jaw and there <u>07_JUD_15_19</u> # But God clave an hollow place that [was] in the jaw, and there came water thereout; and when he had drunk, his spirit came again, and he revived: wherefore he called the name thereof Enhakkore, which [is] in Lehi unto this day.

jaw of an <u>07_JUD_15_16</u># And Samson said, With the jawbone of an ass, heaps upon heaps, with the jaw of an ass have I slain a thousand men.

jaw teeth as <u>20_PRO_30_14</u># [There is] a generation, whose teeth [are as] swords, and their jaw teeth [as] knives, to devour the poor from off the earth, and the needy from [among] men.

jaw through with <u>18_JOB_41_02</u># Canst thou put an hook into his nose? or bore his jaw through with a thorn?
