Joab also and <u>10_2SA_02_24</u> # Joab also and Abishai pursued after Abner: and the sun went down when they were come to the hill of Ammah, that [lieth] before Giah by the way of the wilderness of Gibeon.

Joab and a <u>10_2SA_18_02</u> # And David sent forth a third part of the people under the hand of Joab, and a third part under the hand of Abishai the son of Zeruiah, Joab's brother, and a third part under the hand of Ittai the Gittite. And the king said unto the people, I will surely go forth with you myself also.

Joab and Abishai <u>10_2SA_02_18</u># And there were three sons of Zeruiah there, Joab, and Abishai, and Asahel: and Asahel [was as] light of foot as a wild roe.

Joab and Asahel <u>13_1CH_02_16</u> # Whose sisters [were] Zeruiah, and Abigail. And the sons of Zeruiah; Abishai, and Joab, and Asahel, three.

Joab and half <u>13_1CH_02_54</u> # The sons of Salma; Bethlehem, and the Netophathites, Ataroth, the house of Joab, and half of the Manahethites, the Zorites.

Joab and he <u>10_2SA_20_11</u># And one of Joab's men stood by him, and said, He that favoureth Joab, and he that [is] for David, [let him go] after Joab.

Joab And he <u>10_2SA_20_17</u> # And when he was come near unto her, the woman said, [Art] thou Joab? And he answered, I [am he]. Then she said unto him, Hear the words of thine handmaid. And he answered, I do hear.

Joab And he <u>10_2SA_20_22</u> # Then the woman went unto all the people in her wisdom. And they cut off the

Joab saw that <u>10_2SA_10_09</u># When Joab saw that the front of the battle was against him before and behind, he chose of all the choice [men] of Israel, and put [them] in array against the Syrians:

Joab saying Abner <u>10_2SA_03_23</u> # When Joab and all the host that [was] with him were come, they told Joab, saying, Abner the son of Ner came to the king, and he hath sent him away, and he is gone in peace.

Joab saying Send <u>10_2SA_11_06</u># And David sent to Joab, [saying], Send me Uriah the Hittite. And Joab sent Uriah to David.

Joab saying Who <u>09_1SA_26_06</u># Then answered David and said to Ahimelech the Hittite, and to Abishai the son of Zeruiah, brother to Joab, saying, Who will go down with me to Saul to the camp? And Abishai said, I will go down with thee.

Joab sent and <u>10_2SA_11_18</u># Then Joab sent and told David all the things concerning the war;

Joab sent messengers <u>10_2SA_12_27</u># And Joab sent messengers to David, and said, I have fought against Rabbah, and have taken the city of waters.

Joab sent the <u>10_2SA_18_29</u> # And the king said, Is the young man Absalom safe? And Ahimaaz answered, When Joab sent the king's servant, and [me] thy servant, I saw a great tumult, but I knew not what [it was].

Joab sent to <u>10_2SA_14_02</u> # And Joab sent to Tekoah, and fetched thence a wise woman, and said unto her, I pray thee, feign thyself to be a mourner, and put on now mourning apparel, and anoint not thyself with oil, but be as a woman that had a long time mourned for the dead:

Joab the father <u>13_1CH_04_14</u> # And Meonothai begat Ophrah: and Seraiah begat Joab, the father of the valley of Charashim; for they were craftsmen.

Joab the son <u>13_1CH_11_06</u># And David said, Whosoever smitch the Jebusites first shall be chief and captain. So Joab the son of Zeruiah went first up, and was chief.

Joab the son <u>13_1CH_11_39</u># Zelek the Ammonite, Naharai the Berothite, the armourbearer of Joab the son of Zeruiah,

Joab the son <u>13_1CH_18_15</u> # And Joab the son of Zeruiah [was] over the host; and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, recorder.

Joab the son <u>13_1CH_26_28</u> # And all that Samuel the seer, and Saul the son of Kish, and Abner the son of Ner, and Joab the son of Zeruiah, had dedicated; [and] whosoever had dedicated [any thing, it was] under the hand of Shelomith, and of his brethren.

Joab the son <u>13_1CH_27_24</u> # Joab the son of Zeruiah began to number, but he finished not, because there fell wrath for it against Israel; neither was the number put in the account of the chronicles of king David.

Joab the son <u>11_1KI_01_07</u># And he conferred with Joab the son of Zeruiah, and with Abiathar the priest: and they following Adonijah helped [him].

Joab the son <u>11_1KI_02_05</u># Moreover thou knowest also what Joab the son of Zeruiah did to me, [and] what he did to the two captains of the hosts of Israel, unto Abner the son of Ner, and unto Amasa the son of Jether, whom he slew, and shed the blood of war in peace, and put the blood of war upon his girdle that [was] about his loins, and in his shoes that [were] on his feet.

Joab Though I <u>10_2SA_18_12</u> # And the man said unto Joab, Though I should receive a thousand [shekels] of silver in mine hand, [yet] would I not put forth mine hand against the king's son: for in our hearing the king charged thee and Abishai and Ittai, saying, Beware that none [touch] the young man Absalom.

Joab thy brother <u>10_2SA_02_22</u> # And Abner said again to Asahel, Turn thee aside from following me: wherefore should I smite thee to the ground? how then should I hold up my face to Joab thy brother?

Joab to Cushi <u>10_28A_18_21</u># Then said Joab to Cushi, Go tell the king what thou hast seen. And Cushi bowed himself unto Joab, and ran.

Joab took Amasa <u>10_2SA_20_09</u># And Joab said to Amasa, [Art] thou in health, my brother? And Joab took Amasa by the beard with the right hand to kiss him.

Joab took him <u>10_2SA_03_27</u># And when Abner was returned to Hebron, Joab took him aside in the gate to speak with him quietly, and smote him there under the fifth [rib], that he died, for the blood of Asahel his brother.

Joab two thousand <u>15_EZR_02_06</u># The children of Pahathmoab, of the children of Jeshua [and] Joab, two thousand eight hundred and twelve.

Joab two thousand <u>16_NEH_07_11</u># The children of Pahathmoab, of the children of Jeshua and Joab, two thousand and eight hundred [and] eighteen.

Joab was come <u>10_2SA_03_26</u># And when Joab was come out from David, he sent messengers after Abner, which brought him again from the well of Sirah: but David knew [it] not.

Joab was fled <u>11_1KI_02_29</u># And it was told king Solomon that Joab was fled unto the tabernacle of the LORD; and, behold, [he is] by the altar. Then Solomon sent Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, saying, Go, fall upon him.

Joab was one <u>10_2SA_23_24</u> # Asahel the brother of Joab [was] one of the thirty; Elhanan the son of Dodo of Bethlehem,

Joab was over <u>10_2SA_20_23</u> # Now Joab [was] over all the host of Israel: and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada [was] over the Cherethites and over the Pelethites:

Joab Wherefore Joab <u>13_1CH_21_04</u> # Nevertheless the king's word prevailed against Joab. Wherefore Joab departed, and went throughout all Israel, and came to Jerusalem.

Joab which Amasa <u>10_2SA_17_25</u> # And Absalom made Amasa captain of the host instead of Joab: which Amasa [was] a man's son, whose name [was] Ithra an Israelite, that went in to Abigail the daughter of Nahash, sister to Zeruiah Joab's mother.

Joab with thee <u>10_2SA_14_19</u> # And the king said, [Is not] the hand of Joab with thee in all this? And the woman answered and said, [As] thy soul liveth, my lord the king, none can turn to the right hand or to the left from ought that my lord the king hath spoken: for thy servant Joab, he bade me, and he put all these words in the mouth of thine handmaid:

Joab <u>13_1CH_21_06</u># But Levi and Benjamin counted he not among them: for the king's word was abominable to Joab.

Joab <u>13_1CH_27_34</u> # And after Ahithophel [was] Jehoiada the son of Benaiah, and Abiathar: and the general of the king's army [was] Joab.

Joab <u>10_2SA_19_13</u># And say ye to Amasa, [Art] thou not of my bone, and of my flesh? God do so to me, and more also, if thou be not captain of the host before me continually in the room of Joab.

Joab <u>10_2SA_20_11</u># And one of Joab's men stood by him, and said, He that favoureth Joab, and he that [is] for David, [let him go] after Joab.

Joab's armour compassed <u>10_2SA_18_15</u> # And ten young men that bare Joab's armour compassed about and smote Absalom, and slew him.

Joab's brother and <u>10_2SA_18_02</u> # And David sent forth a third part of the people under the hand of Joab, and a third part under the hand of Abishai the son of Zeruiah, Joab's brother, and a third part under the hand of Ittai the Gittite. And the king said unto the people, I will surely go forth with you myself also.

Joab's field is <u>10_28A_14_30</u> # Therefore he said unto his servants, See, Joab's field is near mine, and he hath barley there; go and set it on fire. And Absalom's servants set the field on fire.

Joab's garment that <u>10_2SA_20_08</u> # When they [were] at the great stone which [is] in Gibeon, Amasa went before them. And Joab's garment that he had put on was girded unto him, and upon it a girdle [with] a

sword fastened upon his loins in the sheath thereof; and as he went forth it fell out.

Joab's hand so <u>10_2SA_20_10</u># But Amasa took no heed to the sword that [was] in Joab's hand: so he smote him therewith in the fifth [rib], and shed out his bowels to the ground, and struck him not again; and he died. So Joab and Abishai his brother pursued after Sheba the son of Bichri.

Joab's men and <u>10_2SA_20_07</u># And there went out after him Joab's men, and the Cherethites, and the Pelethites, and all the mighty men: and they went out of Jerusalem, to pursue after Sheba the son of Bichri.
