

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

James a servant <u>59_JAM_01_01</u># James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, greeting.

James and all <u>44_ACT_21_18</u> # And the [day] following Paul went in with us unto James; and all the elders were present.

James and he <u>41_MAR_03_17</u> # And James the [son] of Zebedee, and John the brother of James; and he surnamed them Boanerges, which is, The sons of thunder:

James and John <u>44_ACT_01_13</u> # And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James [the son] of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas [the brother] of James.

James and John <u>42_LUK_05_10</u> # And so [was] also James, and John, the sons of Zebedee, which were partners with Simon. And Jesus said unto Simon, Fear not; from henceforth thou shalt catch men.

James and John <u>42_LUK_06_14</u> # Simon, [whom he also named Peter,] and Andrew his brother, James and John, Philip and Bartholomew,

James and John <u>42_LUK_08_51</u> # And when he came into the house, he suffered no man to go in, save Peter, and James, and John, and the father and the mother of the maiden.

James and John <u>42_LUK_09_54</u> # And when his disciples James and John saw [this], they said, Lord, wilt thou that we command fire to come down from heaven, and consume them, even as Elias did?

James and John <u>41_MAR_01_29</u> # And forthwith, when they were come out of the synagogue, they entered into the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John.

James and John <u>41_MAR_05_37</u># And he suffered no man to follow him, save Peter, and James, and John the brother of James.

James and John <u>41_MAR_09_02</u> # And after six days Jesus taketh [with him] Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and he was transfigured before them.

James and John <u>41_MAR_10_35</u> # And James and John, the sons of Zebedee, come unto him, saying, Master, we would that thou shouldest do for us whatsoever we shall desire.

James and John <u>41_MAR_10_41</u> # And when the ten heard [it], they began to be much displeased with James and John.

James and John <u>41_MAR_13_03</u> # And as he sat upon the mount of Olives over against the temple, Peter and James and John and Andrew asked him privately,

James and John <u>41_MAR_14_33</u> # And he taketh with him Peter and James and John, and began to be sore amazed, and to be very heavy;

James and John <u>40_MAT_17_01</u># And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,

James and Joses <u>41_MAR_06_03</u> # Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, the brother of James, and Joses, and of Juda, and Simon? and are not his sisters here with us? And they were offended at him.

James and Joses <u>40_MAT_13_55</u># Is not this the carpenter's son? is not his mother called Mary? and his brethren, James, and Joses, and Simon, and Judas?

James and Joses <u>40_MAT_27_56</u># Among which was Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James and Joses, and the mother of Zebedee's children.

James and Judas <u>42_LUK_06_16</u># And Judas [the brother] of James, and Judas Iscariot, which also was the traitor.

James and other <u>42_LUK_24_10</u> # It was Mary Magdalene, and Joanna, and Mary [the mother] of James, and other [women that were] with them, which told these things unto the apostles.

James and Salome <u>41_MAR_16_01</u># And when the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the [mother] of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him.

James and to <u>44_ACT_12_17</u> # But he, beckoning unto them with the hand to hold their peace, declared unto them how the Lord had brought him out of the prison. And he said, Go show these things unto James, and to the brethren. And he departed, and went into another place.

James and went <u>42_LUK_09_28</u># And it came to pass about an eight days after these sayings, he took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to pray.

James answered saying <u>44_ACT_15_13</u> # And after they had held their peace, James answered, saying, Men [and] brethren, hearken unto me:

James Cephas and <u>48_GAL_02_09</u># And when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we [should go] unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision.

James he did <u>48_GAL_02_12</u># For before that certain came from James, he did eat with the Gentiles: but when they were come, he withdrew and separated himself, fearing them which were of the circumcision.

James the brother <u>44_ACT_12_02</u> # And he killed James the brother of John with the sword.

James the less <u>41_MAR_15_40</u> # There were also women looking on afar off: among whom was Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James the less and of Joses, and Salome;

James the Lord's <u>48_GAL_01_19</u> # But other of the apostles saw I none, save James the Lord's brother.

James the son <u>44_ACT_01_13</u> # And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James [the son] of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas [the brother] of James.

James the son <u>42_LUK_06_15</u> # Matthew and Thomas, James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Simon called Zelotes,

James the son <u>41_MAR_01_19</u> # And when he had gone a little farther thence, he saw James the [son] of Zebedee, and John his brother, who also were in the ship mending their nets.

James the son <u>41_MAR_03_17</u> # And James the [son] of Zebedee, and John the brother of James; and he surnamed them Boanerges, which is, The sons of thunder:

James the son <u>41_MAR_03_18</u> # And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite,

James the son <u>40_MAT_04_21</u># And going on from thence, he saw other two brethren, James [the son] of Zebedee, and John his brother, in a ship with Zebedee their father, mending their nets; and he called them.

James the son <u>40 MAT_10_02</u># Now the names of the twelve apostles are these; The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James [the son] of Zebedee, and John his brother;

James the son <u>40 MAT_10_03</u># Philip, and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the publican; James [the son] of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus;

James then of <u>46_1CO_15_07</u> # After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles.

James to them <u>65_JDE_01_01</u># Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, [and] called:

James <u>44_ACT_01_13</u> # And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James [the son] of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas [the brother] of James.

James <u>41_MAR_05_37</u> # And he suffered no man to follow him, save Peter, and James, and John the brother of James.
