Bethlehemjudah and I <u>07\_JUD\_17\_09</u># And Micah said unto him, Whence comest thou? And he said unto him, I [am] a Levite of Bethlehemjudah, and I go to sojourn where I may find [a place].

Bethlehemjudah And they <u>08\_RUT\_01\_02</u># And the name of the man [was] Elimelech, and the name of his wife Naomi, and the name of his two sons Mahlon and Chilion, Ephrathites of Bethlehemjudah. And they came into the country of Moab, and continued there.

Bethlehemjudah and was <u>07\_JUD\_19\_02</u># And his concubine played the whore against him, and went away from him unto her father's house to Bethlehemjudah, and was there four whole months.

Bethlehemjudah but I <u>07\_JUD\_19\_18</u># And he said unto him, We [are] passing from Bethlehemjudah toward the side of mount Ephraim; from thence [am] I: and I went to Bethlehemjudah, but I [am now] going to the house of the LORD; and there [is] no man that receiveth me to house.

Bethlehemjudah of the <u>07\_JUD\_17\_07</u># And there was a young man out of Bethlehemjudah of the family of Judah, who [was] a Levite, and he sojourned there.

Bethlehemjudah to sojourn <u>07\_JUD\_17\_08</u> # And the man departed out of the city from Bethlehemjudah to sojourn where he could find [a place]: and he came to mount Ephraim to the house of Micah, as he journeyed.

Bethlehemjudah toward the <u>07\_JUD\_19\_18</u># And he said unto him, We [are] passing from Bethlehemjudah toward the side of mount Ephraim; from thence [am] I: and I went to Bethlehemjudah, but I [am now] going to the house of the LORD; and there [is] no man that receiveth me to house.

Bethlehemjudah went to <u>08\_RUT\_01\_01</u> # Now it came to pass in the days when the judges ruled, that there was a famine in the land. And a certain man of Bethlehemjudah went to sojourn in the country of Moab, he, and his wife, and his two sons.

Bethlehemjudah whose name <u>09\_1SA\_17\_12</u># Now David [was] the son of that Ephrathite of Bethlehemjudah, whose name [was] Jesse; and he had eight sons: and the man went among men [for] an old man in the days of Saul.

Bethlehemjudah <u>07\_JUD\_19\_01</u> # And it came to pass in those days, when [there was] no king in Israel, that there was a certain Levite sojourning on the side of mount Ephraim, who took to him a concubine out of Bethlehemjudah.

Judah a desolation <u>24\_JER\_34\_22</u> # Behold, I will command, saith the LORD, and cause them to return to this city; and they shall fight against it, and take it, and burn it with fire: and I will make the cities of Judah a desolation without an inhabitant.

Judah abide in <u>10\_2SA\_11\_11</u># And Uriah said unto David, The ark, and Israel, and Judah, abide in tents; and my lord Joab, and the servants of my lord, are encamped in the open fields; shall I then go into mine house, to eat and to drink, and to lie with my wife? [as] thou livest, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not do this thing.

Judah according to <u>24\_JER\_27\_12</u> # I spake also to Zedekiah king of Judah according to all these words, saying, Bring your necks under the yoke of the king of Babylon, and serve him and his people, and live.

Judah according to <u>06\_JOS\_15\_13</u> # And unto Caleb the son of Jephunneh he gave a part among the children of Judah, according to the commandment of the LORD to Joshua, [even] the city of Arba the father of Anak, which [city is] Hebron.

Judah according to <u>06\_JOS\_15\_20</u> # This [is] the inheritance of the tribe of the children of Judah according to their families.

Judah according to <u>04\_NUM\_10\_14</u># In the first [place] went the standard of the camp of the children of Judah according to their armies: and over his host [was] Nahshon the son of Amminadab.

Judah according to <u>04\_NUM\_26\_22</u># These [are] the families of Judah according to those that were numbered of them, threescore and sixteen thousand and five hundred.

Judah acknowledged them <u>01\_GEN\_38\_26</u># And Judah acknowledged [them], and said, She hath been more righteous than I; because that I gave her not to Shelah my son. And he knew her again no more.

Judah after that <u>14\_2CH\_26\_02</u># He built Eloth, and restored it to Judah, after that the king slept with his fathers.

Judah after that <u>12\_2KI\_14\_22</u># He built Elath, and restored it to Judah, after that the king slept with his fathers.

Judah after their <u>04\_NUM\_26\_20</u> # And the sons of Judah after their families were; of Shelah, the family of the Shelanites: of Pharez, the family of the Pharzites: of Zerah, the family of the Zarhites.

Judah against the <u>24\_JER\_01\_18</u> # For, behold, I have made thee this day a defenced city, and an iron pillar, and brazen walls against the whole land, against the kings of Judah, against the princes thereof, against the priests thereof, and against the people of the land.

Judah against which <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_12</u> # Then the angel of the LORD answered and said, O LORD of hosts, how long wilt thou not have mercy on Jerusalem and on the cities of Judah, against which thou hast had indignation these threescore and ten years?

Judah all the <u>24\_JER\_36\_31</u> # And I will punish him and his seed and his servants for their iniquity; and I will bring upon them, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and upon the men of Judah, all the evil that I have pronounced against them; but they hearkened not.

Judah also out <u>12\_2KI\_23\_27</u> # And the LORD said, I will remove Judah also out of my sight, as I have removed Israel, and will cast off this city Jerusalem which I have chosen, and the house of which I said, My name shall be there.

Judah also shall <u>28\_HOS\_05\_05</u> # And the pride of Israel doth testify to his face: therefore shall Israel and Ephraim fall in their iniquity; Judah also shall fall with them.

Judah also shall <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_14</u> # And Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem; and the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance.

Judah also to <u>12\_2KI\_21\_11</u># Because Manasseh king of Judah hath done these abominations, [and] hath done wickedly above all that the Amorites did, which [were] before him, and hath made Judah also to sin with his idols:

Judah an hundred <u>14\_2CH\_28\_06</u># For Pekah the son of Remaliah slew in Judah an hundred and twenty thousand in one day, [which were] all valiant men; because they had forsaken the LORD God of their fathers.

Judah an inheritor <u>23\_ISA\_65\_09</u># And I will bring forth a seed out of Jacob, and out of Judah an inheritor of my mountains: and mine elect shall inherit it, and my servants shall dwell there.

Judah and according <u>14\_2CH\_30\_06</u># So the posts went with the letters from the king and his princes throughout all Israel and Judah, and according to the commandment of the king, saying, Ye children of Israel, turn again unto the LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, and he will return to the remnant of you, that are escaped out of the hand of the kings of Assyria.

Judah and according <u>24\_JER\_11\_13</u># For [according to] the number of thy cities were thy gods, O Judah; and [according to] the number of the streets of Jerusalem have ye set up altars to [that] shameful thing, [even] altars to burn incense unto Baal.

Judah and against <u>09\_1SA\_27\_10</u> # And Achish said, Whither have ye made a road to day? And David said, Against the south of Judah, and against the south of the Jerahmeelites, and against the south of the Kenites.

Judah and against <u>24\_JER\_36\_02</u> # Take thee a roll of a book, and write therein all the words that I have spoken unto thee against Israel, and against Judah, and against all the nations, from the day I spake unto thee, from the days of Josiah, even unto this day.

Judah and against <u>07\_JUD\_10\_09</u># Moreover the children of Ammon passed over Jordan to fight also against Judah, and against Benjamin, and against the house of Ephraim; so that Israel was sore distressed.

Judah and against <u>38\_ZEC\_12\_02</u> # Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all the people round about, when they shall be in the siege both against Judah [and] against Jerusalem.

Judah and all <u>12\_2KI\_23\_02</u> # And the king went up into the house of the LORD, and all the men of Judah and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem with him, and the priests, and the prophets, and all the people, both small and great: and he read in their ears all the words of the book of the covenant which was found in the house of the LORD.

Judah and all <u>24\_JER\_17\_20</u> # And say unto them, Hear ye the word of the LORD, ye kings of Judah, and all Judah, and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, that enter in by these gates:

Judah and all <u>24\_JER\_17\_20</u> # And say unto them, Hear ye the word of the LORD, ye kings of Judah, and all Judah, and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, that enter in by these gates:

Judah and all <u>24\_JER\_26\_19</u> # Did Hezekiah king of Judah and all Judah put him at all to death? did he not fear the LORD, and besought the LORD, and the LORD repented him of the evil which he had pronounced against them? Thus might we procure great evil against our souls.

Judah and all <u>24\_JER\_44\_28</u> # Yet a small number that escape the sword shall return out of the land of Egypt into the land of Judah, and all the remnant of Judah, that are gone into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, shall know whose words shall stand, mine, or theirs.

Judah and among <u>24\_JER\_11\_09</u># And the LORD said unto me, A conspiracy is found among the men of Judah, and among the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Judah and at <u>24\_JER\_27\_18</u> # But if they [be] prophets, and if the word of the LORD be with them, let them now make intercession to the LORD of hosts, that the vessels which are left in the house of the LORD, and [in] the house of the king of Judah, and at Jerusalem, go not to Babylon.

Judah and behold <u>24\_JER\_44\_02</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Ye have seen all the evil that I have brought upon Jerusalem, and upon all the cities of Judah; and, behold, this day they [are] a

desolation, and no man dwelleth therein,

Judah and Benjamin <u>11\_1KI\_12\_23</u># Speak unto Rehoboam, the son of Solomon, king of Judah, and unto all the house of Judah and Benjamin, and to the remnant of the people, saying,

Judah and Benjamin <u>14\_2CH\_11\_01</u> # And when Rehoboam was come to Jerusalem, he gathered of the house of Judah and Benjamin an hundred and fourscore thousand chosen [men], which were warriors, to fight against Israel, that he might bring the kingdom again to Rehoboam.

Judah and Benjamin <u>14\_2CH\_11\_03</u># Speak unto Rehoboam the son of Solomon, king of Judah, and to all Israel in Judah and Benjamin, saying,

Judah and Benjamin <u>14\_2CH\_11\_12</u># And in every several city [he put] shields and spears, and made them exceeding strong, having Judah and Benjamin on his side.

Judah and Benjamin <u>14\_2CH\_11\_23</u># And he dealt wisely, and dispersed of all his children throughout all the countries of Judah and Benjamin, unto every fenced city: and he gave them victual in abundance. And he desired many wives.

Judah and Benjamin <u>14\_2CH\_15\_02</u> # And he went out to meet Asa, and said unto him, Hear ye me, Asa, and all Judah and Benjamin; The LORD [is] with you, while ye be with him; and if ye seek him, he will be found of you; but if ye forsake him, he will forsake you.

Judah and Benjamin <u>14\_2CH\_15\_08</u> # And when Asa heard these words, and the prophecy of Oded the prophet, he took courage, and put away the abominable idols out of all the land of Judah and Benjamin, and out of the cities which he had taken from mount Ephraim, and renewed the altar of the LORD, that [was] before the porch of the LORD.

Judah and Benjamin <u>14\_2CH\_15\_09</u> # And he gathered all Judah and Benjamin, and the strangers with them out of Ephraim and Manasseh, and out of Simeon: for they fell to him out of Israel in abundance, when they saw that the LORD his God [was] with him.

Judah and Benjamin <u>14\_2CH\_25\_05</u> # Moreover Amaziah gathered Judah together, and made them captains over thousands, and captains over hundreds, according to the houses of [their] fathers, throughout all Judah and Benjamin: and he numbered them from twenty years old and above, and found them three hundred thousand choice [men, able] to go forth to war, that could handle spear and shield.

Judah and Benjamin <u>14\_2CH\_31\_01</u> # Now when all this was finished, all Israel that were present went out to the cities of Judah, and brake the images in pieces, and cut down the groves, and threw down the high places and the altars out of all Judah and Benjamin, in Ephraim also and Manasseh, until they had utterly destroyed them all. Then all the children of Israel returned, every man to his possession, into their own cities.

Judah and Benjamin <u>14\_2CH\_34\_09</u> # And when they came to Hilkiah the high priest, they delivered the money that was brought into the house of God, which the Levites that kept the doors had gathered of the hand of Manasseh and Ephraim, and of all the remnant of Israel, and of all Judah and Benjamin; and they returned to Jerusalem.

Judah and Benjamin <u>15\_EZR\_01\_05</u> # Then rose up the chief of the fathers of Judah and Benjamin, and the priests, and the Levites, with all [them] whose spirit God had raised, to go up to build the house of the LORD which [is] in Jerusalem.

Judah and Benjamin <u>15\_EZR\_04\_01</u> # Now when the adversaries of Judah and Benjamin heard that the children of the captivity builded the temple unto the LORD God of Israel;

Judah and Benjamin <u>15\_EZR\_10\_09</u># Then all the men of Judah and Benjamin gathered themselves together unto Jerusalem within three days. It [was] the ninth month, on the twentieth [day] of the month; and all the people sat in the street of the house of God, trembling because of [this] matter, and for the great rain.

Judah and Benjamin <u>16\_NEH\_12\_34</u> # Judah, and Benjamin, and Shemaiah, and Jeremiah,

Judah and brake <u>14\_2CH\_21\_17</u># And they came up into Judah, and brake into it, and carried away all the substance that was found in the king's house, and his sons also, and his wives; so that there was never a son left him, save Jehoahaz, the youngest of his sons.

Judah and brake <u>14\_2CH\_31\_01</u> # Now when all this was finished, all Israel that were present went out to the cities of Judah, and brake the images in pieces, and cut down the groves, and threw down the high places and the altars out of all Judah and Benjamin, in Ephraim also and Manasseh, until they had utterly destroyed them all. Then all the children of Israel returned, every man to his possession, into their own cities.

Judah and bring <u>05\_DEU\_33\_07</u> # And this [is the blessing] of Judah: and he said, Hear, LORD, the voice of Judah, and bring him unto his people: let his hands be sufficient for him; and be thou an help [to him] from his enemies.

Judah and brought <u>24\_JER\_52\_31</u> # And it came to pass in the seven and thirtieth year of the captivity of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the twelfth month, in the five and twentieth [day] of the month, [that] Evilmerodach king of Babylon in the [first] year of his reign lifted up the head of Jehoiachin king of Judah, and brought him forth out of prison,

Judah and build <u>15\_EZR\_01\_03</u> # Who [is there] among you of all his people? his God be with him, and let him go up to Jerusalem, which [is] in Judah, and build the house of the LORD God of Israel, [he [is] the God,] which [is] in Jerusalem.

Judah and built <u>11\_1KI\_15\_17</u># And Baasha king of Israel went up against Judah, and built Ramah, that he might not suffer any to go out or come in to Asa king of Judah.

Judah and built <u>14\_2CH\_16\_01</u> # In the six and thirtieth year of the reign of Asa Baasha king of Israel came up against Judah, and built Ramah, to the intent that he might let none go out or come in to Asa king of Judah.

Judah and came <u>14\_2CH\_12\_04</u># And he took the fenced cities which [pertained] to Judah, and came to Jerusalem.

Judah and carried <u>14\_2CH\_28\_17</u># For again the Edomites had come and smitten Judah, and carried away captives.

Judah and caused <u>14\_2CH\_21\_11</u># Moreover he made high places in the mountains of Judah, and caused the inhabitants of Jerusalem to commit fornication, and compelled Judah [thereto].

Judah and defiled <u>12\_2KI\_23\_08</u># And he brought all the priests out of the cities of Judah, and defiled the high places where the priests had burned incense, from Geba to Beersheba, and brake down the high places of the gates that [were] in the entering in of the gate of Joshua the governor of the city, which [were] on a man's left hand at the gate of the city.

Judah and dwell 24\_JER\_40\_05 # Now while he was not yet gone back, [he said], Go back also to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, whom the king of Babylon hath made governor over the cities of Judah, and dwell with him among the people: or go wheresoever it seemeth convenient unto thee to go. So the captain of the guard gave him victuals and a reward, and let him go.

Judah and Edom <u>24 JER\_09 26</u> # Egypt, and Judah, and Edom, and the children of Ammon, and Moab, and all [that are] in the utmost corners, that dwell in the wilderness: for all [these] nations [are] uncircumcised, and all the house of Israel [are] uncircumcised in the heart.

Judah and Ekron <u>38\_ZEC\_09\_07</u># And I will take away his blood out of his mouth, and his abominations from between his teeth: but he that remaineth, even he, [shall be] for our God, and he shall be as a governor in Judah, and Ekron as a Jebusite.

Judah and Eliezer <u>15 EZR 10 23</u> # Also of the Levites; Jozabad, and Shimei, and Kelaiah, [the same [is] Kelita,] Pethahiah, Judah, and Eliezer.

Judah and encamped <u>14\_2CH\_32\_01</u> # After these things, and the establishment thereof, Sennacherib king of Assyria came, and entered into Judah, and encamped against the fenced cities, and thought to win them for himself.

Judah and for <u>30\_AMO\_02\_04</u># Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Judah, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because they have despised the law of the LORD, and have not kept his commandments, and their lies caused them to err, after the which their fathers have walked:

Judah and for <u>26\_EZE\_37\_16</u># Moreover, thou son of man, take thee one stick, and write upon it, For Judah, and for the children of Israel his companions: then take another stick, and write upon it, For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and [for] all the house of Israel his companions:

Judah and from <u>24\_JER\_07\_34</u> # Then will I cause to cease from the cities of Judah, and from the streets of Jerusalem, the voice of mirth, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride: for the land shall be desolate.

Judah and from 24\_JER\_17\_26 # And they shall come from the cities of Judah, and from the places about Jerusalem, and from the land of Benjamin, and from the plain, and from the mountains, and from the south, bringing burnt offerings, and sacrifices, and meat offerings, and incense, and bringing sacrifices of praise, unto the house of the LORD.

Judah and from <u>06\_JOS\_11\_21</u> # And at that time came Joshua, and cut off the Anakims from the mountains, from Hebron, from Debir, from Anab, and from all the mountains of Judah, and from all the mountains of Israel: Joshua destroyed them utterly with their cities.

Judah and gather <u>14\_2CH\_24\_05</u> # And he gathered together the priests and the Levites, and said to them, Go out unto the cities of Judah, and gather of all Israel money to repair the house of your God from year to year, and see that ye hasten the matter. Howbeit the Levites hastened [it] not.

Judah and gathered <u>14\_2CH\_23\_02</u> # And they went about in Judah, and gathered the Levites out of all the cities of Judah, and the chief of the fathers of Israel, and they came to Jerusalem.

Judah and gave <u>24\_JER\_39\_10</u># But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left of the poor of the people, which had nothing, in the land of Judah, and gave them vineyards and fields at the same time.

Judah and God <u>14\_2CH\_13\_16</u># And the children of Israel fled before Judah: and God delivered them into their hand.

Judah and had <u>14\_2CH\_17\_09</u># And they taught in Judah, and [had] the book of the law of the LORD with them, and went about throughout all the cities of Judah, and taught the people.

Judah and had <u>14\_2CH\_28\_18</u># The Philistines also had invaded the cities of the low country, and of the south of Judah, and had taken Bethshemesh, and Ajalon, and Gederoth, and Shocho with the villages

thereof, and Timnah with the villages thereof, Gimzo also and the villages thereof: and they dwelt there.

Judah and hath <u>38\_ZEC\_10\_03</u> # Mine anger was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for the LORD of hosts hath visited his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle.

Judah and have <u>24\_JER\_19\_04</u># Because they have forsaken me, and have estranged this place, and have burned incense in it unto other gods, whom neither they nor their fathers have known, nor the kings of Judah, and have filled this place with the blood of innocents;

Judah and he <u>11\_1KI\_12\_32</u># And Jeroboam ordained a feast in the eighth month, on the fifteenth day of the month, like unto the feast that [is] in Judah, and he offered upon the altar. So did he in Bethel, sacrificing unto the calves that he had made: and he placed in Bethel the priests of the high places which he had made.

Judah And he <u>11\_1KI\_13\_14</u># And went after the man of God, and found him sitting under an oak: and he said unto him, [Art] thou the man of God that camest from Judah? And he said, I [am].

Judah And he <u>14\_2CH\_29\_21</u># And they brought seven bullocks, and seven rams, and seven lambs, and seven he goats, for a sin offering for the kingdom, and for the sanctuary, and for Judah. And he commanded the priests the sons of Aaron to offer [them] on the altar of the LORD.

Judah and he <u>12\_2KI\_15\_13</u># Shallum the son of Jabesh began to reign in the nine and thirtieth year of Uzziah king of Judah; and he reigned a full month in Samaria.

Judah and he <u>05\_DEU\_33\_07</u> # And this [is the blessing] of Judah: and he said, Hear, LORD, the voice of Judah, and bring him unto his people: let his hands be sufficient for him; and be thou an help [to him] from his enemies.

Judah and he <u>06\_JOS\_07\_17</u># And he brought the family of Judah; and he took the family of the Zarhites: and he brought the family of the Zarhites man by man; and Zabdi was taken:

Judah and he <u>07\_JUD\_01\_19</u># And the LORD was with Judah; and he drave out [the inhabitants of] the mountain; but could not drive out the inhabitants of the valley, because they had chariots of iron.

Judah and his <u>01\_GEN\_44\_14</u> # And Judah and his brethren came to Joseph's house; for he [was] yet there: and they fell before him on the ground.

Judah and his 24 JER 21 07 # And afterward, saith the LORD, I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, and his servants, and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence, from the sword, and from the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those that seek their life: and he shall smite them with the edge of the sword; he shall not spare them, neither have pity, nor have mercy.

Judah and his 24\_JER\_24\_08 # And as the evil figs, which cannot be eaten, they are so evil; surely thus saith the LORD, So will I give Zedekiah the king of Judah, and his princes, and the residue of Jerusalem, that remain in this land, and them that dwell in the land of Egypt:

Judah and his 24\_JER\_34\_21 # And Zedekiah king of Judah and his princes will I give into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of them that seek their life, and into the hand of the king of Babylon's army, which are gone up from you.

Judah and house <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_13</u> # And it shall come to pass, [that] as ye were a curse among the heathen, O house of Judah, and house of Israel; so will I save you, and ye shall be a blessing: fear not, [but] let your hands be strong.

Judah and I <u>16 NEH\_01\_02</u> # That Hanani, one of my brethren, came, he and [certain] men of Judah; and I asked them concerning the Jews that had escaped, which were left of the captivity, and concerning Jerusalem.

Judah and I <u>38\_ZEC\_10\_06</u># And I will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will save the house of Joseph, and I will bring them again to place them; for I have mercy upon them: and they shall be as though I had not cast them off: for I [am] the LORD their God, and will hear them.

Judah and if <u>10\_2SA\_12\_08</u># And I gave thee thy master's house, and thy master's wives into thy bosom, and gave thee the house of Israel and of Judah; and if [that had been] too little, I would moreover have given unto thee such and such things.

Judah and in <u>13\_1CH\_05\_17</u># All these were reckoned by genealogies in the days of Jotham king of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam king of Israel.

Judah and in <u>14\_2CH\_02\_07</u># Send me now therefore a man cunning to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass, and in iron, and in purple, and crimson, and blue, and that can skill to grave with the cunning men that [are] with me in Judah and in Jerusalem, whom David my father did provide.

Judah and in <u>14\_2CH\_11\_10</u># And Zorah, and Aijalon, and Hebron, which [are] in Judah and in Benjamin fenced cities.

Judah and in <u>14\_2CH\_17\_02</u># And he placed forces in all the fenced cities of Judah, and set garrisons in the land of Judah, and in the cities of Ephraim, which Asa his father had taken.

Judah and in <u>14\_2CH\_27\_04</u> # Moreover he built cities in the mountains of Judah, and in the forests he built castles and towers.

Judah and in <u>12\_2KI\_23\_05</u> # And he put down the idolatrous priests, whom the kings of Judah had ordained to burn incense in the high places in the cities of Judah, and in the places round about Jerusalem; them also that burned incense unto Baal, to the sun, and to the moon, and to the planets, and to all the host of heaven.

Judah and in <u>12\_2KI\_23\_24</u> # Moreover the [workers with] familiar spirits, and the wizards, and the images, and the idols, and all the abominations that were spied in the land of Judah and in Jerusalem, did Josiah put away, that he might perform the words of the law which were written in the book that Hilkiah the priest found in the house of the LORD.

Judah and in <u>30\_AMO\_01\_01</u># The words of Amos, who was among the herdmen of Tekoa, which he saw concerning Israel in the days of Uzziah king of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash king of Israel, two years before the earthquake.

Judah and in <u>15 EZR 09 09</u> # For we [were] bondmen; yet our God hath not forsaken us in our bondage, but hath extended mercy unto us in the sight of the kings of Persia, to give us a reviving, to set up the house of our God, and to repair the desolations thereof, and to give us a wall in Judah and in Jerusalem.

Judah and in <u>28\_HOS\_01\_01</u># The word of the LORD that came unto Hosea, the son of Beeri, in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash, king of Israel.

Judah and in <u>24\_JER\_07\_17</u># Seest thou not what they do in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem?

Judah and in <u>24\_JER\_11\_06</u># Then the LORD said unto me, Proclaim all these words in the cities of

Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem, saying, Hear ye the words of this covenant, and do them.

Judah and in 24\_JER\_31\_23 # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; As yet they shall use this speech in the land of Judah and in the cities thereof, when I shall bring again their captivity; The LORD bless thee, O habitation of justice, [and] mountain of holiness.

Judah and in <u>24\_JER\_32\_44</u> # Men shall buy fields for money, and subscribe evidences, and seal [them], and take witnesses in the land of Benjamin, and in the places about Jerusalem, and in the cities of Judah, and in the cities of the mountains, and in the cities of the valley, and in the cities of the south: for I will cause their captivity to return, saith the LORD.

Judah and in <u>24\_JER\_33\_10</u># Thus saith the LORD; Again there shall be heard in this place, which ye say [shall be] desolate without man and without beast, [even] in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem, that are desolate, without man, and without inhabitant, and without beast,

Judah and in <u>24\_JER\_44\_06</u> # Wherefore my fury and mine anger was poured forth, and was kindled in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem; and they are wasted [and] desolate, as at this day.

Judah and in <u>24\_JER\_44\_09</u> # Have ye forgotten the wickedness of your fathers, and the wickedness of the kings of Judah, and the wickedness of their wives, and your own wickedness, and the wickedness of your wives, which they have committed in the land of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem?

Judah and in 24\_JER\_44\_17 # But we will certainly do whatsoever thing goeth forth out of our own mouth, to burn incense unto the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto her, as we have done, we, and our fathers, our kings, and our princes, in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem: for [then] had we plenty of victuals, and were well, and saw no evil.

Judah and in <u>24\_JER\_44\_21</u> # The incense that ye burned in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem, ye, and your fathers, your kings, and your princes, and the people of the land, did not the LORD remember them, and came it [not] into his mind?

Judah and in <u>16\_NEH\_11\_36</u># And of the Levites [were] divisions [in] Judah, [and] in Benjamin.

Judah and in <u>16\_NEH\_13\_16</u># There dwelt men of Tyre also therein, which brought fish, and all manner of ware, and sold on the sabbath unto the children of Judah, and in Jerusalem.

Judah and inhabitants <u>24\_JER\_04\_04</u> # Circumcise yourselves to the LORD, and take away the foreskins of your heart, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench [it], because of the evil of your doings.

Judah and inhabitants <u>24\_JER\_11\_12</u># Then shall the cities of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem go, and cry unto the gods unto whom they offer incense: but they shall not save them at all in the time of their trouble.

Judah and inhabitants <u>24\_JER\_19\_03</u> # And say, Hear ye the word of the LORD, O kings of Judah, and inhabitants of Jerusalem; Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, the which whosoever heareth, his ears shall tingle.

Judah and Israel <u>11\_1KI\_04\_20</u># Judah and Israel [were] many, as the sand which [is] by the sea in multitude, eating and drinking, and making merry.

Judah and Israel <u>11\_1KI\_04\_25</u># And Judah and Israel dwelt safely, every man under his vine and under his fig tree, from Dan even to Beersheba, all the days of Solomon.

Judah and Israel <u>14\_2CH\_16\_11</u># And, behold, the acts of Asa, first and last, lo, they [are] written in the

book of the kings of Judah and Israel.

Judah and Israel <u>14\_2CH\_28\_26</u> # Now the rest of his acts and of all his ways, first and last, behold, they [are] written in the book of the kings of Judah and Israel.

Judah and Israel <u>14\_2CH\_32\_32</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Hezekiah, and his goodness, behold, they [are] written in the vision of Isaiah the prophet, the son of Amoz, [and] in the book of the kings of Judah and Israel.

Judah and Israel <u>14\_2CH\_35\_18</u># And there was no passover like to that kept in Israel from the days of Samuel the prophet; neither did all the kings of Israel keep such a passover as Josiah kept, and the priests, and the Levites, and all Judah and Israel that were present, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Judah and Israel <u>38\_ZEC\_11\_14</u># Then I cut asunder mine other staff, [even] Bands, that I might break the brotherhood between Judah and Israel.

Judah and Issachar <u>05\_DEU\_27\_12</u> # These shall stand upon mount Gerizim to bless the people, when ye are come over Jordan; Simeon, and Levi, and Judah, and Issachar, and Joseph, and Benjamin:

Judah and Issachar <u>01\_GEN\_35\_23</u> # The sons of Leah; Reuben, Jacob's firstborn, and Simeon, and Levi, and Judah, and Issachar, and Zebulun:

Judah and it <u>30\_AMO\_02\_05</u># But I will send a fire upon Judah, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem.

Judah and Jehoiachin <u>14\_2CH\_36\_08</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Jehoiakim, and his abominations which he did, and that which was found in him, behold, they [are] written in the book of the kings of Israel and Judah: and Jehoiachin his son reigned in his stead.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>13\_1CH\_06\_15</u># And Jehozadak went [into captivity], when the LORD carried away Judah and Jerusalem by the hand of Nebuchadnezzar.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_11\_14</u># For the Levites left their suburbs and their possession, and came to Judah and Jerusalem: for Jeroboam and his sons had cast them off from executing the priest's office unto the LORD:

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_20\_05</u> # And Jehoshaphat stood in the congregation of Judah and Jerusalem, in the house of the LORD, before the new court,

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_20\_17</u> # Ye shall not [need] to fight in this [battle]: set yourselves, stand ye [still], and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD [will be] with you.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_20\_27</u> # Then they returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, and Jehoshaphat in the forefront of them, to go again to Jerusalem with joy; for the LORD had made them to rejoice over their enemies.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_24\_09</u> # And they made a proclamation through Judah and Jerusalem, to bring in to the LORD the collection [that] Moses the servant of God [laid] upon Israel in the wilderness.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_24\_18</u> # And they left the house of the LORD God of their fathers, and served groves and idols: and wrath came upon Judah and Jerusalem for this their trespass.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_24\_23</u> # And it came to pass at the end of the year, [that] the host of Syria came up against him: and they came to Judah and Jerusalem, and destroyed all the princes of the people from among the people, and sent all the spoil of them unto the king of Damascus.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_28\_10</u># And now ye purpose to keep under the children of Judah and Jerusalem for bondmen and bondwomen unto you: [but are there] not with you, even with you, sins against the LORD your God?

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_29\_08</u> # Wherefore the wrath of the LORD was upon Judah and Jerusalem, and he hath delivered them to trouble, to astonishment, and to hissing, as ye see with your eyes.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_32\_12</u># Hath not the same Hezekiah taken away his high places and his altars, and commanded Judah and Jerusalem, saying, Ye shall worship before one altar, and burn incense upon it?

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_32\_25</u> # But Hezekiah rendered not again according to the benefit [done] unto him; for his heart was lifted up: therefore there was wrath upon him, and upon Judah and Jerusalem.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_34\_03</u> # For in the eighth year of his reign, while he was yet young, he began to seek after the God of David his father: and in the twelfth year he began to purge Judah and Jerusalem from the high places, and the groves, and the carved images, and the molten images.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_34\_05</u># And he burnt the bones of the priests upon their altars, and cleansed Judah and Jerusalem.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_34\_29</u> # Then the king sent and gathered together all the elders of Judah and Jerusalem.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_35\_24</u> # His servants therefore took him out of that chariot, and put him in the second chariot that he had; and they brought him to Jerusalem, and he died, and was buried in [one of] the sepulchres of his fathers. And all Judah and Jerusalem mourned for Josiah.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_36\_04</u> # And the king of Egypt made Eliakim his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem, and turned his name to Jehoiakim. And Necho took Jehoahaz his brother, and carried him to Egypt.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_36\_10</u> # And when the year was expired, king Nebuchadnezzar sent, and brought him to Babylon, with the goodly vessels of the house of the LORD, and made Zedekiah his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>12\_2KI\_18\_22</u> # But if ye say unto me, We trust in the LORD our God: [is] not that he, whose high places and whose altars Hezekiah hath taken away, and hath said to Judah and Jerusalem, Ye shall worship before this altar in Jerusalem?

Judah and Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_04\_06</u> # And in the reign of Ahasuerus, in the beginning of his reign, wrote they [unto him] an accusation against the inhabitants of Judah and Jerusalem.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_05\_01</u> # Then the prophets, Haggai the prophet, and Zechariah the son of Iddo, prophesied unto the Jews that [were] in Judah and Jerusalem in the name of the God of Israel, [even] unto them.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_07\_14</u> # Forasmuch as thou art sent of the king, and of his seven counsellors, to inquire concerning Judah and Jerusalem, according to the law of thy God which [is] in thine hand;

Judah and Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_10\_07</u> # And they made proclamation throughout Judah and Jerusalem unto all the children of the captivity, that they should gather themselves together unto Jerusalem;

Judah and Jerusalem 23\_ISA\_01\_01 # The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah.

Judah and Jerusalem 23\_ISA\_02\_01 # The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_04\_03</u># For thus saith the LORD to the men of Judah and Jerusalem, Break up your fallow ground, and sow not among thorns.

Judah and Jerusalem 24\_JER\_19\_07 # And I will make void the counsel of Judah and Jerusalem in this place; and I will cause them to fall by the sword before their enemies, and by the hands of them that seek their lives: and their carcases will I give to be meat for the fowls of the heaven, and for the beasts of the earth.

Judah and Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_27\_20</u> # Which Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took not, when he carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah from Jerusalem to Babylon, and all the nobles of Judah and Jerusalem;

Judah and Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_29\_02</u># [After that Jeconiah the king, and the queen, and the eunuchs, the princes of Judah and Jerusalem, and the carpenters, and the smiths, were departed from Jerusalem;]

Judah and Jerusalem <u>29\_JOE\_03\_01</u> # For, behold, in those days, and in that time, when I shall bring again the captivity of Judah and Jerusalem,

Judah and Jerusalem <u>39\_MAL\_03\_04</u># Then shall the offering of Judah and Jerusalem be pleasant unto the LORD, as in the days of old, and as in former years.

Judah and Judah <u>23\_ISA\_11\_13</u># The envy also of Ephraim shall depart, and the adversaries of Judah shall be cut off: Ephraim shall not envy Judah, and Judah shall not vex Ephraim.

Judah and left <u>11\_1KI\_19\_03</u># And when he saw [that], he arose, and went for his life, and came to Beersheba, which [belongeth] to Judah, and left his servant there.

Judah and left <u>01\_GEN\_29\_35</u> # And she conceived again, and bare a son: and she said, Now will I praise the LORD: therefore she called his name Judah; and left bearing.

Judah and made <u>14\_2CH\_11\_17</u># So they strengthened the kingdom of Judah, and made Rehoboam the son of Solomon strong, three years: for three years they walked in the way of David and Solomon.

Judah and made <u>14\_2CH\_21\_08</u># In his days the Edomites revolted from under the dominion of Judah, and made themselves a king.

Judah and made <u>14\_2CH\_24\_17</u> # Now after the death of Jehoiada came the princes of Judah, and made obeisance to the king. Then the king hearkened unto them.

Judah and made <u>12\_2KI\_08\_20</u># In his days Edom revolted from under the hand of Judah, and made a king over themselves.

Judah and make <u>26\_EZE\_37\_19</u> # Say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will take the stick of Joseph, which [is] in the hand of Ephraim, and the tribes of Israel his fellows, and will put them with him, [even] with the stick of Judah, and make them one stick, and they shall be one in mine hand.

Judah and Mattaniah <u>16\_NEH\_12\_08</u># Moreover the Levites: Jeshua, Binnui, Kadmiel, Sherebiah, Judah, [and] Mattaniah, [which was] over the thanksgiving, he and his brethren.

Judah and now <u>16\_NEH\_06\_07</u> # And thou hast also appointed prophets to preach of thee at Jerusalem, saying, [There is] a king in Judah: and now shall it be reported to the king according to these words. Come now therefore, and let us take counsel together.

Judah and of <u>13\_1CH\_09\_03</u># And in Jerusalem dwelt of the children of Judah, and of the children of Benjamin, and of the children of Ephraim, and Manasseh;

Judah and of <u>12\_2KI\_23\_01</u># And the king sent, and they gathered unto him all the elders of Judah and of Jerusalem.

Judah and of <u>24\_JER\_27\_21</u> # Yea, thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, concerning the vessels that remain [in] the house of the LORD, and [in] the house of the king of Judah and of Jerusalem;

Judah and of <u>16\_NEH\_11\_04</u># And at Jerusalem dwelt [certain] of the children of Judah, and of the children of Benjamin. Of the children of Judah; Athaiah the son of Uzziah, the son of Zechariah, the son of Amariah, the son of Shephatiah, the son of Mahalaleel, of the children of Perez;

Judah and out <u>13\_1CH\_06\_65</u># And they gave by lot out of the tribe of the children of Judah, and out of the tribe of the children of Simeon, and out of the tribe of the children of Benjamin, these cities, which are called by [their] names.

Judah and out <u>14\_2CH\_24\_06</u> # And the king called for Jehoiada the chief, and said unto him, Why hast thou not required of the Levites to bring in out of Judah and out of Jerusalem the collection, [according to the commandment] of Moses the servant of the LORD, and of the congregation of Israel, for the tabernacle of witness?

Judah and out <u>06\_JOS\_21\_04</u># And the lot came out for the families of the Kohathites: and the children of Aaron the priest, [which were] of the Levites, had by lot out of the tribe of Judah, and out of the tribe of Simeon, and out of the tribe of Benjamin, thirteen cities.

Judah and out <u>06\_JOS\_21\_09</u># And they gave out of the tribe of the children of Judah, and out of the tribe of the children of Simeon, these cities which are [here] mentioned by name,

Judah and pitched <u>09\_1SA\_17\_01</u> # Now the Philistines gathered together their armies to battle, and were gathered together at Shochoh, which [belongeth] to Judah, and pitched between Shochoh and Azekah, in Ephesdammin.

Judah and proclaimed <u>12\_2KI\_23\_17</u># Then he said, What title [is] that that I see? And the men of the city told him, [It is] the sepulchre of the man of God, which came from Judah, and proclaimed these things that thou hast done against the altar of Bethel.

Judah and publish <u>24\_JER\_04\_05</u> # Declare ye in Judah, and publish in Jerusalem; and say, Blow ye the trumpet in the land: cry, gather together, and say, Assemble yourselves, and let us go into the defenced cities.

Judah and reigned <u>11\_1KI\_15\_25</u># And Nadab the son of Jeroboam began to reign over Israel in the second year of Asa king of Judah, and reigned over Israel two years.

Judah and reigned <u>11\_1KI\_16\_10</u># And Zimri went in and smote him, and killed him, in the twenty and seventh year of Asa king of Judah, and reigned in his stead.

Judah and reigned <u>11\_1KI\_22\_51</u># Ahaziah the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the seventeenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned two years over Israel.

Judah and reigned <u>12\_2KI\_03\_01</u> # Now Jehoram the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the eighteenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned twelve years.

Judah and said <u>14\_2CH\_16\_07</u> # And at that time Hanani the seer came to Asa king of Judah, and said unto him, Because thou hast relied on the king of Syria, and not relied on the LORD thy God, therefore is the host of the king of Syria escaped out of thine hand.

Judah and said <u>12\_2KI\_10\_13</u># Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who [are] ye? And they answered, We [are] the brethren of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.

Judah and said <u>10\_2SA\_19\_43</u> # And the men of Israel answered the men of Judah, and said, We have ten parts in the king, and we have also more [right] in David than ye: why then did ye despise us, that our advice should not be first had in bringing back our king? And the words of the men of Judah were fiercer than the words of the men of Israel.

Judah and said <u>01\_GEN\_38\_22</u> # And he returned to Judah, and said, I cannot find her; and also the men of the place said, [that] there was no harlot in this [place].

Judah and said <u>16\_NEH\_13\_17</u># Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, and said unto them, What evil thing [is] this that ye do, and profane the sabbath day?

Judah and set <u>14\_2CH\_17\_02</u> # And he placed forces in all the fenced cities of Judah, and set garrisons in the land of Judah, and in the cities of Ephraim, which Asa his father had taken.

Judah and smote <u>13\_1CH\_04\_41</u> # And these written by name came in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah, and smote their tents, and the habitations that were found there, and destroyed them utterly unto this day, and dwelt in their rooms: because [there was] pasture there for their flocks.

Judah and spake <u>24\_JER\_26\_18</u> # Micah the Morasthite prophesied in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah, and spake to all the people of Judah, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Zion shall be plowed [like] a field, and Jerusalem shall become heaps, and the mountain of the house as the high places of a forest.

Judah and speak <u>24\_JER\_22\_01</u># Thus saith the LORD; Go down to the house of the king of Judah, and speak there this word,

Judah and spread <u>07\_JUD\_15\_09</u># Then the Philistines went up, and pitched in Judah, and spread themselves in Lehi.

Judah and taught <u>14\_2CH\_17\_09</u> # And they taught in Judah, and [had] the book of the law of the LORD with them, and went about throughout all the cities of Judah, and taught the people.

Judah and tell <u>24\_JER\_34\_02</u># Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel; Go and speak to Zedekiah king of Judah, and tell him, Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will give this city into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall burn it with fire:

Judah and that <u>24\_JER\_40\_11</u># Likewise when all the Jews that [were] in Moab, and among the Ammonites, and in Edom, and that [were] in all the countries, heard that the king of Babylon had left a remnant of Judah, and that he had set over them Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan;

Judah and the <u>13\_1CH\_06\_55</u># And they gave them Hebron in the land of Judah, and the suburbs thereof round about it.

Judah and the <u>14\_2CH\_13\_13</u> # But Jeroboam caused an ambushment to come about behind them: so they were before Judah, and the ambushment [was] behind them.

Judah and the <u>14\_2CH\_14\_12</u># So the LORD smote the Ethiopians before Asa, and before Judah; and the Ethiopians fled.

Judah and the <u>14\_2CH\_17\_13</u> # And he had much business in the cities of Judah: and the men of war, mighty men of valour, [were] in Jerusalem.

Judah and the <u>14\_2CH\_20\_18</u># And Jehoshaphat bowed his head with [his] face to the ground: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem fell before the LORD, worshipping the LORD.

Judah and the <u>14\_2CH\_21\_13</u># But hast walked in the way of the kings of Israel, and hast made Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to go a whoring, like to the whoredoms of the house of Ahab, and also hast slain thy brethren of thy father's house, [which were] better than thyself:

Judah and the <u>14\_2CH\_22\_08</u># And it came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing judgment upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of the brethren of Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them.

Judah and the <u>14\_2CH\_23\_02</u># And they went about in Judah, and gathered the Levites out of all the cities of Judah, and the chief of the fathers of Israel, and they came to Jerusalem.

Judah and the <u>14\_2CH\_32\_33</u> # And Hezekiah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the chiefest of the sepulchres of the sons of David: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem did him honour at his death. And Manasseh his son reigned in his stead.

Judah and the <u>14\_2CH\_33\_09</u># So Manasseh made Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to err, [and] to do worse than the heathen, whom the LORD had destroyed before the children of Israel.

Judah and the <u>14\_2CH\_34\_30</u> # And the king went up into the house of the LORD, and all the men of Judah, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and the priests, and the Levites, and all the people, great and small: and he read in their ears all the words of the book of the covenant that was found in the house of the LORD.

Judah and the <u>12\_2KI\_03\_09</u> # So the king of Israel went, and the king of Judah, and the king of Edom: and they fetched a compass of seven days' journey: and there was no water for the host, and for the cattle that followed them.

Judah And the <u>10\_2SA\_02\_01</u> # And it came to pass after this, that David inquired of the LORD, saying, Shall I go up into any of the cities of Judah? And the LORD said unto him, Go up. And David said, Whither shall I go up? And he said, Unto Hebron.

Judah and the <u>26\_EZE\_27\_17</u> # Judah, and the land of Israel, they [were] thy merchants: they traded in thy market wheat of Minnith, and Pannag, and honey, and oil, and balm.

Judah and the <u>26\_EZE\_48\_22</u> # Moreover from the possession of the Levites, and from the possession of the city, [being] in the midst [of that] which is the prince's, between the border of Judah and the border of Benjamin, shall be for the prince.

Judah and the <u>37\_HAG\_01\_14</u> # And the LORD stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people; and they came and did work in the house of the LORD of hosts, their God,

Judah and the <u>28\_HOS\_01\_11</u># Then shall the children of Judah and the children of Israel be gathered together, and appoint themselves one head, and they shall come up out of the land: for great [shall be] the day of Jezreel.

Judah and the <u>24\_JER\_08\_01</u> # At that time, saith the LORD, they shall bring out the bones of the kings of Judah, and the bones of his princes, and the bones of the priests, and the bones of the prophets, and the bones of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, out of their graves:

Judah and the <u>29\_JOE\_03\_06</u># The children also of Judah and the children of Jerusalem have ye sold unto the Grecians, that ye might remove them far from their border.

Judah and the <u>06\_JOS\_18\_11</u># And the lot of the tribe of the children of Benjamin came up according to their families: and the coast of their lot came forth between the children of Judah and the children of Joseph.

Judah and the <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_05</u> # And ye shall flee [to] the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and the LORD my God shall come, [and] all the saints with thee.

Judah and their <u>19\_PSA\_68\_27</u># There [is] little Benjamin [with] their ruler, the princes of Judah [and] their council, the princes of Zebulun, [and] the princes of Naphtali.

Judah And there <u>11\_1KI\_15\_07</u># Now the rest of the acts of Abijam, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? And there was war between Abijam and Jeroboam.

Judah and there <u>30\_AMO\_07\_12</u># Also Amaziah said unto Amos, O thou seer, go, flee thee away into the land of Judah, and there eat bread, and prophesy there:

Judah and they <u>11\_1KI\_12\_27</u># If this people go up to do sacrifice in the house of the LORD at Jerusalem, then shall the heart of this people turn again unto their lord, [even] unto Rehoboam king of Judah, and they shall kill me, and go again to Rehoboam king of Judah.

Judah and to <u>37\_HAG\_02\_02</u># Speak now to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and to the residue of the people, saying,

Judah and to 23\_ISA\_36\_07 # But if thou say to me, We trust in the LORD our God: [is it] not he, whose high places and whose altars Hezekiah hath taken away, and said to Judah and to Jerusalem, Ye shall worship before this altar?

Judah and to <u>24\_JER\_11\_02</u># Hear ye the words of this covenant, and speak unto the men of Judah, and to

Judah and to <u>24\_JER\_25\_02</u># The which Jeremiah the prophet spake unto all the people of Judah, and to all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, saying,

Judah and took <u>12\_2KI\_18\_13</u> # Now in the fourteenth year of king Hezekiah did Sennacherib king of Assyria come up against all the fenced cities of Judah, and took them.

Judah and took <u>23\_ISA\_36\_01</u> # Now it came to pass in the fourteenth year of king Hezekiah, [that] Sennacherib king of Assyria came up against all the defenced cities of Judah, and took them.

Judah and troubled <u>15\_EZR\_04\_04</u> # Then the people of the land weakened the hands of the people of Judah, and troubled them in building,

Judah and unto <u>11\_1KI\_12\_23</u># Speak unto Rehoboam, the son of Solomon, king of Judah, and unto all the house of Judah and Benjamin, and to the remnant of the people, saying,

Judah and unto <u>14\_2CH\_32\_09</u> # After this did Sennacherib king of Assyria send his servants to Jerusalem, [but he [himself laid siege] against Lachish, and all his power with him,] unto Hezekiah king of Judah, and unto all Judah that [were] at Jerusalem, saying,

Judah and upon <u>09\_1SA\_30\_14</u> # We made an invasion [upon] the south of the Cherethites, and upon [the coast] which [belongeth] to Judah, and upon the south of Caleb; and we burned Ziklag with fire.

Judah and upon <u>24\_JER\_35\_17</u># Therefore thus saith the LORD God of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring upon Judah and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem all the evil that I have pronounced against them: because I have spoken unto them, but they have not heard; and I have called unto them, but they have not answered.

Judah are they <u>12\_2KI\_13\_12</u># And the rest of the acts of Joash, and all that he did, and his might wherewith he fought against Amaziah king of Judah, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Judah are they <u>12\_2KI\_14\_15</u># Now the rest of the acts of Jehoash which he did, and his might, and how he fought with Amaziah king of Judah, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Judah are they <u>33\_MIC\_01\_05</u># For the transgression of Jacob [is] all this, and for the sins of the house of Israel. What [is] the transgression of Jacob? [is it] not Samaria? and what [are] the high places of Judah? [are they] not Jerusalem?

Judah arose and <u>09\_1SA\_17\_52</u># And the men of Israel and of Judah arose, and shouted, and pursued the Philistines, until thou come to the valley, and to the gates of Ekron. And the wounded of the Philistines fell down by the way to Shaaraim, even unto Gath, and unto Ekron.

Judah as in 25\_LAM\_01\_15 # The Lord hath trodden under foot all my mighty [men] in the midst of me: he hath called an assembly against me to crush my young men: the Lord hath trodden the virgin, the daughter of Judah, [as] in a winepress.

Judah as rottenness <u>28\_HOS\_05\_12</u> # Therefore [will] I [be] unto Ephraim as a moth, and to the house of Judah as rottenness.

Judah at Bethshemesh <u>14\_2CH\_25\_21</u># So Joash the king of Israel went up; and they saw one another in the face, [both] he and Amaziah king of Judah, at Bethshemesh, which [belongeth] to Judah.

Judah at Jerusalem <u>06\_JOS\_15\_63</u># As for the Jebusites the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the children of Judah could not drive them out: but the Jebusites dwell with the children of Judah at Jerusalem unto this day.

Judah Athaiah the <u>16\_NEH\_11\_04</u># And at Jerusalem dwelt [certain] of the children of Judah, and of the children of Benjamin. Of the children of Judah; Athaiah the son of Uzziah, the son of Zechariah, the son of Amariah, the son of Shephatiah, the son of Mahalaleel, of the children of Perez;

Judah be glad <u>19\_PSA\_48\_11</u># Let mount Zion rejoice, let the daughters of Judah be glad, because of thy judgments.

Judah be saved <u>24\_JER\_33\_16</u># In those days shall Judah be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely: and this [is the name] wherewith she shall be called, The LORD our righteousness.

Judah because he <u>12\_2KI\_01\_17</u> # So he died according to the word of the LORD which Elijah had spoken. And Jehoram reigned in his stead in the second year of Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat king of Judah; because he had no son.

Judah because of <u>12\_2KI\_23\_26</u># Notwithstanding the LORD turned not from the fierceness of his great wrath, wherewith his anger was kindled against Judah, because of all the provocations that Manasseh had provoked him withal.

Judah began Ahab <u>11\_1KI\_16\_29</u># And in the thirty and eighth year of Asa king of Judah began Ahab the son of Omri to reign over Israel: and Ahab the son of Omri reigned over Israel in Samaria twenty and two years.

Judah began Baasha <u>11\_1KI\_15\_33</u># In the third year of Asa king of Judah began Baasha the son of Ahijah to reign over all Israel in Tirzah, twenty and four years.

Judah began Elah <u>11\_1KI\_16\_08</u># In the twenty and sixth year of Asa king of Judah began Elah the son of Baasha to reign over Israel in Tirzah, two years.

Judah began Hoshea <u>12\_2KI\_17\_01</u># In the twelfth year of Ahaz king of Judah began Hoshea the son of Elah to reign in Samaria over Israel nine years.

Judah began Jehoash <u>12\_2KI\_13\_10</u> # In the thirty and seventh year of Joash king of Judah began Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] sixteen years.

Judah began Menahem <u>12\_2KI\_15\_17</u> # In the nine and thirtieth year of Azariah king of Judah began Menahem the son of Gadi to reign over Israel, [and reigned] ten years in Samaria.

Judah began Omri <u>11\_1KI\_16\_23</u># In the thirty and first year of Asa king of Judah began Omri to reign over Israel, twelve years: six years reigned he in Tirzah.

Judah began to <u>12\_2KI\_08\_16</u> # And in the fifth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel, Jehoshaphat [being] then king of Judah, Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat king of Judah began to reign.

Judah began to <u>12\_2KI\_16\_01</u># In the seventeenth year of Pekah the son of Remaliah Ahaz the son of Jotham king of Judah began to reign.

Judah began to <u>12\_2KI\_18\_01</u> # Now it came to pass in the third year of Hoshea son of Elah king of Israel, [that] Hezekiah the son of Ahaz king of Judah began to reign.

Judah begin to <u>12\_2KI\_08\_25</u># In the twelfth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel did Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah begin to reign.

Judah Behold your 23\_ISA\_40\_09 # O Zion, that bringest good tidings, get thee up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, that bringest good tidings, lift up thy voice with strength; lift [it] up, be not afraid; say unto the cities of Judah, Behold your God!

Judah brought to <u>14\_2CH\_17\_05</u> # Therefore the LORD stablished the kingdom in his hand; and all Judah brought to Jehoshaphat presents; and he had riches and honour in abundance.

Judah came Nebuchadnezzar 27\_DAN\_01\_01 # In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah came Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon unto Jerusalem, and besieged it.

Judah came this <u>24\_JER\_26\_01</u> # In the beginning of the reign of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah came this word from the LORD, saying,

Judah came this <u>24\_JER\_27\_01</u> # In the beginning of the reign of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah came this word unto Jeremiah from the LORD, saying,

Judah came to <u>10\_2SA\_19\_15</u># So the king returned, and came to Jordan. And Judah came to Gilgal, to go to meet the king, to conduct the king over Jordan.

Judah came toward <u>14\_2CH\_20\_24</u># And when Judah came toward the watch tower in the wilderness, they looked unto the multitude, and, behold, they [were] dead bodies fallen to the earth, and none escaped.

Judah city by <u>14\_2CH\_19\_05</u># And he set judges in the land throughout all the fenced cities of Judah, city by city,

Judah clave unto <u>10\_2SA\_20\_02</u># So every man of Israel went up from after David, [and] followed Sheba the son of Bichri: but the men of Judah clave unto their king, from Jordan even to Jerusalem.

Judah come in <u>24\_JER\_17\_19</u># Thus said the LORD unto me; Go and stand in the gate of the children of the people, whereby the kings of Judah come in, and by the which they go out, and in all the gates of Jerusalem;

Judah could not <u>06\_JOS\_15\_63</u> # As for the Jebusites the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the children of Judah could not drive them out: but the Jebusites dwell with the children of Judah at Jerusalem unto this day.

Judah Daniel Hananiah <u>27\_DAN\_01\_06</u># Now among these were of the children of Judah, Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah:

Judah desolate and <u>24\_JER\_10\_22</u># Behold, the noise of the bruit is come, and a great commotion out of the north country, to make the cities of Judah desolate, [and] a den of dragons.

Judah desolate without <u>24\_JER\_09\_11</u># And I will make Jerusalem heaps, [and] a den of dragons; and I will make the cities of Judah desolate, without an inhabitant.

Judah did give <u>14\_2CH\_30\_24</u> # For Hezekiah king of Judah did give to the congregation a thousand bullocks and seven thousand sheep; and the princes gave to the congregation a thousand bullocks and ten thousand sheep: and a great number of priests sanctified themselves.

Judah did Zachariah <u>12\_2KI\_15\_08</u># In the thirty and eighth year of Azariah king of Judah did Zachariah the son of Jeroboam reign over Israel in Samaria six months.

Judah did Zimri <u>11\_1KI\_16\_15</u># In the twenty and seventh year of Asa king of Judah did Zimri reign seven days in Tirzah. And the people [were] encamped against Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines.

Judah do show <u>10\_2SA\_03\_08</u># Then was Abner very wroth for the words of Ishbosheth, and said, [Am] I a dog's head, which against Judah do show kindness this day unto the house of Saul thy father, to his brethren, and to his friends, and have not delivered thee into the hand of David, that thou chargest me to day with a fault concerning this woman?

Judah dwelt at <u>16\_NEH\_11\_25</u># And for the villages, with their fields, [some] of the children of Judah dwelt at Kirjatharba, and [in] the villages thereof, and at Dibon, and [in] the villages thereof, and at Jekabzeel, and [in] the villages thereof,

Judah dwelt every <u>16\_NEH\_11\_03</u># Now these [are] the chief of the province that dwelt in Jerusalem: but in the cities of Judah dwelt every one in his possession in their cities, [to wit], Israel, the priests, and the Levites, and the Nethinims, and the children of Solomon's servants.

Judah Elihu one <u>13\_1CH\_27\_18</u># Of Judah, Elihu, [one] of the brethren of David: of Issachar, Omri the son of Michael:

Judah Er and <u>13\_1CH\_02\_03</u> # The sons of Judah; Er, and Onan, and Shelah: [which] three were born unto him of the daughter of Shua the Canaanitess. And Er, the firstborn of Judah, was evil in the sight of the LORD; and he slew him.

Judah Er and <u>01\_GEN\_46\_12</u># And the sons of Judah; Er, and Onan, and Shelah, and Pharez, and Zarah: but Er and Onan died in the land of Canaan. And the sons of Pharez were Hezron and Hamul.

Judah even as <u>10\_2SA\_19\_14</u> # And he bowed the heart of all the men of Judah, even as [the heart of] one man; so that they sent [this word] unto the king, Return thou, and all thy servants.

Judah even the <u>23\_ISA\_07\_17</u># The LORD shall bring upon thee, and upon thy people, and upon thy father's house, days that have not come from the day that Ephraim departed from Judah; [even] the king of Assyria.

Judah even to <u>09\_1SA\_30\_26</u># And when David came to Ziklag, he sent of the spoil unto the elders of Judah, [even] to his friends, saying, Behold a present for you of the spoil of the enemies of the LORD;

Judah even to <u>10\_2SA\_24\_07</u> # And came to the strong hold of Tyre, and to all the cities of the Hivites, and of the Canaanites: and they went out to the south of Judah, [even] to Beersheba.

Judah even unto 24\_JER\_25\_03 # From the thirteenth year of Josiah the son of Amon king of Judah, even

unto this day, that [is] the three and twentieth year, the word of the LORD hath come unto me, and I have spoken unto you, rising early and speaking; but ye have not hearkened.

Judah every one <u>15\_EZR\_02\_01</u> # Now these [are] the children of the province that went up out of the captivity, of those which had been carried away, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had carried away unto Babylon, and came again unto Jerusalem and Judah, every one unto his city;

Judah every one <u>16\_NEH\_07\_06</u># These [are] the children of the province, that went up out of the captivity, of those that had been carried away, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had carried away, and came again to Jerusalem and to Judah, every one unto his city;

Judah every one <u>16\_NEH\_11\_20</u># And the residue of Israel, of the priests, [and] the Levites, [were] in all the cities of Judah, every one in his inheritance.

Judah fear ye <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_15</u># So again have I thought in these days to do well unto Jerusalem and to the house of Judah: fear ye not.

Judah feared not <u>24\_JER\_03\_08</u># And I saw, when for all the causes whereby backsliding Israel committed adultery I had put her away, and given her a bill of divorce; yet her treacherous sister Judah feared not, but went and played the harlot also.

Judah first that <u>38\_ZEC\_12\_07</u># The LORD also shall save the tents of Judah first, that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem do not magnify [themselves] against Judah.

Judah followed David <u>10\_2SA\_02\_10</u> # Ishbosheth Saul's son [was] forty years old when he began to reign over Israel, and reigned two years. But the house of Judah followed David.

Judah for all <u>14\_2CH\_19\_11</u> # And, behold, Amariah the chief priest [is] over you in all matters of the LORD; and Zebadiah the son of Ishmael, the ruler of the house of Judah, for all the king's matters: also the Levites [shall be] officers before you. Deal courageously, and the LORD shall be with the good.

Judah For all <u>23\_ISA\_09\_21</u> # Manasseh, Ephraim; and Ephraim, Manasseh: [and] they together [shall be] against Judah. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

Judah for David <u>12\_2KI\_08\_19</u> # Yet the LORD would not destroy Judah for David his servant's sake, as he promised him to give him alway a light, [and] to his children.

Judah for Israel <u>12\_2KI\_14\_28</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Jeroboam, and all that he did, and his might, how he warred, and how he recovered Damascus, and Hamath, [which belonged] to Judah, for Israel, are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Judah for me <u>38\_ZEC\_09\_13</u> # When I have bent Judah for me, filled the bow with Ephraim, and raised up thy sons, O Zion, against thy sons, O Greece, and made thee as the sword of a mighty man.

Judah for that <u>24\_JER\_15\_04</u> # And I will cause them to be removed into all kingdoms of the earth, because of Manasseh the son of Hezekiah king of Judah, for [that] which he did in Jerusalem.

Judah for the <u>14\_2CH\_14\_06</u> # And he built fenced cities in Judah: for the land had rest, and he had no war in those years; because the LORD had given him rest.

Judah forty days <u>26\_EZE\_04\_06</u> # And when thou hast accomplished them, lie again on thy right side, and thou shalt bear the iniquity of the house of Judah forty days: I have appointed thee each day for a year.

Judah from among <u>24\_JER\_12\_14</u># Thus saith the LORD against all mine evil neighbours, that touch the inheritance which I have caused my people Israel to inherit; Behold, I will pluck them out of their land, and

pluck out the house of Judah from among them.

Judah from Dan <u>10\_2SA\_03\_10</u># To translate the kingdom from the house of Saul, and to set up the throne of David over Israel and over Judah, from Dan even to Beersheba.

Judah from Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_27\_20</u># Which Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took not, when he carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah from Jerusalem to Babylon, and all the nobles of Judah and Jerusalem;

Judah from Samaria <u>14\_2CH\_25\_13</u> # But the soldiers of the army which Amaziah sent back, that they should not go with him to battle, fell upon the cities of Judah, from Samaria even unto Bethhoron, and smote three thousand of them, and took much spoil.

Judah from the <u>26\_EZE\_48\_08</u># And by the border of Judah, from the east side unto the west side, shall be the offering which ye shall offer of five and twenty thousand [reeds in] breadth, and [in] length as one of the [other] parts, from the east side unto the west side: and the sanctuary shall be in the midst of it.

Judah from the <u>23\_ISA\_11\_12</u># And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

Judah from the <u>16\_NEH\_05\_14</u> # Moreover from the time that I was appointed to be their governor in the land of Judah, from the twentieth year even unto the two and thirtieth year of Artaxerxes the king, [that is], twelve years, I and my brethren have not eaten the bread of the governor.

Judah gathered themselves <u>14\_2CH\_20\_04</u> # And Judah gathered themselves together, to ask [help] of the LORD: even out of all the cities of Judah they came to seek the LORD.

Judah gave a <u>14\_2CH\_13\_15</u># Then the men of Judah gave a shout: and as the men of Judah shouted, it came to pass, that God smote Jeroboam and all Israel before Abijah and Judah.

Judah Go ye <u>24\_JER\_42\_19</u># The LORD hath said concerning you, O ye remnant of Judah; Go ye not into Egypt: know certainly that I have admonished you this day.

Judah had burned <u>24\_JER\_36\_32</u># Then took Jeremiah another roll, and gave it to Baruch the scribe, the son of Neriah; who wrote therein from the mouth of Jeremiah all the words of the book which Jehoiakim king of Judah had burned in the fire: and there were added besides unto them many like words.

Judah had dedicated <u>12\_2KI\_12\_18</u># And Jehoash king of Judah took all the hallowed things that Jehoshaphat, and Jehoram, and Ahaziah, his fathers, kings of Judah, had dedicated, and his own hallowed things, and all the gold [that was] found in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and in the king's house, and sent [it] to Hazael king of Syria: and he went away from Jerusalem.

Judah had destroyed <u>14\_2CH\_34\_11</u># Even to the artificers and builders gave they [it], to buy hewn stone, and timber for couplings, and to floor the houses which the kings of Judah had destroyed.

Judah had fought <u>07\_JUD\_01\_08</u># Now the children of Judah had fought against Jerusalem, and had taken it, and smitten it with the edge of the sword, and set the city on fire.

Judah had given <u>12\_2KI\_23\_11</u># And he took away the horses that the kings of Judah had given to the sun, at the entering in of the house of the LORD, by the chamber of Nathanmelech the chamberlain, which [was] in the suburbs, and burned the chariots of the sun with fire.

Judah had made <u>12\_2KI\_23\_12</u> # And the altars that [were] on the top of the upper chamber of Ahaz, which the kings of Judah had made, and the altars which Manasseh had made in the two courts of the house of the LORD, did the king beat down, and brake [them] down from thence, and cast the dust of them

into the brook Kidron.

Judah had ordained <u>12\_2KI\_23\_05</u># And he put down the idolatrous priests, whom the kings of Judah had ordained to burn incense in the high places in the cities of Judah, and in the places round about Jerusalem; them also that burned incense unto Baal, to the sun, and to the moon, and to the planets, and to all the host of heaven.

Judah had overlaid <u>12\_2KI\_18\_16</u># At that time did Hezekiah cut off [the gold from] the doors of the temple of the LORD, and [from] the pillars which Hezekiah king of Judah had overlaid, and gave it to the king of Assyria.

Judah had shut <u>24\_JER\_32\_03</u># For Zedekiah king of Judah had shut him up, saying, Wherefore dost thou prophesy, and say, Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will give this city into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall take it;

Judah Hanani with <u>16\_NEH\_12\_36</u># And his brethren, Shemaiah, and Azarael, Milalai, Gilalai, Maai, Nethaneel, and Judah, Hanani, with the musical instruments of David the man of God, and Ezra the scribe before them.

Judah hath burned <u>24\_JER\_36\_28</u># Take thee again another roll, and write in it all the former words that were in the first roll, which Jehoiakim the king of Judah hath burned.

Judah hath dealt <u>39\_MAL\_02\_11</u># Judah hath dealt treacherously, and an abomination is committed in Israel and in Jerusalem; for Judah hath profaned the holiness of the LORD which he loved, and hath married the daughter of a strange god.

Judah hath done <u>12\_2KI\_21\_11</u># Because Manasseh king of Judah hath done these abominations, [and] hath done wickedly above all that the Amorites did, which [were] before him, and hath made Judah also to sin with his idols:

Judah hath multiplied <u>28\_HOS\_08\_14</u># For Israel hath forgotten his Maker, and buildeth temples; and Judah hath multiplied fenced cities: but I will send a fire upon his cities, and it shall devour the palaces thereof.

Judah hath not <u>24\_JER\_03\_10</u># And yet for all this her treacherous sister Judah hath not turned unto me with her whole heart, but feignedly, saith the LORD.

Judah hath profaned <u>39\_MAL\_02\_11</u># Judah hath dealt treacherously, and an abomination is committed in Israel and in Jerusalem; for Judah hath profaned the holiness of the LORD which he loved, and hath married the daughter of a strange god.

Judah hath read <u>12\_2KI\_22\_16</u># Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, and upon the inhabitants thereof, [even] all the words of the book which the king of Judah hath read:

Judah hath thy <u>24\_JER\_14\_19</u># Hast thou utterly rejected Judah? hath thy soul loathed Zion? why hast thou smitten us, and [there is] no healing for us? we looked for peace, and [there is] no good; and for the time of healing, and behold trouble!

Judah have anointed <u>10\_2SA\_02\_07</u># Therefore now let your hands be strengthened, and be ye valiant: for your master Saul is dead, and also the house of Judah have anointed me king over them.

Judah have broken <u>24\_JER\_11\_10</u># They are turned back to the iniquities of their forefathers, which refused to hear my words; and they went after other gods to serve them: the house of Israel and the house of Judah have broken my covenant which I made with their fathers.

Judah have dealt <u>24\_JER\_05\_11</u># For the house of Israel and the house of Judah have dealt very treacherously against me, saith the LORD.

Judah have done <u>24\_JER\_07\_30</u># For the children of Judah have done evil in my sight, saith the LORD: they have set their abominations in the house which is called by my name, to pollute it.

Judah have only <u>24\_JER\_32\_30</u> # For the children of Israel and the children of Judah have only done evil before me from their youth: for the children of Israel have only provoked me to anger with the work of their hands, saith the LORD.

Judah he hath <u>14\_2CH\_28\_09</u> # But a prophet of the LORD was there, whose name [was] Oded: and he went out before the host that came to Samaria, and said unto them, Behold, because the LORD God of your fathers was wroth with Judah, he hath delivered them into your hand, and ye have slain them in a rage [that] reacheth up unto heaven.

Judah he hath <u>28\_HOS\_06\_11</u># Also, O Judah, he hath set an harvest for thee, when I returned the captivity of my people.

Judah he hath <u>25\_LAM\_02\_02</u> # The Lord hath swallowed up all the habitations of Jacob, and hath not pitied: he hath thrown down in his wrath the strong holds of the daughter of Judah; he hath brought [them] down to the ground: he hath polluted the kingdom and the princes thereof.

Judah he is <u>33\_MIC\_01\_09</u> # For her wound [is] incurable; for it is come unto Judah; he is come unto the gate of my people, [even] to Jerusalem.

Judah he made <u>14\_2CH\_28\_25</u> # And in every several city of Judah he made high places to burn incense unto other gods, and provoked to anger the LORD God of his fathers.

Judah he shall <u>23\_ISA\_08\_08</u> # And he shall pass through Judah; he shall overflow and go over, he shall reach [even] to the neck; and the stretching out of his wings shall fill the breadth of thy land, O Immanuel.

Judah He shall <u>24\_JER\_36\_30</u> # Therefore thus saith the LORD of Jehoiakim king of Judah; He shall have none to sit upon the throne of David: and his dead body shall be cast out in the day to the heat, and in the night to the frost.

Judah he was <u>14\_2CH\_20\_31</u> # And Jehoshaphat reigned over Judah: [he was] thirty and five years old when he began to reign, and he reigned twenty and five years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Azubah the daughter of Shilhi.

Judah heard these <u>24\_JER\_26\_10</u># When the princes of Judah heard these things, then they came up from the king's house unto the house of the LORD, and sat down in the entry of the new gate of the LORD'S [house].

Judah his pleasant <u>23\_ISA\_05\_07</u> # For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts [is] the house of Israel, and the men of Judah his pleasant plant: and he looked for judgment, but behold oppression; for righteousness, but behold a cry.

Judah his portion <u>38\_ZEC\_02\_12</u># And the LORD shall inherit Judah his portion in the holy land, and shall choose Jerusalem again.

Judah how much <u>09\_1SA\_23\_03</u> # And David's men said unto him, Behold, we be afraid here in Judah: how much more then if we come to Keilah against the armies of the Philistines?

Judah I come <u>14\_2CH\_35\_21</u> # But he sent ambassadors to him, saying, What have I to do with thee, thou king of Judah? [I come] not against thee this day, but against the house wherewith I have war: for God

commanded me to make haste: forbear thee from [meddling with] God, who [is] with me, that he destroy thee not.

Judah I even <u>28\_HOS\_05\_14</u># For I [will be] unto Ephraim as a lion, and as a young lion to the house of Judah: I, [even] I, will tear and go away; I will take away, and none shall rescue [him].

Judah I would <u>12\_2KI\_03\_14</u> # And Elisha said, [As] the LORD of hosts liveth, before whom I stand, surely, were it not that I regard the presence of Jehoshaphat the king of Judah, I would not look toward thee, nor see thee.

Judah in all 24\_JER\_44\_26 # Therefore hear ye the word of the LORD, all Judah that dwell in the land of Egypt; Behold, I have sworn by my great name, saith the LORD, that my name shall no more be named in the mouth of any man of Judah in all the land of Egypt, saying, The Lord GOD liveth.

Judah in Jerusalem <u>26\_EZE\_21\_20</u> # Appoint a way, that the sword may come to Rabbath of the Ammonites, and to Judah in Jerusalem the defenced.

Judah in Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_34\_06</u># Then Jeremiah the prophet spake all these words unto Zedekiah king of Judah in Jerusalem,

Judah in Riblah <u>24\_JER\_52\_10</u># And the king of Babylon slew the sons of Zedekiah before his eyes: he slew also all the princes of Judah in Riblah.

Judah in the <u>11\_1KI\_22\_41</u># And Jehoshaphat the son of Asa began to reign over Judah in the fourth year of Ahab king of Israel.

Judah in the <u>12\_2KI\_25\_27</u> # And it came to pass in the seven and thirtieth year of the captivity of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the twelfth month, on the seven and twentieth [day] of the month, [that] Evilmerodach king of Babylon in the year that he began to reign did lift up the head of Jehoiachin king of Judah out of prison;

Judah in the <u>24\_JER\_01\_02</u> # To whom the word of the LORD came in the days of Josiah the son of Amon king of Judah, in the thirteenth year of his reign.

Judah in the <u>24\_JER\_25\_01</u> # The word that came to Jeremiah concerning all the people of Judah in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, that [was] the first year of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon;

Judah in the 24\_JER\_28\_01 # And it came to pass the same year, in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, in the fourth year, [and] in the fifth month, [that] Hananiah the son of Azur the prophet, which [was] of Gibeon, spake unto me in the house of the LORD, in the presence of the priests and of all the people, saying,

Judah in the <u>24\_JER\_36\_09</u> # And it came to pass in the fifth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, in the ninth month, [that] they proclaimed a fast before the LORD to all the people in Jerusalem, and to all the people that came from the cities of Judah unto Jerusalem.

Judah in the <u>24\_JER\_39\_01</u># In the ninth year of Zedekiah king of Judah, in the tenth month, came Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon and all his army against Jerusalem, and they besieged it.

Judah in the 24\_JER\_52\_31 # And it came to pass in the seven and thirtieth year of the captivity of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the twelfth month, in the five and twentieth [day] of the month, [that] Evilmerodach king of Babylon in the [first] year of his reign lifted up the head of Jehoiachin king of Judah, and brought him forth out of prison,

Judah in the <u>31\_OBA\_01\_12</u><sup>#</sup> But thou shouldest not have looked on the day of thy brother in the day that he became a stranger; neither shouldest thou have rejoiced over the children of Judah in the day of their destruction; neither shouldest thou have spoken proudly in the day of distress.

Judah into Babylon 24\_JER\_51\_59 # The word which Jeremiah the prophet commanded Seraiah the son of Neriah, the son of Maaseiah, when he went with Zedekiah the king of Judah into Babylon in the fourth year of his reign. And [this] Seraiah [was] a quiet prince.

Judah into his <u>27\_DAN\_01\_02</u> # And the Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand, with part of the vessels of the house of God: which he carried into the land of Shinar to the house of his god; and he brought the vessels into the treasure house of his god.

Judah into the <u>24\_JER\_20\_04</u> # For thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will make thee a terror to thyself, and to all thy friends: and they shall fall by the sword of their enemies, and thine eyes shall behold [it]: and I will give all Judah into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall carry them captive into Babylon, and shall slay them with the sword.

Judah into the 24\_JER\_44\_30 # Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will give Pharaohhophra king of Egypt into the hand of his enemies, and into the hand of them that seek his life; as I gave Zedekiah king of Judah into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, his enemy, and that sought his life.

Judah into the <u>07\_JUD\_01\_16</u># And the children of the Kenite, Moses' father in law, went up out of the city of palm trees with the children of Judah into the wilderness of Judah, which [lieth] in the south of Arad; and they went and dwelt among the people.

Judah is a <u>01\_GEN\_49\_09</u> # Judah [is] a lion's whelp: from the prey, my son, thou art gone up: he stooped down, he couched as a lion, and as an old lion; who shall rouse him up?

Judah is exceeding <u>26\_EZE\_09\_09</u># Then said he unto me, The iniquity of the house of Israel and Judah [is] exceeding great, and the land is full of blood, and the city full of perverseness: for they say, The LORD hath forsaken the earth, and the LORD seeth not.

Judah is fallen <u>23\_ISA\_03\_08</u># For Jerusalem is ruined, and Judah is fallen: because their tongue and their doings [are] against the LORD, to provoke the eyes of his glory.

Judah is God <u>19\_PSA\_76\_01</u># To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm [or] Song of Asaph. In Judah [is] God known: his name [is] great in Israel.

Judah is gone <u>25\_LAM\_01\_03</u> # Judah is gone into captivity because of affliction, and because of great servitude: she dwelleth among the heathen, she findeth no rest: all her persecutors overtook her between the straits.

Judah is like <u>26\_EZE\_25\_08</u> # Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because that Moab and Seir do say, Behold, the house of Judah [is] like unto all the heathen;

Judah is my <u>19\_PSA\_108\_08</u># Gilead [is] mine; Manasseh [is] mine; Ephraim also [is] the strength of mine head; Judah [is] my lawgiver;

Judah is my <u>19\_PSA\_60\_07</u># Gilead [is] mine, and Manasseh [is] mine; Ephraim also [is] the strength of mine head; Judah [is] my lawgiver;

Judah is written <u>24\_JER\_17\_01</u># The sin of Judah [is] written with a pen of iron, [and] with the point of a diamond: [it is] graven upon the table of their heart, and upon the horns of your altars;

Judah Israel and <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_19</u># And I said unto the angel that talked with me, What [be] these? And he

answered me, These [are] the horns which have scattered Judah, Israel, and Jerusalem.

Judah Issachar and <u>13\_1CH\_02\_01</u># These [are] the sons of Israel; Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah, Issachar, and Zebulun,

Judah itself and <u>24\_JER\_31\_24</u> # And there shall dwell in Judah itself, and in all the cities thereof together, husbandmen, and they [that] go forth with flocks.

Judah Jehoahaz the <u>12\_2KI\_13\_01</u># In the three and twentieth year of Joash the son of Ahaziah king of Judah Jehoahaz the son of Jehu began to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] seventeen years.

Judah Jehoram the <u>12\_2KI\_08\_16</u># And in the fifth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel, Jehoshaphat [being] then king of Judah, Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat king of Judah began to reign.

Judah Jeroboam the <u>12\_2KI\_14\_23</u># In the fifteenth year of Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah Jeroboam the son of Joash king of Israel began to reign in Samaria, [and reigned] forty and one years.

Judah join himself <u>14\_2CH\_20\_35</u># And after this did Jehoshaphat king of Judah join himself with Ahaziah king of Israel, who did very wickedly:

Judah joy and <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_19</u># Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The fast of the fourth [month], and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts; therefore love the truth and peace.

Judah judge I <u>23 ISA 05 03</u> # And now, O inhabitants of Jerusalem, and men of Judah, judge, I pray you, betwixt me and my vineyard.

Judah keep thy <u>34\_NAH\_01\_15</u> # Behold upon the mountains the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace! O Judah, keep thy solemn feasts, perform thy vows: for the wicked shall no more pass through thee; he is utterly cut off.

Judah kept not <u>12\_2KI\_17\_19</u># Also Judah kept not the commandments of the LORD their God, but walked in the statutes of Israel which they made.

Judah Let us <u>14\_2CH\_14\_07</u> # Therefore he said unto Judah, Let us build these cities, and make about [them] walls, and towers, gates, and bars, [while] the land [is] yet before us; because we have sought the LORD our God, we have sought [him], and he hath given us rest on every side. So they built and prospered.

Judah like an <u>38\_ZEC\_12\_06</u> # In that day will I make the governors of Judah like an hearth of fire among the wood, and like a torch of fire in a sheaf; and they shall devour all the people round about, on the right hand and on the left: and Jerusalem shall be inhabited again in her own place, [even] in Jerusalem.

Judah lived after <u>14\_2CH\_25\_25</u># And Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah lived after the death of Joash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel fifteen years.

Judah lived after <u>12\_2KI\_14\_17</u># And Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah lived after the death of Jehoash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel fifteen years.

Judah looked back <u>14\_2CH\_13\_14</u> # And when Judah looked back, behold, the battle [was] before and behind: and they cried unto the LORD, and the priests sounded with the trumpets.

Judah looked one <u>12\_2KI\_14\_11</u># But Amaziah would not hear. Therefore Jehoash king of Israel went up; and he and Amaziah king of Judah looked one another in the face at Bethshemesh, which [belongeth] to Judah.

Judah loved David <u>09\_18A\_18\_16</u># But all Israel and Judah loved David, because he went out and came in before them.

Judah low because <u>14\_2CH\_28\_19</u># For the LORD brought Judah low because of Ahaz king of Israel; for he made Judah naked, and transgressed sore against the LORD.

Judah made all <u>02\_EXO\_38\_22</u> # And Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah, made all that the LORD commanded Moses.

Judah mourneth and <u>24\_JER\_14\_02</u> # Judah mourneth, and the gates thereof languish; they are black unto the ground; and the cry of Jerusalem is gone up.

Judah mourning and <u>25\_LAM\_02\_05</u># The Lord was as an enemy: he hath swallowed up Israel, he hath swallowed up all her palaces: he hath destroyed his strong holds, and hath increased in the daughter of Judah mourning and lamentation.

Judah Nahshon the <u>04\_NUM\_01\_07</u># Of Judah; Nahshon the son of Amminadab.

Judah naked and <u>14\_2CH\_28\_19</u># For the LORD brought Judah low because of Ahaz king of Israel; for he made Judah naked, and transgressed sore against the LORD.

Judah namely Hebron <u>13\_1CH\_06\_57</u># And to the sons of Aaron they gave the cities of Judah, [namely], Hebron, [the city] of refuge, and Libnah with her suburbs, and Jattir, and Eshtemoa, with their suburbs,

Judah Nevertheless in <u>11\_1KI\_15\_23</u># The rest of all the acts of Asa, and all his might, and all that he did, and the cities which he built, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? Nevertheless in the time of his old age he was diseased in his feet.

Judah none was <u>11\_1KI\_15\_22</u># Then king Asa made a proclamation throughout all Judah; none [was] exempted: and they took away the stones of Ramah, and the timber thereof, wherewith Baasha had builded; and king Asa built with them Geba of Benjamin, and Mizpah.

Judah nor a <u>01\_GEN\_49\_10</u># The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him [shall] the gathering of the people [be].

Judah nor any <u>12\_2KI\_18\_05</u># He trusted in the LORD God of Israel; so that after him was none like him among all the kings of Judah, nor [any] that were before him.

Judah O God <u>19\_PSA\_63\_01</u> # A Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah. O God, thou [art] my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;

Judah of his <u>24\_JER\_51\_05</u># For Israel [hath] not [been] forsaken, nor Judah of his God, of the LORD of hosts; though their land was filled with sin against the Holy One of Israel.

Judah of the <u>08\_RUT\_04\_12</u> # And let thy house be like the house of Pharez, whom Tamar bare unto Judah, of the seed which the LORD shall give thee of this young woman.

Judah offend and <u>28\_HOS\_04\_15</u> # Though thou, Israel, play the harlot, [yet] let not Judah offend; and come not ye unto Gilgal, neither go ye up to Bethaven, nor swear, The LORD liveth.

Judah one gate <u>26\_EZE\_48\_31</u> # And the gates of the city [shall be] after the names of the tribes of Israel: three gates northward; one gate of Reuben, one gate of Judah, one gate of Levi.

Judah only <u>11\_1KI\_12\_20</u># And it came to pass, when all Israel heard that Jeroboam was come again, that

they sent and called him unto the congregation, and made him king over all Israel: there was none that followed the house of David, but the tribe of Judah only.

Judah only <u>12\_2KI\_17\_18</u># Therefore the LORD was very angry with Israel, and removed them out of his sight: there was none left but the tribe of Judah only.

Judah out of <u>12\_2KI\_25\_27</u> # And it came to pass in the seven and thirtieth year of the captivity of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the twelfth month, on the seven and twentieth [day] of the month, [that] Evilmerodach king of Babylon in the year that he began to reign did lift up the head of Jehoiachin king of Judah out of prison;

Judah Pekah the <u>12\_2KI\_15\_27</u># In the two and fiftieth year of Azariah king of Judah Pekah the son of Remaliah began to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] twenty years.

Judah Pekahiah the <u>12\_2KI\_15\_23</u> # In the fiftieth year of Azariah king of Judah Pekahiah the son of Menahem began to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] two years.

Judah perish <u>24\_JER\_40\_15</u># Then Johanan the son of Kareah spake to Gedaliah in Mizpah secretly, saying, Let me go, I pray thee, and I will slay Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and no man shall know [it]: wherefore should he slay thee, that all the Jews which are gathered unto thee should be scattered, and the remnant in Judah perish?

Judah Pharez Hezron <u>13\_1CH\_04\_01</u># The sons of Judah; Pharez, Hezron, and Carmi, and Hur, and Shobal.

Judah pitch throughout <u>04\_NUM\_02\_03</u># And on the east side toward the rising of the sun shall they of the standard of the camp of Judah pitch throughout their armies: and Nahshon the son of Amminadab [shall be] captain of the children of Judah.

Judah prevailed above <u>13\_1CH\_05\_02</u># For Judah prevailed above his brethren, and of him [came] the chief ruler; but the birthright [was] Joseph's:]

Judah prevailed because <u>14\_2CH\_13\_18</u># Thus the children of Israel were brought under at that time, and the children of Judah prevailed, because they relied upon the LORD God of their fathers.

Judah put him <u>24\_JER\_26\_19</u># Did Hezekiah king of Judah and all Judah put him at all to death? did he not fear the LORD, and besought the LORD, and the LORD repented him of the evil which he had pronounced against them? Thus might we procure great evil against our souls.

Judah regardeth not <u>27\_DAN\_06\_13</u> # Then answered they and said before the king, That Daniel, which [is] of the children of the captivity of Judah, regardeth not thee, O king, nor the decree that thou hast signed, but maketh his petition three times a day.

Judah Rehoboam reigned <u>11\_1KI\_12\_17</u># But [as for] the children of Israel which dwelt in the cities of Judah, Rehoboam reigned over them.

Judah Rehoboam reigned <u>14\_2CH\_10\_17</u># But [as for] the children of Israel that dwelt in the cities of Judah, Rehoboam reigned over them.

Judah Rehoboam was <u>11\_1KI\_14\_21</u># And Rehoboam the son of Solomon reigned in Judah. Rehoboam [was] forty and one years old when he began to reign, and he reigned seventeen years in Jerusalem, the city which the LORD did choose out of all the tribes of Israel, to put his name there. And his mother's name [was] Naamah an Ammonitess.

Judah reigned <u>14\_2CH\_22\_01</u># And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in

his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.

Judah rejoiced at <u>14\_2CH\_15\_15</u># And all Judah rejoiced at the oath: for they had sworn with all their heart, and sought him with their whole desire; and he was found of them: and the LORD gave them rest round about.

Judah rejoiced because <u>19\_PSA\_97\_08</u># Zion heard, and was glad; and the daughters of Judah rejoiced because of thy judgments, O LORD.

Judah rejoiced for <u>16\_NEH\_12\_44</u> # And at that time were some appointed over the chambers for the treasures, for the offerings, for the firstfruits, and for the tithes, to gather into them out of the fields of the cities the portions of the law for the priests and Levites: for Judah rejoiced for the priests and for the Levites that waited.

Judah rejoiced <u>14\_2CH\_30\_25</u> # And all the congregation of Judah, with the priests and the Levites, and all the congregation that came out of Israel, and the strangers that came out of the land of Israel, and that dwelt in Judah, rejoiced.

Judah returned to <u>14\_2CH\_19\_01</u># And Jehoshaphat the king of Judah returned to his house in peace to Jerusalem.

Judah Rezin the <u>12\_2KI\_15\_37</u> # In those days the LORD began to send against Judah Rezin the king of Syria, and Pekah the son of Remaliah.

Judah round about <u>06\_JOS\_15\_12</u> # And the west border [was] to the great sea, and the coast [thereof]. This [is] the coast of the children of Judah round about according to their families.

Judah said Bring <u>01\_GEN\_38\_24</u> # And it came to pass about three months after, that it was told Judah, saying, Tamar thy daughter in law hath played the harlot; and also, behold, she [is] with child by whoredom. And Judah said, Bring her forth, and let her be burnt.

Judah said Let <u>01\_GEN\_38\_23</u># And Judah said, Let her take [it] to her, lest we be shamed: behold, I sent this kid, and thou hast not found her.

Judah said The <u>16\_NEH\_04\_10</u> # And Judah said, The strength of the bearers of burdens is decayed, and [there is] much rubbish; so that we are not able to build the wall.

Judah said unto <u>01\_GEN\_37\_26</u># And Judah said unto his brethren, What profit [is it] if we slay our brother, and conceal his blood?

Judah said unto <u>01\_GEN\_38\_08</u> # And Judah said unto Onan, Go in unto thy brother's wife, and marry her, and raise up seed to thy brother.

Judah said unto <u>01\_GEN\_43\_08</u># And Judah said unto Israel his father, Send the lad with me, and we will arise and go; that we may live, and not die, both we, and thou, [and] also our little ones.

Judah said unto <u>07\_JUD\_01\_03</u># And Judah said unto Simeon his brother, Come up with me into my lot, that we may fight against the Canaanites; and I likewise will go with thee into thy lot. So Simeon went with him.

Judah said What <u>01\_GEN\_44\_16</u> # And Judah said, What shall we say unto my lord? what shall we speak? or how shall we clear ourselves? God hath found out the iniquity of thy servants: behold, we [are] my lord's servants, both we, and [he] also with whom the cup is found.

Judah said Why <u>07\_JUD\_15\_10</u> # And the men of Judah said, Why are ye come up against us? And they answered, To bind Samson are we come up, to do to him as he hath done to us.

Judah saith the <u>24\_JER\_13\_11</u># For as the girdle cleaveth to the loins of a man, so have I caused to cleave unto me the whole house of Israel and the whole house of Judah, saith the LORD; that they might be unto me for a people, and for a name, and for a praise, and for a glory: but they would not hear.

Judah saith the <u>24\_JER\_30\_03</u># For, lo, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will bring again the captivity of my people Israel and Judah, saith the LORD: and I will cause them to return to the land that I gave to their fathers, and they shall possess it.

Judah sat before <u>26\_EZE\_08\_01</u> # And it came to pass in the sixth year, in the sixth [month], in the fifth [day] of the month, [as] I sat in mine house, and the elders of Judah sat before me, that the hand of the Lord GOD fell there upon me.

Judah sat each <u>11\_1KI\_22\_10</u># And the king of Israel and Jehoshaphat the king of Judah sat each on his throne, having put on their robes, in a void place in the entrance of the gate of Samaria; and all the prophets prophesied before them.

Judah sat either <u>14\_2CH\_18\_09</u> # And the king of Israel and Jehoshaphat king of Judah sat either of them on his throne, clothed in [their] robes, and they sat in a void place at the entering in of the gate of Samaria; and all the prophets prophesied before them.

Judah saw her <u>01\_GEN\_38\_15</u># When Judah saw her, he thought her [to be] an harlot; because she had covered her face.

Judah saw his <u>28\_HOS\_05\_13</u> # When Ephraim saw his sickness, and Judah [saw] his wound, then went Ephraim to the Assyrian, and sent to king Jareb: yet could he not heal you, nor cure you of your wound.

Judah saw it <u>24\_JER\_03\_07</u># And I said after she had done all these [things], Turn thou unto me. But she returned not. And her treacherous sister Judah saw [it].

Judah saw them <u>24\_JER\_39\_04</u> # And it came to pass, [that] when Zedekiah the king of Judah saw them, and all the men of war, then they fled, and went forth out of the city by night, by the way of the king's garden, by the gate betwixt the two walls: and he went out the way of the plain.

Judah saw there <u>01\_GEN\_38\_02</u> # And Judah saw there a daughter of a certain Canaanite, whose name [was] Shuah; and he took her, and went in unto her.

Judah saw this <u>12\_2KI\_09\_27</u># But when Ahaziah the king of Judah saw [this], he fled by the way of the garden house. And Jehu followed after him, and said, Smite him also in the chariot. [And they did so] at the going up to Gur, which [is] by Ibleam. And he fled to Megiddo, and died there.

Judah say Hear <u>24\_JER\_21\_11</u># And touching the house of the king of Judah, [say], Hear ye the word of the LORD;

Judah saying I <u>37\_HAG\_02\_21</u># Speak to Zerubbabel, governor of Judah, saying, I will shake the heavens and the earth;

Judah saying Let <u>12\_2KI\_19\_10</u># Thus shall ye speak to Hezekiah king of Judah, saying, Let not thy God in whom thou trustest deceive thee, saying, Jerusalem shall not be delivered into the hand of the king of Assyria.

Judah saying Let <u>23\_ISA\_37\_10</u> # Thus shall ye speak to Hezekiah king of Judah, saying, Let not thy God, in whom thou trustest, deceive thee, saying, Jerusalem shall not be given into the hand of the king of

Assyria.

Judah saying Tamar <u>01\_GEN\_38\_24</u> # And it came to pass about three months after, that it was told Judah, saying, Tamar thy daughter in law hath played the harlot; and also, behold, she [is] with child by whoredom. And Judah said, Bring her forth, and let her be burnt.

Judah saying The <u>14\_2CH\_25\_18</u> # And Joash king of Israel sent to Amaziah king of Judah, saying, The thistle that [was] in Lebanon sent to the cedar that [was] in Lebanon, saying, Give thy daughter to my son to wife: and there passed by a wild beast that [was] in Lebanon, and trode down the thistle.

Judah saying The <u>12\_2KI\_03\_07</u> # And he went and sent to Jehoshaphat the king of Judah, saying, The king of Moab hath rebelled against me: wilt thou go with me against Moab to battle? And he said, I will go up: I [am] as thou [art], my people as thy people, [and] my horses as thy horses.

Judah saying The <u>12\_2KI\_14\_09</u> # And Jehoash the king of Israel sent to Amaziah king of Judah, saying, The thistle that [was] in Lebanon sent to the cedar that [was] in Lebanon, saying, Give thy daughter to my son to wife: and there passed by a wild beast that [was] in Lebanon, and trode down the thistle.

Judah saying Thus <u>11\_1KI\_13\_21</u># And he cried unto the man of God that came from Judah, saying, Thus saith the LORD, Forasmuch as thou hast disobeyed the mouth of the LORD, and hast not kept the commandment which the LORD thy God commanded thee,

Judah saying Thus <u>24\_JER\_26\_18</u># Micah the Morasthite prophesied in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah, and spake to all the people of Judah, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Zion shall be plowed [like] a field, and Jerusalem shall become heaps, and the mountain of the house as the high places of a forest.

Judah saying Why <u>10\_2SA\_19\_11</u> # And king David sent to Zadok and to Abiathar the priests, saying, Speak unto the elders of Judah, saying, Why are ye the last to bring the king back to his house? seeing the speech of all Israel is come to the king, [even] to his house.

Judah saying <u>24\_JER\_05\_20</u> # Declare this in the house of Jacob, and publish it in Judah, saying,

Judah saying <u>24\_JER\_35\_01</u> # The word which came unto Jeremiah from the LORD in the days of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, saying,

Judah saying <u>24\_JER\_45\_01</u> # The word that Jeremiah the prophet spake unto Baruch the son of Neriah, when he had written these words in a book at the mouth of Jeremiah, in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, saying,

Judah saying <u>24\_JER\_49\_34</u># The word of the LORD that came to Jeremiah the prophet against Elam in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, saying,

Judah sent many <u>16\_NEH\_06\_17</u># Moreover in those days the nobles of Judah sent many letters unto Tobiah, and [the letters] of Tobiah came unto them.

Judah sent the <u>01\_GEN\_38\_20</u># And Judah sent the kid by the hand of his friend the Adullamite, to receive [his] pledge from the woman's hand: but he found her not.

Judah sent to <u>12\_2KI\_18\_14</u> # And Hezekiah king of Judah sent to the king of Assyria to Lachish, saying, I have offended; return from me: that which thou puttest on me will I bear. And the king of Assyria appointed unto Hezekiah king of Judah three hundred talents of silver and thirty talents of gold.

Judah sent unto 24\_JER\_29\_03 # By the hand of Elasah the son of Shaphan, and Gemariah the son of Hilkiah, [whom Zedekiah king of Judah sent unto Babylon to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon] saying,

Judah seven years <u>10\_2SA\_05\_05</u> # In Hebron he reigned over Judah seven years and six months: and in Jerusalem he reigned thirty and three years over all Israel and Judah.

Judah shall abide <u>06\_JOS\_18\_05</u># And they shall divide it into seven parts: Judah shall abide in their coast on the south, and the house of Joseph shall abide in their coasts on the north.

Judah shall again <u>23\_ISA\_37\_31</u> # And the remnant that is escaped of the house of Judah shall again take root downward, and bear fruit upward:

Judah shall be <u>23\_ISA\_11\_13</u># The envy also of Ephraim shall depart, and the adversaries of Judah shall be cut off: Ephraim shall not envy Judah, and Judah shall not vex Ephraim.

Judah shall be <u>23\_ISA\_19\_17</u> # And the land of Judah shall be a terror unto Egypt, every one that maketh mention thereof shall be afraid in himself, because of the counsel of the LORD of hosts, which he hath determined against it.

Judah shall be <u>24\_JER\_13\_19</u># The cities of the south shall be shut up, and none shall open [them]: Judah shall be carried away captive all of it, it shall be wholly carried away captive.

Judah shall be <u>24\_JER\_19\_13</u># And the houses of Jerusalem, and the houses of the kings of Judah, shall be defiled as the place of Tophet, because of all the houses upon whose roofs they have burned incense unto all the host of heaven, and have poured out drink offerings unto other gods.

Judah shall be 24\_JER\_23\_06 # In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this [is] his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

Judah shall be <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_21</u> # Yea, every pot in Jerusalem and in Judah shall be holiness unto the LORD of hosts: and all they that sacrifice shall come and take of them, and seethe therein: and in that day there shall be no more the Canaanite in the house of the LORD of hosts.

Judah shall dwell <u>29\_JOE\_03\_20</u> # But Judah shall dwell for ever, and Jerusalem from generation to generation.

Judah shall flow <u>29\_JOE\_03\_18</u># And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] the mountains shall drop down new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters, and a fountain shall come forth of the house of the LORD, and shall water the valley of Shittim.

Judah shall go <u>07\_JUD\_01\_02</u># And the LORD said, Judah shall go up: behold, I have delivered the land into his hand.

Judah shall go <u>07\_JUD\_20\_18</u> # And the children of Israel arose, and went up to the house of God, and asked counsel of God, and said, Which of us shall go up first to the battle against the children of Benjamin? And the LORD said, Judah [shall go up] first.

Judah shall not <u>23\_ISA\_11\_13</u># The envy also of Ephraim shall depart, and the adversaries of Judah shall be cut off: Ephraim shall not envy Judah, and Judah shall not vex Ephraim.

Judah shall not <u>24\_JER\_32\_04</u># And Zedekiah king of Judah shall not escape out of the hand of the Chaldeans, but shall surely be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon, and shall speak with him mouth to mouth, and his eyes shall behold his eyes;

Judah shall plow <u>28\_HOS\_10\_11</u># And Ephraim [is as] an heifer [that is] taught, [and] loveth to tread out [the corn]; but I passed over upon her fair neck: I will make Ephraim to ride; Judah shall plow, [and] Jacob shall break his clods.

Judah shall say <u>38\_ZEC\_12\_05</u># And the governors of Judah shall say in their heart, The inhabitants of Jerusalem [shall be] my strength in the LORD of hosts their God.

Judah shall the <u>24\_JER\_33\_13</u> # In the cities of the mountains, in the cities of the vale, and in the cities of the south, and in the land of Benjamin, and in the places about Jerusalem, and in the cities of Judah, shall the flocks pass again under the hands of him that telleth [them], saith the LORD.

Judah shall walk <u>24\_JER\_03\_18</u> # In those days the house of Judah shall walk with the house of Israel, and they shall come together out of the land of the north to the land that I have given for an inheritance unto your fathers.

Judah shall yet <u>12\_2KI\_19\_30</u> # And the remnant that is escaped of the house of Judah shall yet again take root downward, and bear fruit upward.

Judah shouted it <u>14\_2CH\_13\_15</u># Then the men of Judah gave a shout: and as the men of Judah shouted, it came to pass, that God smote Jeroboam and all Israel before Abijah and Judah.

Judah so that <u>14\_2CH\_17\_10</u> # And the fear of the LORD fell upon all the kingdoms of the lands that [were] round about Judah, so that they made no war against Jehoshaphat.

Judah so that <u>14\_2CH\_32\_23</u># And many brought gifts unto the LORD to Jerusalem, and presents to Hezekiah king of Judah: so that he was magnified in the sight of all nations from thenceforth.

Judah so that <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_21</u> # Then said I, What come these to do? And he spake, saying, These [are] the horns which have scattered Judah, so that no man did lift up his head: but these are come to fray them, to cast out the horns of the Gentiles, which lifted up [their] horn over the land of Judah to scatter it.

Judah some treading <u>16\_NEH\_13\_15</u> # In those days saw I in Judah [some] treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all [manner of] burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I testified [against them] in the day wherein they sold victuals.

Judah spake unto <u>01\_GEN\_43\_03</u># And Judah spake unto him, saying, The man did solemnly protest unto us, saying, Ye shall not see my face, except your brother [be] with you.

Judah stolen thee <u>10\_2SA\_19\_41</u> # And, behold, all the men of Israel came to the king, and said unto the king, Why have our brethren the men of Judah stolen thee away, and have brought the king, and his household, and all David's men with him, over Jordan?

Judah stood before <u>14\_2CH\_20\_13</u> # And all Judah stood before the LORD, with their little ones, their wives, and their children.

Judah sworn unto <u>16\_NEH\_06\_18</u># For [there were] many in Judah sworn unto him, because he [was] the son in law of Shechaniah the son of Arah; and his son Johanan had taken the daughter of Meshullam the son of Berechiah.

Judah that are <u>24\_JER\_44\_24</u> # Moreover Jeremiah said unto all the people, and to all the women, Hear the word of the LORD, all Judah that [are] in the land of Egypt:

Judah that are <u>24\_JER\_44\_27</u># Behold, I will watch over them for evil, and not for good: and all the men of Judah that [are] in the land of Egypt shall be consumed by the sword and by the famine, until there be an end of them.

Judah that are <u>24\_JER\_44\_28</u> # Yet a small number that escape the sword shall return out of the land of

Egypt into the land of Judah, and all the remnant of Judah, that are gone into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, shall know whose words shall stand, mine, or theirs.

Judah that bare <u>13\_1CH\_12\_24</u># The children of Judah that bare shield and spear [were] six thousand and eight hundred, ready armed to the war.

Judah that come <u>24\_JER\_36\_06</u># Therefore go thou, and read in the roll, which thou hast written from my mouth, the words of the LORD in the ears of the people in the LORD'S house upon the fasting day: and also thou shalt read them in the ears of all Judah that come out of their cities.

Judah that dwell <u>24\_JER\_44\_26</u># Therefore hear ye the word of the LORD, all Judah that dwell in the land of Egypt; Behold, I have sworn by my great name, saith the LORD, that my name shall no more be named in the mouth of any man of Judah in all the land of Egypt, saying, The Lord GOD liveth.

Judah that dwelt <u>14\_2CH\_31\_06</u> # And [concerning] the children of Israel and Judah, that dwelt in the cities of Judah, they also brought in the tithe of oxen and sheep, and the tithe of holy things which were consecrated unto the LORD their God, and laid [them] by heaps.

Judah that enter <u>24\_JER\_07\_02</u> # Stand in the gate of the LORD's house, and proclaim there this word, and say, Hear the word of the LORD, all [ye of] Judah, that enter in at these gates to worship the LORD.

Judah that have 24 JER 44 12 # And I will take the remnant of Judah, that have set their faces to go into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, and they shall all be consumed, [and] fall in the land of Egypt; they shall [even] be consumed by the sword [and] by the famine: they shall die, from the least even unto the greatest, by the sword and by the famine: and they shall be an execration, [and] an astonishment, and a curse, and a reproach.

Judah that Rezin 23\_ISA\_07\_01 # And it came to pass in the days of Ahaz the son of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, [that] Rezin the king of Syria, and Pekah the son of Remaliah, king of Israel, went up toward Jerusalem to war against it, but could not prevail against it.

Judah that sent 24\_JER\_37\_07 # Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel; Thus shall ye say to the king of Judah, that sent you unto me to inquire of me; Behold, Pharaoh's army, which is come forth to help you, shall return to Egypt into their own land.

Judah that sittest <u>24\_JER\_22\_02</u> # And say, Hear the word of the LORD, O king of Judah, that sittest upon the throne of David, thou, and thy servants, and thy people that enter in by these gates:

Judah that they <u>26\_EZE\_08\_17</u># Then he said unto me, Hast thou seen [this], O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? for they have filled the land with violence, and have returned to provoke me to anger: and, lo, they put the branch to their nose.

Judah that they <u>19\_PSA\_69\_35</u># For God will save Zion, and will build the cities of Judah: that they may dwell there, and have it in possession.

Judah that this <u>24\_JER\_36\_01</u> # And it came to pass in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, [that] this word came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, saying,

Judah that was <u>24\_JER\_25\_01</u> # The word that came to Jeremiah concerning all the people of Judah in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, that [was] the first year of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon;

Judah the captains <u>14\_2CH\_17\_14</u># And these [are] the numbers of them according to the house of their fathers: Of Judah, the captains of thousands; Adnah the chief, and with him mighty men of valour three hundred thousand.

Judah the hand <u>14\_2CH\_30\_12</u> # Also in Judah the hand of God was to give them one heart to do the commandment of the king and of the princes, by the word of the LORD.

Judah the high <u>14\_2CH\_14\_05</u> # Also he took away out of all the cities of Judah the high places and the images: and the kingdom was quiet before him.

Judah the house <u>13\_1CH\_28\_04</u> # Howbeit the LORD God of Israel chose me before all the house of my father to be king over Israel for ever: for he hath chosen Judah [to be] the ruler; and of the house of Judah, the house of my father; and among the sons of my father he liked me to make [me] king over all Israel:

Judah the king's <u>11\_1KI\_01\_09</u># And Adonijah slew sheep and oxen and fat cattle by the stone of Zoheleth, which [is] by Enrogel, and called all his brethren the king's sons, and all the men of Judah the king's servants:

Judah the mount <u>19\_PSA\_78\_68</u> # But chose the tribe of Judah, the mount Zion which he loved.

Judah the son <u>14\_2CH\_25\_23</u> # And Joash the king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Joash, the son of Jehoahaz, at Bethshemesh, and brought him to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim to the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

Judah Thou art 24\_JER\_22\_06 # For thus saith the LORD unto the king's house of Judah; Thou [art] Gilead unto me, [and] the head of Lebanon: [yet] surely I will make thee a wilderness, [and] cities [which] are not inhabited.

Judah three hundred <u>14\_2CH\_14\_08</u> # And Asa had an army [of men] that bare targets and spears, out of Judah three hundred thousand; and out of Benjamin, that bare shields and drew bows, two hundred and fourscore thousand: all these [were] mighty men of valour.

Judah three hundred <u>12\_2KI\_18\_14</u># And Hezekiah king of Judah sent to the king of Assyria to Lachish, saying, I have offended; return from me: that which thou puttest on me will I bear. Judah to leave <u>24\_JER\_44\_07</u> # Therefore now thus saith the LORD, the God of hosts, the God of Israel; Wherefore commit ye [this] great evil against your souls, to cut off from you man and woman, child and suckling, out of Judah, to leave you none to remain;

Judah to meet <u>10\_2SA\_19\_16</u># And Shimei the son of Gera, a Benjamite, which [was] of Bahurim, hasted and came down with the men of Judah to meet king David.

Judah to remove <u>12\_2KI\_24\_03</u> # Surely at the commandment of the LORD came [this] upon Judah, to remove [them] out of his sight, for the sins of Manasseh, according to all that he did;

Judah to scatter <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_21</u> # Then said I, What come these to do? And he spake, saying, These [are] the horns which have scattered Judah, so that no man did lift up his head: but these are come to fray them, to cast out the horns of the Gentiles, which lifted up [their] horn over the land of Judah to scatter it.

Judah to seek <u>14\_2CH\_14\_04</u> # And commanded Judah to seek the LORD God of their fathers, and to do the law and the commandment.

Judah to the <u>24\_JER\_44\_14</u> # So that none of the remnant of Judah, which are gone into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, shall escape or remain, that they should return into the land of Judah, to the which they have a desire to return to dwell there: for none shall return but such as shall escape.

Judah took advice <u>14\_2CH\_25\_17</u># Then Amaziah king of Judah took advice, and sent to Joash, the son of Jehoahaz, the son of Jeho, king of Israel, saying, Come, let us see one another in the face.

Judah took all <u>12\_2KI\_12\_18</u> # And Jehoash king of Judah took all the hallowed things that Jehoshaphat, and Jehoram, and Ahaziah, his fathers, kings of Judah, had dedicated, and his own hallowed things, and all the gold [that was] found in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and in the king's house, and sent [it] to Hazael king of Syria: and he went away from Jerusalem.

Judah took Azariah <u>12\_2KI\_14\_21</u> # And all the people of Judah took Azariah, which [was] sixteen years old, and made him king instead of his father Amaziah.

Judah took Gaza <u>07\_JUD\_01\_18</u># Also Judah took Gaza with the coast thereof, and Askelon with the coast thereof, and Ekron with the coast thereof.

Judah took of <u>06\_JOS\_07\_01</u> # But the children of Israel committed a trespass in the accursed thing: for Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel.

Judah took Uzziah <u>14\_2CH\_26\_01</u># Then all the people of Judah took Uzziah, who [was] sixteen years old, and made him king in the room of his father Amaziah.

Judah toward the <u>06\_JOS\_15\_21</u># And the uttermost cities of the tribe of the children of Judah toward the coast of Edom southward were Kabzeel, and Eder, and Jagur,

Judah until he <u>12\_2KI\_24\_20</u># For through the anger of the LORD it came to pass in Jerusalem and Judah, until he had cast them out from his presence, that Zedekiah rebelled against the king of Babylon.

Judah unto Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_36\_09</u> # And it came to pass in the fifth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, in the ninth month, [that] they proclaimed a fast before the LORD to all the people in Jerusalem, and to all the people that came from the cities of Judah unto Jerusalem.

Judah unto the <u>05\_DEU\_34\_02</u># And all Naphtali, and the land of Ephraim, and Manasseh, and all the land of Judah, unto the utmost sea,

Judah was seven <u>10\_2SA\_02\_11</u># And the time that David was king in Hebron over the house of Judah was seven years and six months.

Judah went out <u>12\_2KI\_24\_12</u> # And Jehoiachin the king of Judah went out to the king of Babylon, he, and his mother, and his servants, and his princes, and his officers: and the king of Babylon took him in the eighth year of his reign.

Judah went to <u>07\_JUD\_15\_11</u># Then three thousand men of Judah went to the top of the rock Etam, and said to Samson, Knowest thou not that the Philistines [are] rulers over us? what [is] this [that] thou hast done unto us? And he said unto them, As they did unto me, so have I done unto them.

Judah went up <u>11\_1KI\_22\_29</u># So the king of Israel and Jehoshaphat the king of Judah went up to Ramothgilead.

Judah went up <u>14\_2CH\_18\_28</u># So the king of Israel and Jehoshaphat the king of Judah went up to Ramothgilead.

Judah went up <u>07\_JUD\_01\_04</u> # And Judah went up; and the LORD delivered the Canaanites and the Perizzites into their hand: and they slew of them in Bezek ten thousand men.

Judah went with <u>07\_JUD\_01\_17</u> # And Judah went with Simeon his brother, and they slew the Canaanites that inhabited Zephath, and utterly destroyed it. And the name of the city was called Hormah.

Judah were an <u>04\_NUM\_02\_09</u> # All that were numbered in the camp of Judah [were] an hundred thousand and fourscore thousand and six thousand and four hundred, throughout their armies. These shall first set forth.

Judah were Er <u>13\_1CH\_04\_21</u> # The sons of Shelah the son of Judah [were], Er the father of Lecah, and Laadah the father of Mareshah, and the families of the house of them that wrought fine linen, of the house of Ashbea,

Judah were Er <u>04\_NUM\_26\_19</u># The sons of Judah [were] Er and Onan: and Er and Onan died in the land of Canaan.

Judah were fiercer <u>10\_2SA\_19\_43</u> # And the men of Israel answered the men of Judah, and said, We have ten parts in the king, and we have also more [right] in David than ye: why then did ye despise us, that our advice should not be first had in bringing back our king? And the words of the men of Judah were fiercer than the words of the men of Israel.

Judah were five <u>13\_1CH\_02\_04</u># And Tamar his daughter in law bare him Pharez and Zerah. All the sons of Judah [were] five.

Judah were five <u>10\_2SA\_24\_09</u> # And Joab gave up the sum of the number of the people unto the king: and there were in Israel eight hundred thousand valiant men that drew the sword; and the men of Judah [were] five hundred thousand men.

Judah were like <u>28\_HOS\_05\_10</u># The princes of Judah were like them that remove the bound: [therefore] I will pour out my wrath upon them like water.

Judah were oppressed 24\_JER\_50\_33 # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The children of Israel and the children of Judah [were] oppressed together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go.

Judah were the <u>24\_JER\_22\_24</u># [As] I live, saith the LORD, though Coniah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah were the signet upon my right hand, yet would I pluck thee thence;

Judah were threescore <u>04\_NUM\_01\_27</u># Those that were numbered of them, [even] of the tribe of Judah, [were] threescore and fourteen thousand and six hundred.

Judah what shall <u>28\_HOS\_06\_04</u> # O Ephraim, what shall I do unto thee? O Judah, what shall I do unto thee? for your goodness [is] as a morning cloud, and as the early dew it goeth away.

Judah when he <u>23\_ISA\_38\_09</u> # The writing of Hezekiah king of Judah, when he had been sick, and was recovered of his sickness:

Judah when they <u>26\_EZE\_25\_03</u> # And say unto the Ammonites, Hear the word of the Lord GOD; Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thou saidst, Aha, against my sanctuary, when it was profaned; and against the land of Israel, when it was desolate; and against the house of Judah, when they went into captivity;

Judah wherefore they <u>07\_JUD\_18\_12</u> # And they went up, and pitched in Kirjathjearim, in Judah: wherefore they called that place Mahanehdan unto this day: behold, [it is] behind Kirjathjearim.

Judah which are 24\_JER\_29\_22 # And of them shall be taken up a curse by all the captivity of Judah which [are] in Babylon, saying, The LORD make thee like Zedekiah and like Ahab, whom the king of Babylon roasted in the fire;

Judah which are <u>24\_JER\_33\_04</u># For thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, concerning the houses of this city, and concerning the houses of the kings of Judah, which are thrown down by the mounts, and by the sword;

Judah which are <u>24\_JER\_44\_14</u> # So that none of the remnant of Judah, which are gone into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, shall escape or remain, that they should return into the land of Judah, to the which they have a desire to return to dwell there: for none shall return but such as shall escape.

Judah which come 24\_JER\_26\_02 # Thus saith the LORD; Stand in the court of the LORD'S house, and speak unto all the cities of Judah, which come to worship in the LORD'S house, all the words that I command thee to speak unto them; diminish not a word:

Judah which he <u>33\_MIC\_01\_01</u> # The word of the LORD that came to Micah the Morasthite in the days of Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah, which he saw concerning Samaria and Jerusalem.

Judah which lieth <u>07\_JUD\_01\_16</u> # And the children of the Kenite, Moses' father in law, went up out of the city of palm trees with the children of Judah into the wilderness of Judah, which [lieth] in the south of Arad; and they went and dwelt among the people.

Judah which reigned <u>24\_JER\_22\_11</u># For thus saith the LORD touching Shallum the son of Josiah king of Judah, which reigned instead of Josiah his father, which went forth out of this place; He shall not return thither any more:

Judah which sent <u>12\_2KI\_22\_18</u># But to the king of Judah which sent you to inquire of the LORD, thus

shall ye say to him, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, [As touching] the words which thou hast heard;

Judah which swear 23\_ISA\_48\_01 # Hear ye this, O house of Jacob, which are called by the name of Israel, and are come forth out of the waters of Judah, which swear by the name of the LORD, and make mention of the God of Israel, [but] not in truth, nor in righteousness.

Judah which they <u>24\_JER\_11\_17</u># For the LORD of hosts, that planted thee, hath pronounced evil against thee, for the evil of the house of Israel and of the house of Judah, which they have done against themselves to provoke me to anger in offering incense unto Baal.

Judah which they <u>24\_JER\_32\_32</u> # Because of all the evil of the children of Israel and of the children of Judah, which they have done to provoke me to anger, they, their kings, their princes, their priests, and their prophets, and the men of Judah, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Judah which was <u>24\_JER\_32\_01</u># The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD in the tenth year of Zedekiah king of Judah, which [was] the eighteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar.

Judah which were <u>24\_JER\_40\_01</u> # The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, after that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had let him go from Ramah, when he had taken him being bound in chains among all that were carried away captive of Jerusalem and Judah, which were carried away captive unto Babylon.

Judah Who is <u>14\_2CH\_36\_23</u># Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, All the kingdoms of the earth hath the LORD God of heaven given me; and he hath charged me to build him an house in Jerusalem, which [is] in Judah. Who [is there] among you of all his people? The LORD his God [be] with him, and let him go up.

Judah who sent <u>14\_2CH\_34\_26</u> # And as for the king of Judah, who sent you to inquire of the LORD, so shall ye say unto him, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel [concerning] the words which thou hast heard;

Judah who was <u>07\_JUD\_17\_07</u># And there was a young man out of Bethlehemjudah of the family of Judah, who [was] a Levite, and he sojourned there.

Judah who were <u>13\_1CH\_09\_01</u># So all Israel were reckoned by genealogies; and, behold, they [were] written in the book of the kings of Israel and Judah, [who] were carried away to Babylon for their transgression.

Judah whom I <u>24\_JER\_24\_05</u> # Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel; Like these good figs, so will I acknowledge them that are carried away captive of Judah, whom I have sent out of this place into the land of the Chaldeans for [their] good.

Judah whom Nebuchadnezzar <u>12\_2KI\_25\_22</u> # And [as for] the people that remained in the land of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon had left, even over them he made Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, the son of Shaphan, ruler.

Judah whom Nebuchadnezzar <u>17\_EST\_02\_06</u> # Who had been carried away from Jerusalem with the captivity which had been carried away with Jeconiah king of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had carried away.

Judah whom the <u>27\_DAN\_05\_13</u> # Then was Daniel brought in before the king. [And] the king spake and said unto Daniel, [Art] thou that Daniel, which [art] of the children of the captivity of Judah, whom the king my father brought out of Jewry?

Judah will hear <u>24\_JER\_36\_03</u> # It may be that the house of Judah will hear all the evil which I purpose to do unto them; that they may return every man from his evil way; that I may forgive their iniquity and their sin.

Judah will I <u>24\_JER\_20\_05</u># Moreover I will deliver all the strength of this city, and all the labours thereof, and all the precious things thereof, and all the treasures of the kings of Judah will I give into the hand of their enemies, which shall spoil them, and take them, and carry them to Babylon.

Judah Wilt thou <u>14\_2CH\_18\_03</u># And Ahab king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat king of Judah, Wilt thou go with me to Ramothgilead? And he answered him, I [am] as thou [art], and my people as thy people; and [we will be] with thee in the war.

Judah with all <u>24\_JER\_28\_04</u> # And I will bring again to this place Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah, with all the captives of Judah, that went into Babylon, saith the LORD: for I will break the yoke of the king of Babylon.

Judah with the <u>11\_1KI\_12\_21</u># And when Rehoboam was come to Jerusalem, he assembled all the house of Judah, with the tribe of Benjamin, an hundred and fourscore thousand chosen men, which were warriors, to fight against the house of Israel, to bring the kingdom again to Rehoboam the son of Solomon.

Judah with the <u>14\_2CH\_30\_25</u> # And all the congregation of Judah, with the priests and the Levites, and all the congregation that came out of Israel, and the strangers that came out of the land of Israel, and that dwelt in Judah, rejoiced.

Judah with the <u>24\_JER\_24\_01</u> # The LORD showed me, and, behold, two baskets of figs [were] set before the temple of the LORD, after that Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon had carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah, and the princes of Judah, with the carpenters and smiths, from Jerusalem, and had brought them to Babylon.

Judah with the <u>24\_JER\_31\_27</u># Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will sow the house of Israel and the house of Judah with the seed of man, and with the seed of beast.

Judah with the <u>06\_JOS\_21\_11</u># And they gave them the city of Arba the father of Anak, which [city is] Hebron, in the hill [country] of Judah, with the suburbs thereof round about it.

Judah with thee <u>14\_2CH\_25\_19</u> # Thou sayest, Lo, thou hast smitten the Edomites; and thine heart lifteth thee up to boast: abide now at home; why shouldest thou meddle to [thine] hurt, that thou shouldest fall, [even] thou, and Judah with thee?

Judah with thee <u>12\_2KI\_14\_10</u># Thou hast indeed smitten Edom, and thine heart hath lifted thee up: glory [of this], and tarry at home: for why shouldest thou meddle to [thy] hurt, that thou shouldest fall, [even] thou, and Judah with thee?

Judah within three <u>10\_2SA\_20\_04</u> # Then said the king to Amasa, Assemble me the men of Judah within three days, and be thou here present.

Judah Ye shall 23\_ISA\_44\_26 # That confirmeth the word of his servant, and performeth the counsel of his messengers; that saith to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be inhabited; and to the cities of Judah, Ye shall be built, and I will raise up the decayed places thereof:

Judah yet out <u>33\_MIC\_05\_02</u> # But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, [though] thou be little among the thousands of Judah, [yet] out of thee shall he come forth unto me [that is] to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth [have been] from of old, from everlasting.

Judah yet ruleth <u>28\_HOS\_11\_12</u># Ephraim compasseth me about with lies, and the house of Israel with deceit: but Judah yet ruleth with God, and is faithful with the saints.

Judah <u>13\_1CH\_02\_10</u> # And Ram begat Amminadab; and Amminadab begat Nahshon, prince of the

# children of Judah;

Judah <u>13\_1CH\_04\_27</u># And Shimei had sixteen sons and six daughters; but his brethren had not many children, neither did all their family multiply, like to the children of Judah.

Judah <u>13\_1CH\_09\_04</u> # Uthai the son of Ammihud, the son of Omri, the son of Imri, the son of Bani, of the children of Pharez the son of Judah.

Judah <u>11\_1KI\_01\_35</u># Then ye shall come up after him, that he may come and sit upon my throne; for he shall be king in my stead: and I have appointed him to be ruler over Israel and over Judah.

Judah <u>11\_1KI\_02\_32</u> # And the LORD shall return his blood upon his own head, who fell upon two men more righteous and better than he, and slew them with the sword, my father David not knowing [thereof, to wit], Abner the son of Ner, captain of the host of Israel, and Amasa the son of Jether, captain of the host of Judah.

Judah <u>11\_1KI\_12\_27</u># If this people go up to do sacrifice in the house of the LORD at Jerusalem, then shall the heart of this people turn again unto their lord, [even] unto Rehoboam king of Judah, and they shall kill me, and go again to Rehoboam king of Judah.

Judah <u>11\_1KI\_13\_12</u># And their father said unto them, What way went he? For his sons had seen what way the man of God went, which came from Judah.

Judah <u>11\_1KI\_14\_29</u># Now the rest of the acts of Rehoboam, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>11\_1KI\_15\_01</u># Now in the eighteenth year of king Jeroboam the son of Nebat reigned Abijam over Judah.

Judah <u>11\_1KI\_15\_09</u># And in the twentieth year of Jeroboam king of Israel reigned Asa over Judah.

Judah <u>11\_1KI\_15\_17</u># And Baasha king of Israel went up against Judah, and built Ramah, that he might not suffer any to go out or come in to Asa king of Judah.

Judah <u>11\_1KI\_22\_45</u># Now the rest of the acts of Jehoshaphat, and his might that he showed, and how he warred, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>09\_1SA\_15\_04</u> # And Saul gathered the people together, and numbered them in Telaim, two hundred thousand footmen, and ten thousand men of Judah.

Judah <u>09\_1SA\_23\_23</u># See therefore, and take knowledge of all the lurking places where he hideth himself, and come ye again to me with the certainty, and I will go with you: and it shall come to pass, if he be in the land, that I will search him out throughout all the thousands of Judah.

Judah <u>09\_1SA\_30\_16</u># And when he had brought him down, behold, [they were] spread abroad upon all the earth, eating and drinking, and dancing, because of all the great spoil that they had taken out of the land of the Philistines, and out of the land of Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_09\_11</u># And the king made [of] the algum trees terraces to the house of the LORD, and to the king's palace, and harps and psalteries for singers: and there were none such seen before in the land of Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_11\_05</u># And Rehoboam dwelt in Jerusalem, and built cities for defence in Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_13\_01</u> # Now in the eighteenth year of king Jeroboam began Abijah to reign over Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_13\_15</u># Then the men of Judah gave a shout: and as the men of Judah shouted, it came to pass, that God smote Jeroboam and all Israel before Abijah and Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_16\_01</u># In the six and thirtieth year of the reign of Asa Baasha king of Israel came up against Judah, and built Ramah, to the intent that he might let none go out or come in to Asa king of Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_17\_06</u># And his heart was lifted up in the ways of the LORD: moreover he took away the high places and groves out of Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_17\_07</u> # Also in the third year of his reign he sent to his princes, [even] to Benhail, and to Obadiah, and to Zechariah, and to Nethaneel, and to Michaiah, to teach in the cities of Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_17\_19</u># These waited on the king, beside [those] whom the king put in the fenced cities throughout all Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_20\_03</u># And Jehoshaphat feared, and set himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_21\_12</u> # And there came a writing to him from Elijah the prophet, saying, Thus saith the LORD God of David thy father, Because thou hast not walked in the ways of Jehoshaphat thy father, nor in the ways of Asa king of Judah,

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_22\_10</u> # But when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal of the house of Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_25\_21</u># So Joash the king of Israel went up; and they saw one another in the face, [both] he and Amaziah king of Judah, at Bethshemesh, which [belongeth] to Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_25\_28</u># And they brought him upon horses, and buried him with his fathers in the city of Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_27\_07</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Jotham, and all his wars, and his ways, lo, they [are] written in the book of the kings of Israel and Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_32\_08</u># With him [is] an arm of flesh; but with us [is] the LORD our God to help us, and to fight our battles. And the people rested themselves upon the words of Hezekiah king of Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_33\_14</u> # Now after this he built a wall without the city of David, on the west side of Gihon, in the valley, even to the entering in at the fish gate, and compassed about Ophel, and raised it up a very great height, and put captains of war in all the fenced cities of Judah.

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_34\_24</u># Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, and upon the inhabitants thereof, [even] all the curses that are written in the book which they have read before the king of Judah:

Judah <u>14\_2CH\_35\_27</u># And his deeds, first and last, behold, they [are] written in the book of the kings of Israel and Judah.

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_08\_23</u> # And the rest of the acts of Joram, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_09\_29</u> # And in the eleventh year of Joram the son of Ahab began Ahaziah to reign over Judah.

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_12\_19</u> # And the rest of the acts of Joash, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_14\_01</u># In the second year of Joash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel reigned Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah.

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_14\_11</u># But Amaziah would not hear. Therefore Jehoash king of Israel went up; and he and Amaziah king of Judah looked one another in the face at Bethshemesh, which [belongeth] to Judah.

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_14\_18</u> # And the rest of the acts of Amaziah, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_15\_06</u> # And the rest of the acts of Azariah, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_15\_36</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Jotham, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_16\_19</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Ahaz which he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_20\_20</u> # And the rest of the acts of Hezekiah, and all his might, and how he made a pool, and a conduit, and brought water into the city, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_21\_17</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Manasseh, and all that he did, and his sin that he sinned, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_21\_25</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Amon which he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_23\_22</u> # Surely there was not holden such a passover from the days of the judges that judged Israel, nor in all the days of the kings of Israel, nor of the kings of Judah;

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_23\_28</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Josiah, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>12\_2KI\_24\_05</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Jehoiakim, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Judah <u>10\_2SA\_05\_05</u># In Hebron he reigned over Judah seven years and six months: and in Jerusalem he reigned thirty and three years over all Israel and Judah.

Judah <u>10\_2SA\_21\_02</u> # And the king called the Gibeonites, and said unto them; [now the Gibeonites [were] not of the children of Israel, but of the remnant of the Amorites; and the children of Israel had sworn unto them: and Saul sought to slay them in his zeal to the children of Israel and Judah.]

Judah <u>10\_2SA\_24\_01</u># And again the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go, number Israel and Judah.

Judah <u>02\_EXO\_01\_02</u># Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah,

Judah <u>02\_EXO\_31\_02</u> # See, I have called by name Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah:

Judah <u>02\_EXO\_35\_30</u># And Moses said unto the children of Israel, See, the LORD hath called by name Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah;

Judah <u>26\_EZE\_48\_07</u> # And by the border of Reuben, from the east side unto the west side, a [portion for] Judah.

Judah <u>15\_EZR\_01\_02</u> # Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, The LORD God of heaven hath given me all the kingdoms of the earth; and he hath charged me to build him an house at Jerusalem, which [is] in Judah.

Judah <u>15\_EZR\_01\_08</u># Even those did Cyrus king of Persia bring forth by the hand of Mithredath the treasurer, and numbered them unto Sheshbazzar, the prince of Judah.

Judah <u>58\_HEB\_08\_08</u># For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:

Judah <u>23\_ISA\_01\_01</u> # The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah.

Judah 23\_ISA\_22\_21 # And I will clothe him with thy robe, and strengthen him with thy girdle, and I will commit thy government into his hand: and he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to the house of Judah.

Judah <u>24\_JER\_01\_15</u># For, lo, I will call all the families of the kingdoms of the north, saith the LORD; and they shall come, and they shall set every one his throne at the entering of the gates of Jerusalem, and against all the walls thereof round about, and against all the cities of Judah.

Judah <u>24\_JER\_02\_28</u># But where [are] thy gods that thou hast made thee? let them arise, if they can save thee in the time of thy trouble: for [according to] the number of thy cities are thy gods, O Judah.

Judah <u>24\_JER\_03\_11</u> # And the LORD said unto me, The backsliding Israel hath justified herself more than treacherous Judah.

Judah <u>24\_JER\_04\_16</u># Make ye mention to the nations; behold, publish against Jerusalem, [that] watchers come from a far country, and give out their voice against the cities of Judah.

Judah <u>24\_JER\_22\_30</u> # Thus saith the LORD, Write ye this man childless, a man [that] shall not prosper in his days: for no man of his seed shall prosper, sitting upon the throne of David, and ruling any more in Judah.

Judah 24\_JER\_27\_03 # And send them to the king of Edom, and to the king of Moab, and to the king of the Ammonites, and to the king of Tyrus, and to the king of Zidon, by the hand of the messengers which come to Jerusalem unto Zedekiah king of Judah;

Judah <u>24\_JER\_30\_04</u># And these [are] the words that the LORD spake concerning Israel and concerning Judah.

Judah <u>24\_JER\_31\_31</u># Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:
