joint as he <u>01_GEN_32_25</u># And when he saw that he prevailed not against him, he touched the hollow of his thigh; and the hollow of Jacob's thigh was out of joint, as he wrestled with him.

joint heirs with 45_ROM_08_17 # And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with [him], that we may be also glorified together.

joint my heart 19_PSA_22_14 # I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels.

joint supplieth according <u>49_EPH_04_16</u># From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

joint <u>20_PRO_25_19</u># Confidence in an unfaithful man in time of trouble [is like] a broken tooth, and a foot out of joint.

joints and bands <u>51_COL_02_19</u> # And not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increaseth with the increase of God.

joints and marrow <u>58_HEB_04_12</u># For the word of God [is] quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and [is] a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

joints of his <u>27_DAN_05_06</u> # Then the king's countenance was changed, and his thoughts troubled him, so that the joints of his loins were loosed, and his knees smote one against another.

joints of the 11 1KI 22 34 # And a [certain] man drew a bow at a venture, and smote the king of Israel between the joints of the harness: wherefore he said unto the driver of his chariot, Turn thine hand, and carry me out of the host; for I am wounded.

joints of the <u>14_2CH_18_33</u># And a [certain] man drew a bow at a venture, and smote the king of Israel between the joints of the harness: therefore he said to his chariot man, Turn thine hand, that thou mayest carry me out of the host; for I am wounded.

joints of thy <u>22_SON_07_01</u># How beautiful are thy feet with shoes, O prince's daughter! the joints of thy thighs [are] like jewels, the work of the hands of a cunning workman.
