thine handmaid, saying, Assuredly Solomon thy son shall reign after me, and he shall sit upon my throne? why then doth Adonijah reign?

Adonijah reigneth and <u>11\_1KI\_01\_18</u># And now, behold, Adonijah reigneth; and now, my lord the king, thou knowest [it] not:

Adonijah said unto <u>11\_1KI\_01\_42</u># And while he yet spake, behold, Jonathan the son of Abiathar the priest came: and Adonijah said unto him, Come in; for thou [art] a valiant man, and bringest good tidings.

Adonijah shall be <u>11\_1KI\_02\_24</u># Now therefore, [as] the LORD liveth, which hath established me, and set me on the throne of David my father, and who hath made me an house, as he promised, Adonijah shall be put to death this day.

Adonijah shall reign <u>11\_1KI\_01\_24</u> # And Nathan said, My lord, O king, hast thou said, Adonijah shall

reign after me, and he shall sit upon my throne?

Adonijah slew sheep <u>11\_1KI\_01\_09</u># And Adonijah slew sheep and oxen and fat cattle by the stone of Zoheleth, which [is] by Enrogel, and called all his brethren the king's sons, and all the men of Judah the king's servants:

Adonijah the son <u>13\_1CH\_03\_02</u># The third, Absalom the son of Maachah the daughter of Talmai king of Geshur: the fourth, Adonijah the son of Haggith:

Adonijah the son <u>11\_1KI\_01\_05</u># Then Adonijah the son of Haggith exalted himself, saying, I will be king: and he prepared him chariots and horsemen, and fifty men to run before him.

Adonijah the son <u>11\_1KI\_01\_11</u># Wherefore Nathan spake unto Bathsheba the mother of Solomon, saying, Hast thou not heard that Adonijah the son of Haggith doth reign, and David our lord knoweth [it] not?

Adonijah the son <u>11\_1KI\_02\_13</u># And Adonijah the son of Haggith came to Bathsheba the mother of Solomon. And she said, Comest thou peaceably? And he said, Peaceably.

Adonijah the son <u>10\_2SA\_03\_04</u># And the fourth, Adonijah the son of Haggith; and the fifth, Shephatiah the son of Abital;

Adonijah though he <u>11\_1KI\_02\_28</u># Then tidings came to Joab: for Joab had turned after Adonijah, though he turned not after Absalom. And Joab fled unto the tabernacle of the LORD, and caught hold on the horns of the altar.

Adonijah thy brother <u>11\_1KI\_02\_21</u># And she said, Let Abishag the Shunammite be given to Adonijah thy brother to wife.

Adonijah Verily our <u>11\_1KI\_01\_43</u># And Jonathan answered and said to Adonijah, Verily our lord king David hath made Solomon king.

Adonijah were afraid <u>11\_1KI\_01\_49</u># And all the guests that [were] with Adonijah were afraid, and rose up, and went every man his way.

Adonijah <u>11\_1KI\_01\_08</u># But Zadok the priest, and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, and Nathan the prophet, and Shimei, and Rei, and the mighty men which [belonged] to David, were not with Adonijah.

Adonijah <u>11\_1KI\_01\_25</u># For he is gone down this day, and hath slain oxen and fat cattle and sheep in abundance, and hath called all the king's sons, and the captains of the host, and Abiathar the priest; and, behold, they eat and drink before him, and say, God save king Adonijah.

Ahijah Behold the <u>11\_1KI\_14\_05</u># And the LORD said unto Ahijah, Behold, the wife of Jeroboam cometh to ask a thing of thee for her son; for he [is] sick: thus and thus shalt thou say unto her: for it shall be, when she cometh in, that she shall feign herself [to be] another [woman].

Ahijah But Ahijah <u>11\_1KI\_14\_04</u> # And Jeroboam's wife did so, and arose, and went to Shiloh, and came to the house of Ahijah. But Ahijah could not see; for his eyes were set by reason of his age.

Ahijah caught the <u>11\_1KI\_11\_30</u># And Ahijah caught the new garment that [was] on him, and rent it [in] twelve pieces:

Ahijah could not <u>11\_1KI\_14\_04</u># And Jeroboam's wife did so, and arose, and went to Shiloh, and came to the house of Ahijah. But Ahijah could not see; for his eyes were set by reason of his age.

Ahijah for the <u>11\_1KI\_21\_22</u># And will make thine house like the house of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and

like the house of Baasha the son of Ahijah, for the provocation wherewith thou hast provoked [me] to anger, and made Israel to sin.

Ahijah Hanan Anan <u>16\_NEH\_10\_26</u> # And Ahijah, Hanan, Anan,

Ahijah heard the <u>11\_1KI\_14\_06</u># And it was [so], when Ahijah heard the sound of her feet, as she came in at the door, that he said, Come in, thou wife of Jeroboam; why feignest thou thyself [to be] another? for I [am] sent to thee [with] heavy [tidings].

Ahijah of the <u>11\_1KI\_15\_27</u># And Baasha the son of Ahijah, of the house of Issachar, conspired against him; and Baasha smote him at Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines; for Nadab and all Israel laid siege to Gibbethon.

Ahijah the Pelonite <u>13\_1CH\_11\_36</u># Hepher the Mecherathite, Ahijah the Pelonite,

Ahijah the prophet <u>11\_1KI\_14\_02</u># And Jeroboam said to his wife, Arise, I pray thee, and disguise thyself, that thou be not known to be the wife of Jeroboam; and get thee to Shiloh: behold, there [is] Ahijah the prophet, which told me that [I should be] king over this people.

Ahijah the prophet <u>11\_1KI\_14\_18</u># And they buried him; and all Israel mourned for him, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by the hand of his servant Ahijah the prophet.

Ahijah the Shilonite <u>11\_1KI\_11\_29</u># And it came to pass at that time when Jeroboam went out of Jerusalem, that the prophet Ahijah the Shilonite found him in the way; and he had clad himself with a new garment; and they two [were] alone in the field:

Ahijah the Shilonite <u>11\_1KI\_12\_15</u># Wherefore the king hearkened not unto the people; for the cause was from the LORD, that he might perform his saying, which the LORD spake by Ahijah the Shilonite unto Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

Ahijah the Shilonite <u>11\_1KI\_15\_29</u># And it came to pass, when he reigned, [that] he smote all the house of Jeroboam; he left not to Jeroboam any that breathed, until he had destroyed him, according unto the saying of the LORD, which he spake by his servant Ahijah the Shilonite:

Ahijah the Shilonite <u>14\_2CH\_09\_29</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Solomon, first and last, [are] they not written in the book of Nathan the prophet, and in the prophecy of Ahijah the Shilonite, and in the visions of Iddo the seer against Jeroboam the son of Nebat?

Ahijah the Shilonite <u>14\_2CH\_10\_15</u># So the king hearkened not unto the people: for the cause was of God, that the LORD might perform his word, which he spake by the hand of Ahijah the Shilonite to Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

Ahijah to reign <u>11\_1KI\_15\_33</u># In the third year of Asa king of Judah began Baasha the son of Ahijah to reign over all Israel in Tirzah, twenty and four years.

Ahijah was over <u>13\_1CH\_26\_20</u># And of the Levites, Ahijah [was] over the treasures of the house of God, and over the treasures of the dedicated things.

Ahijah <u>13\_1CH\_02\_25</u> # And the sons of Jerahmeel the firstborn of Hezron were, Ram the firstborn, and Bunah, and Oren, and Ozem, [and] Ahijah.

Ahijah <u>12\_2KI\_09\_09</u> # And I will make the house of Ahab like the house of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and like the house of Baasha the son of Ahijah:

Ajah and Anah 01\_GEN\_36\_24 # And these [are] the children of Zibeon; both Ajah, and Anah: this [was

that] Anah that found the mules in the wilderness, as he fed the asses of Zibeon his father.

Antothijah <u>13\_1CH\_08\_24</u># And Hananiah, and Elam, and Antothijah,

Bizjothjah <u>06\_JOS\_15\_28</u> # And Hazarshual, and Beersheba, and Bizjothjah,

Elijah and besought <u>12\_2KI\_01\_13</u># And he sent again a captain of the third fifty with his fifty. And the third captain of fifty went up, and came and fell on his knees before Elijah, and besought him, and said unto him, O man of God, I pray thee, let my life, and the life of these fifty thy servants, be precious in thy sight.

Elijah and he <u>11\_1KI\_18\_46</u># And the hand of the LORD was on Elijah; and he girded up his loins, and ran before Ahab to the entrance of Jezreel.

Elijah and ministered <u>11\_1KI\_19\_21</u># And he returned back from him, and took a yoke of oxen, and slew them, and boiled their flesh with the instruments of the oxen, and gave unto the people, and they did eat. Then he arose, and went after Elijah, and ministered unto him.

Elijah and said <u>11\_1KI\_19\_20</u># And he left the oxen, and ran after Elijah, and said, Let me, I pray thee, kiss my father and my mother, and [then] I will follow thee. And he said unto him, Go back again: for what have I done to thee?

Elijah and she <u>11\_1KI\_17\_15</u># And she went and did according to the saying of Elijah: and she, and he, and her house, did eat [many] days.

Elijah and Shemaiah <u>15\_EZR\_10\_21</u># And of the sons of Harim; Maaseiah, and Elijah, and Shemaiah, and Jehiel, and Uzziah.

Elijah and the <u>11\_1KI\_17\_22</u># And the LORD heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul of the child came into him again, and he revived.

Elijah and when <u>12\_2KI\_02\_14</u> # And he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and smote the waters, and said, Where [is] the LORD God of Elijah? and when he also had smitten the waters, they parted hither and thither: and Elisha went over.

Elijah answered and <u>12\_2KI\_01\_10</u> # And Elijah answered and said to the captain of fifty, If I [be] a man of God, then let fire come down from heaven, and consume thee and thy fifty. And there came down fire from heaven, and consumed him and his fifty.

Elijah answered and <u>12\_2KI\_01\_12</u> # And Elijah answered and said unto them, If I [be] a man of God, let fire come down from heaven, and consume thee and thy fifty. And the fire of God came down from heaven, and consumed him and his fifty.

Elijah brought them <u>11\_1KI\_18\_40</u># And Elijah said unto them, Take the prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape. And they took them: and Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there.

Elijah came unto <u>11\_1KI\_18\_21</u># And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? if the LORD [be] God, follow him: but if Baal, [then] follow him. And the people answered him not a word.

Elijah departed <u>12\_2KI\_01\_04</u> # Now therefore thus saith the LORD, Thou shalt not come down from that bed on which thou art gone up, but shalt surely die. And Elijah departed.

Elijah doth rest <u>12\_2KI\_02\_15</u> # And when the sons of the prophets which [were] to view at Jericho saw

him, they said, The spirit of Elijah doth rest on Elisha. And they came to meet him, and bowed themselves to the ground before him.

Elijah Go down <u>12\_2KI\_01\_15</u># And the angel of the LORD said unto Elijah, Go down with him: be not afraid of him. And he arose, and went down with him unto the king.

Elijah had done <u>11\_1KI\_19\_01</u># And Ahab told Jezebel all that Elijah had done, and withal how he had slain all the prophets with the sword.

Elijah had spoken <u>12\_2KI\_01\_17</u># So he died according to the word of the LORD which Elijah had spoken. And Jehoram reigned in his stead in the second year of Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat king of Judah; because he had no son.

Elijah hast thou <u>11\_1KI\_21\_20</u># And Ahab said to Elijah, hast thou found me, O mine enemy? And he answered, I have found [thee]; because thou hast sold thyself to work evil in the sight of the LORD.

Elijah heard it <u>11\_1KI\_19\_13</u># And it was [so], when Elijah heard [it] that he wrapped his face in his mantle, and went out, and stood in the entering in of the cave. And, behold, [there came] a voice unto him, and said, What doest thou here, Elijah?

Elijah in the <u>11\_1KI\_18\_01</u># And it came to pass [after] many days, that the word of the LORD came to Elijah in the third year, saying, Go, show thyself unto Ahab; and I will send rain upon the earth.

Elijah into heaven <u>12\_2KI\_02\_01</u> # And it came to pass, when the LORD would take up Elijah into heaven by a whirlwind, that Elijah went with Elisha from Gilgal.

Elijah mocked them <u>11\_1KI\_18\_27</u># And it came to pass at noon, that Elijah mocked them, and said, Cry aloud: for he [is] a god; either he is talking, or he is pursuing, or he is in a journey, [or] peradventure he sleepeth, and must be awaked.

Elijah Now by <u>11\_1KI\_17\_24</u># And the woman said to Elijah, Now by this I know that thou [art] a man of God, [and] that the word of the LORD in thy mouth [is] truth.

Elijah passed by <u>11\_1KI\_19\_19</u># So he departed thence, and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, who [was] plowing [with] twelve yoke [of oxen] before him, and he with the twelfth: and Elijah passed by him, and cast his mantle upon him.

Elijah said See <u>11\_1KI\_17\_23</u># And Elijah took the child, and brought him down out of the chamber into the house, and delivered him unto his mother: and Elijah said, See, thy son liveth.

Elijah said unto <u>11\_1KI\_17\_13</u># And Elijah said unto her, Fear not; go [and] do as thou hast said: but make me thereof a little cake first, and bring [it] unto me, and after make for thee and for thy son.

Elijah said unto <u>11\_1KI\_18\_25</u># And Elijah said unto the prophets of Baal, Choose you one bullock for yourselves, and dress [it] first; for ye [are] many; and call on the name of your gods, but put no fire [under].

Elijah said unto <u>11\_1KI\_18\_30</u># And Elijah said unto all the people, Come near unto me. And all the people came near unto him. And he repaired the altar of the LORD [that was] broken down.

Elijah said unto <u>11\_1KI\_18\_40</u># And Elijah said unto them, Take the prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape. And they took them: and Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there.

Elijah said unto <u>11\_1KI\_18\_41</u> # And Elijah said unto Ahab, Get thee up, eat and drink; for [there is] a sound of abundance of rain.

Elijah said unto <u>12\_2KI\_02\_02</u> # And Elijah said unto Elisha, Tarry here, I pray thee; for the LORD hath sent me to Bethel. And Elisha said [unto him, As] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. So they went down to Bethel.

Elijah said unto <u>12\_2KI\_02\_04</u># And Elijah said unto him, Elisha, tarry here, I pray thee; for the LORD hath sent me to Jericho. And he said, [As] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. So they came to Jericho.

Elijah said unto <u>12\_2KI\_02\_06</u> # And Elijah said unto him, Tarry, I pray thee, here; for the LORD hath sent me to Jordan. And he said, [As] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. And they two went on.

Elijah said unto <u>12\_2KI\_02\_09</u> # And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me.

Elijah saying So <u>11\_1KI\_19\_02</u># Then Jezebel sent a messenger unto Elijah, saying, So let the gods do [to me], and more also, if I make not thy life as the life of one of them by to morrow about this time.

Elijah that Ahab <u>11\_1KI\_18\_17</u># And it came to pass, when Ahab saw Elijah, that Ahab said unto him, [Art] thou he that troubleth Israel?

Elijah that fell <u>12\_2KI\_02\_13</u># He took up also the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and went back, and stood by the bank of Jordan;

Elijah that fell <u>12\_2KI\_02\_14</u> # And he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and smote the waters, and said, Where [is] the LORD God of Elijah? and when he also had smitten the waters, they parted hither and thither: and Elisha went over.

Elijah the prophet <u>11\_1KI\_18\_36</u># And it came to pass at [the time of] the offering of the [evening] sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that thou [art] God in Israel, and [that] I [am] thy servant, and [that] I have done all these things at thy word.

Elijah the prophet <u>14\_2CH\_21\_12</u> # And there came a writing to him from Elijah the prophet, saying, Thus saith the LORD God of David thy father, Because thou hast not walked in the ways of Jehoshaphat thy father, nor in the ways of Asa king of Judah,

Elijah the prophet <u>39\_MAL\_04\_05</u># Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD:
