

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Jabeshgilead and all <u>09\_1SA\_11\_01</u># Then Nahash the Ammonite came up, and encamped against Jabeshgilead: and all the men of Jabesh said unto Nahash, Make a covenant with us, and we will serve thee.

Jabeshgilead and said 10 2SA 02 05 # And David sent messengers unto the men of Jabeshgilead, and said unto them, Blessed [be] ye of the LORD, that ye have showed this kindness unto your lord, [even] unto Saul, and have buried him.

Jabeshgilead and yet <u>07\_JUD\_21\_14</u># And Benjamin came again at that time; and they gave them wives which they had saved alive of the women of Jabeshgilead: and yet so they sufficed them not.

Jabeshgilead four hundred <u>07\_JUD\_21\_12</u># And they found among the inhabitants of Jabeshgilead four hundred young virgins, that had known no man by lying with any male: and they brought them unto the camp to Shiloh, which [is] in the land of Canaan.

Jabeshgilead heard all <u>13\_1CH\_10\_11</u># And when all Jabeshgilead heard all that the Philistines had done to Saul,

Jabeshgilead heard of <u>09\_1SA\_31\_11</u># And when the inhabitants of Jabeshgilead heard of that which the Philistines had done to Saul;

Jabeshgilead there <u>07\_JUD\_21\_09</u> # For the people were numbered, and, behold, [there were] none of the inhabitants of Jabeshgilead there.

Jabeshgilead To morrow <u>09\_1SA\_11\_09</u># And they said unto the messengers that came, Thus shall ye say unto the men of Jabeshgilead, To morrow, by [that time] the sun be hot, ye shall have help. And the messengers came and showed [it] to the men of Jabesh; and they were glad.

Jabeshgilead to the <u>07\_JUD\_21\_08</u># And they said, What one [is there] of the tribes of Israel that came not up to Mizpeh to the LORD? And, behold, there came none to the camp from Jabeshgilead to the assembly.

Jabeshgilead were they <u>10\_2SA\_02\_04</u># And the men of Judah came, and there they anointed David king over the house of Judah. And they told David, saying, [That] the men of Jabeshgilead [were they] that buried Saul.

Jabeshgilead which had <u>10\_2SA\_21\_12</u> # And David went and took the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son from the men of Jabeshgilead, which had stolen them from the street of Bethshan, where the Philistines had hanged them, when the Philistines had slain Saul in Gilboa:

Jabeshgilead with the <u>07\_JUD\_21\_10</u># And the congregation sent thither twelve thousand men of the valiantest, and commanded them, saying, Go and smite the inhabitants of Jabeshgilead with the edge of the sword, with the women and the children.
