justify himself said [42\\_LUK\\_10\\_29](#) # But he, willing to justify himself, said unto Jesus, And who is my neighbour?

justify many for [23\\_ISA\\_53\\_11](#) # He shall see of the travail of his soul, [and] shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.

justify myself mine [18\\_JOB\\_09\\_20](#) # If I justify myself, mine own mouth shall condemn me: [if I say], I [am] perfect, it shall also prove me perverse.

justify the circumcision [45\\_ROM\\_03\\_30](#) # Seeing [it is] one God, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith.

justify the heathen [48\\_GAL\\_03\\_08](#) # And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, [saying], In thee shall all nations be blessed.

justify the righteous [05\\_DEU\\_25\\_01](#) # If there be a controversy between men, and they come unto judgment, that [the judges] may judge them; then they shall justify the righteous, and condemn the wicked.

justify the wicked [02\\_EXO\\_23\\_07](#) # Keep thee far from a false matter; and the innocent and righteous slay thou not: for I will not justify the wicked.

justify the wicked [23\\_ISA\\_05\\_23](#) # Which justify the wicked for reward, and take away the righteousness of the righteous from him!

justify thee [18\\_JOB\\_33\\_32](#) # If thou hast any thing to say, answer me: speak, for I desire to justify thee.

justify you till [18\\_JOB\\_27\\_05](#) # God forbid that I should justify you: till I die I will not remove mine integrity from me.

justify yourselves before [42\\_LUK\\_16\\_15](#) # And he said unto them, Ye are they which justify yourselves before men; but God knoweth your hearts: for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of God.

justifying the righteous [11\\_1KI\\_08\\_32](#) # Then hear thou in heaven, and do, and judge thy servants, condemning the wicked, to bring his way upon his head; and justifying the righteous, to give him according to his righteousness.

justifying the righteous [14\\_2CH\\_06\\_23](#) # Then hear thou from heaven, and do, and judge thy servants, by requiring the wicked, by recompensing his way upon his own head; and by justifying the righteous, by giving him according to his righteousness.
