

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Jorkoam and Rekem <u>13_1CH_02_44</u># And Shema begat Raham, the father of Jorkoam: and Rekem begat Shammai.

Koa and all <u>26_EZE_23_23</u> # The Babylonians, and all the Chaldeans, Pekod, and Shoa, and Koa, [and] all the Assyrians with them: all of them desirable young men, captains and rulers, great lords and renowned, all of them riding upon horses.

Tekoa and as 14_2CH_20_20 # And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper.

Tekoa and set <u>24_JER_06_01</u> # O ye children of Benjamin, gather yourselves to flee out of the midst of Jerusalem, and blow the trumpet in Tekoa, and set up a sign of fire in Bethhaccerem: for evil appeareth out of the north, and great destruction.

Tekoa had two 13_1CH_04_05 # And Ashur the father of Tekoa had two wives, Helah and Naarah.

Tekoa which he <u>30_AMO_01_01</u> # The words of Amos, who was among the herdmen of Tekoa, which he saw concerning Israel in the days of Uzziah king of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash king of Israel, two years before the earthquake.

Tekoa 13_1CH_02_24 # And after that Hezron was dead in Calebephratah, then Abiah Hezron's wife bare him Ashur the father of Tekoa.

Tekoa 14_2CH_11_06 # He built even Bethlehem, and Etam, and Tekoa,

Tekoah and fetched 10_2SA_14_02 # And Joab sent to Tekoah, and fetched thence a wise woman, and said unto her, I pray thee, feign thyself to be a mourner, and put on now mourning apparel, and anoint not thyself with oil, but be as a woman that had a long time mourned for the dead:

Tekoah said unto 10_2SA_14_09 # And the woman of Tekoah said unto the king, My lord, O king, the iniquity [be] on me, and on my father's house: and the king and his throne [be] guiltless.

Tekoah spake to 10_28A_14_04 # And when the woman of Tekoah spake to the king, she fell on her face to the ground, and did obeisance, and said, Help, O king.
