Kedar and Adbeel <u>13\_1CH\_01\_29</u> # These [are] their generations: The firstborn of Ishmael, Nebaioth; then Kedar, and Adbeel, and Mibsam,

Kedar and Adbeel <u>01\_GEN\_25\_13</u> # And these [are] the names of the sons of Ishmael, by their names, according to their generations: the firstborn of Ishmael, Nebajoth; and Kedar, and Adbeel, and Mibsam,

Kedar and concerning 24\_JER\_49\_28 # Concerning Kedar, and concerning the kingdoms of Hazor, which Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon shall smite, thus saith the LORD; Arise ye, go up to Kedar, and spoil the men of the east.

Kedar and consider 24\_JER\_02\_10 # For pass over the isles of Chittim, and see; and send unto Kedar, and consider diligently, and see if there be such a thing.

Kedar and spoil <u>24\_JER\_49\_28</u># Concerning Kedar, and concerning the kingdoms of Hazor, which Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon shall smite, thus saith the LORD; Arise ye, go up to Kedar, and spoil the men of the east.

Kedar as the <u>22\_SON\_01\_05</u># I [am] black, but comely, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, as the tents of Kedar, as the curtains of Solomon.

Kedar doth inhabit 23 ISA 42 11 # Let the wilderness and the cities thereof lift up [their voice], the villages [that] Kedar doth inhabit: let the inhabitants of the rock sing, let them shout from the top of the mountains.

Kedar shall be <u>23\_ISA\_21\_17</u># And the residue of the number of archers, the mighty men of the children of Kedar, shall be diminished: for the LORD God of Israel hath spoken [it].

Kedar shall be <u>23\_ISA\_60\_07</u> # All the flocks of Kedar shall be gathered together unto thee, the rams of Nebaioth shall minister unto thee: they shall come up with acceptance on mine altar, and I will glorify the house of my glory.

Kedar shall fail <u>23\_ISA\_21\_16</u> # For thus hath the Lord said unto me, Within a year, according to the years of an hireling, and all the glory of Kedar shall fail:

Kedar they occupied <u>26\_EZE\_27\_21</u> # Arabia, and all the princes of Kedar, they occupied with thee in lambs, and rams, and goats: in these [were they] thy merchants.
