Joseph after their <u>04\_NUM\_26\_37</u> # These [are] the families of the sons of Ephraim according to those that were numbered of them, thirty and two thousand and five hundred. These [are] the sons of Joseph after their families.

Joseph also went <u>42\_LUK\_02\_04</u># And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; [because he was of the house and lineage of David:]

Joseph and Benjamin 13\_1CH\_02\_02 # Dan, Joseph, and Benjamin, Naphtali, Gad, and Asher.

Joseph and Benjamin <u>05\_DEU\_27\_12</u> # These shall stand upon mount Gerizim to bless the people, when ye are come over Jordan; Simeon, and Levi, and Judah, and Issachar, and Joseph, and Benjamin:

Joseph and Benjamin 01\_GEN\_35\_24 # The sons of Rachel; Joseph, and Benjamin:

Joseph and Benjamin <u>01\_GEN\_46\_19</u> # The sons of Rachel Jacob's wife; Joseph, and Benjamin.

Joseph and called 44\_ACT\_07\_14 # Then sent Joseph, and called his father Jacob to [him], and all his kindred, threescore and fifteen souls.

Joseph and chose 19\_PSA\_78\_67 # Moreover he refused the tabernacle of Joseph, and chose not the tribe of Ephraim:

Joseph and devour 30\_AMO\_05\_06 # Seek the LORD, and ye shall live; lest he break out like fire in the house of Joseph, and devour [it], and [there be] none to quench [it] in Bethel.

Joseph and he <u>01\_GEN\_39\_02</u> # And the LORD was with Joseph, and he was a prosperous man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian.

Joseph and his <u>01\_GEN\_50\_08</u> # And all the house of Joseph, and his brethren, and his father's house: only their little ones, and their flocks, and their herds, they left in the land of Goshen.

Joseph and his <u>42\_LUK\_02\_33</u># And Joseph and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him.

Joseph and his <u>42\_LUK\_02\_43</u># And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and Joseph and his mother knew not [of it].

Joseph by their <u>06\_JOS\_17\_02</u> # There was also [a lot] for the rest of the children of Manasseh by their families; for the children of Abiezer, and for the children of Helek, and for the children of Shechem, and for the children of Hepher, and for the children of Shemida: these [were] the male children of Manasseh the son of Joseph by their families.

Joseph even to <u>06\_JOS\_17\_17</u> # And Joshua spake unto the house of Joseph, [even] to Ephraim and to Manasseh, saying, Thou [art] a great people, and hast great power: thou shalt not have one lot [only]:

Joseph fell from <u>06\_JOS\_16\_01</u> # And the lot of the children of Joseph fell from Jordan by Jericho, unto the water of Jericho on the east, to the wilderness that goeth up from Jericho throughout mount Bethel.

Joseph fell upon <u>01\_GEN\_50\_01</u> # And Joseph fell upon his father's face, and wept upon him, and kissed him.

Joseph for a 19\_PSA\_81\_05 # This he ordained in Joseph [for] a testimony, when he went out through the land of Egypt: [where] I heard a language [that] I understood not.

Joseph for the <u>04\_NUM\_34\_23</u> # The prince of the children of Joseph, for the tribe of the children of Manasseh, Hanniel the son of Ephod.

Joseph for to <u>01\_GEN\_41\_57</u># And all countries came into Egypt to Joseph for to buy [corn]; because that the famine was [so] sore in all lands.

Joseph Forasmuch as <u>01\_GEN\_41\_39</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Forasmuch as God hath showed thee all this, [there is] none so discreet and wise as thou [art]:

Joseph her husband <u>40\_MAT\_01\_19</u># Then Joseph her husband, being a just [man], and not willing to make her a public example, was minded to put her away privily.

Joseph hindermost <u>01\_GEN\_33\_02</u># And he put the handmaids and their children foremost, and Leah and her children after, and Rachel and Joseph hindermost.

Joseph I also <u>01\_GEN\_40\_16</u># When the chief baker saw that the interpretation was good, he said unto Joseph, I also [was] in my dream, and, behold, [I had] three white baskets on my head:

Joseph I am <u>01\_GEN\_41\_44</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I [am] Pharaoh, and without thee shall no man lift up his hand or foot in all the land of Egypt.

Joseph I have 01\_GEN\_41\_15 # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I have dreamed a dream, and [there is]

none that can interpret it: and I have heard say of thee, [that] thou canst understand a dream to interpret it.

Joseph in a <u>40\_MAT\_02\_13</u># And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him.

Joseph in Egypt 40 MAT 02 19 # But when Herod was dead, behold, an angel of the Lord appeareth in a dream to Joseph in Egypt,

Joseph In my <u>01\_GEN\_41\_17</u># And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, In my dream, behold, I stood upon the bank of the river:

Joseph in the <u>01\_GEN\_46\_20</u># And unto Joseph in the land of Egypt were born Manasseh and Ephraim, which Asenath the daughter of Potipherah priest of On bare unto him.

Joses beheld where 41\_MAR\_15\_47 # And Mary Magdalene and Mary [the mother] of Joses beheld where he was laid.

Joses who by <u>44\_ACT\_04\_36</u> # And Joses, who by the apostles was surnamed Barnabas, [which is, being interpreted, The son of consolation,] a Levite, [and] of the country of Cyprus,
