king's burnt sacrifice 12 2KI 16 15 # And king Ahaz commanded Urijah the priest, saying, Upon the great altar burn the morning burnt offering, and the evening meat offering, and the king's burnt sacrifice, and his meat offering, with the burnt offering of all the people of the land, and their meat offering, and their drink offerings; and sprinkle upon it all the blood of the burnt offering, and all the blood of the sacrifice: and the brazen altar shall be for me to inquire [by].

king's business and <u>27\_DAN\_08\_27</u> # And I Daniel fainted, and was sick [certain] days; afterward I rose up, and did the king's business; and I was astonished at the vision, but none understood [it].

king's son in <u>09\_1SA\_22\_14</u># Then Ahimelech answered the king, and said, And who [is so] faithful among all thy servants as David, which is the king's son in law, and goeth at thy bidding, and is honourable in thine house?

king's son is <u>10\_2SA\_18\_20</u># And Joab said unto him, Thou shalt not bear tidings this day, but thou shalt bear tidings another day: but this day thou shalt bear no tidings, because the king's son is dead.

king's son lean 10\_28A\_13\_04 # And he said unto him, Why [art] thou, [being] the king's son, lean from day to day? wilt thou not tell me? And Amnon said unto him, I love Tamar, my brother Absalom's sister.

king's son shall <u>14\_2CH\_23\_03</u> # And all the congregation made a covenant with the king in the house of God. And he said unto them, Behold, the king's son shall reign, as the LORD hath said of the sons of David.

king's son was 12 2KI 15 05 # And the LORD smote the king, so that he was a leper unto the day of his death, and dwelt in a several house. And Jotham the king's son [was] over the house, judging the people of the land.

king's son 11\_1KI\_22\_26# And the king of Israel said, Take Micaiah, and carry him back unto Amon the governor of the city, and to Joash the king's son;

king's son <u>14\_2CH\_18\_25</u> # Then the king of Israel said, Take ye Micaiah, and carry him back to Amon the governor of the city, and to Joash the king's son;

king's son 12 2KI 11 04 # And the seventh year Jehoiada sent and fetched the rulers over hundreds, with the captains and the guard, and brought them to him into the house of the LORD, and made a covenant with them, and took an oath of them in the house of the LORD, and showed them the king's son.

king's son 19\_PSA\_72\_01 # [A Psalm] for Solomon. Give the king thy judgments, O God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son.

king's sons and <u>11\_1KI\_01\_09</u># And Adonijah slew sheep and oxen and fat cattle by the stone of Zoheleth, which [is] by Enrogel, and called all his brethren the king's sons, and all the men of Judah the king's servants:

king's sons and <u>11\_1KI\_01\_25</u># For he is gone down this day, and hath slain oxen and fat cattle and sheep in abundance, and hath called all the king's sons, and the captains of the host, and Abiathar the priest; and, behold, they eat and drink before him, and say, God save king Adonijah.

king's sons and 12\_2KI\_10\_07 # And it came to pass, when the letter came to them, that they took the king's sons, and slew seventy persons, and put their heads in baskets, and sent him [them] to Jezreel.

king's sons And 12\_2KI\_10\_08 # And there came a messenger, and told him, saying, They have brought the heads of the king's sons. And he said, Lay ye them in two heaps at the entering in of the gate until the morning.

king's sons and <u>10\_2SA\_13\_30</u> # And it came to pass, while they were in the way, that tidings came to David, saying, Absalom hath slain all the king's sons, and there is not one of them left.

king's sons are <u>10\_2SA\_13\_33</u># Now therefore let not my lord the king take the thing to his heart, to think that all the king's sons are dead: for Amnon only is dead.

king's sons arose <u>10\_2SA\_13\_29</u> # And the servants of Absalom did unto Amnon as Absalom had commanded. Then all the king's sons arose, and every man gat him up upon his mule, and fled.

king's sons being 12\_2KI\_10\_06 # Then he wrote a letter the second time to them, saying, If ye [be] mine, and [if] ye will hearken unto my voice, take ye the heads of the men your master's sons, and come to me to Jezreel by to morrow this time. Now the king's sons, [being] seventy persons, [were] with the great men of the city, which brought them up.

king's sons came <u>10\_2SA\_13\_36</u># And it came to pass, as soon as he had made an end of speaking, that, behold, the king's sons came, and lifted up their voice and wept: and the king also and all his servants wept very sore.

king's sons go 10\_2SA\_13\_27# But Absalom pressed him, that he let Amnon and all the king's sons go with him.

king's sons that 14\_2CH\_22\_11# But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

king's sons which 12\_2KI\_11\_02# But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons [which were] slain; and they hid him, [even] him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

king's sons <u>13\_1CH\_27\_32</u> # Also Jonathan David's uncle was a counsellor, a wise man, and a scribe: and Jehiel the son of Hachmoni [was] with the king's sons:

king's sons <u>10 2SA 09 11</u> # Then said Ziba unto the king, According to all that my lord the king hath commanded his servant, so shall thy servant do. As for Mephibosheth, [said the king], he shall eat at my table, as one of the king's sons.

king's sons <u>10\_2SA\_13\_23</u> # And it came to pass after two full years, that Absalom had sheepshearers in Baalhazor, which [is] beside Ephraim: and Absalom invited all the king's sons.

king's spear and <u>09\_18A\_26\_22</u> # And David answered and said, Behold the king's spear! and let one of the young men come over and fetch it.

king's spear is <u>09\_1SA\_26\_16</u># This thing [is] not good that thou hast done. [As] the LORD liveth, ye [are] worthy to die, because ye have not kept your master, the LORD'S anointed. And now see where the king's spear [is], and the cruse of water that [was] at his bolster.

king's strength also 19\_PSA\_99\_04 # The king's strength also loveth judgment; thou dost establish equity, thou executest judgment and righteousness in Jacob.

king's substance 14\_2CH\_35\_07 # And Josiah gave to the people, of the flock, lambs and kids, all for the passover offerings, for all that were present, to the number of thirty thousand, and three thousand bullocks: these [were] of the king's substance.

king's table and <u>10\_2SA\_09\_13</u> # So Mephibosheth dwelt in Jerusalem: for he did eat continually at the king's table; and was lame on both his feet.

king's table <u>09\_1SA\_20\_29</u># And he said, Let me go, I pray thee; for our family hath a sacrifice in the city; and my brother, he hath commanded me [to be there]: and now, if I have found favour in thine eyes, let me get away, I pray thee, and see my brethren. Therefore he cometh not unto the king's table.

king's treasure house 15 EZR 05 17 # Now therefore, if [it seem] good to the king, let there be search made in the king's treasure house, which [is] there at Babylon, whether it be [so], that a decree was made of Cyrus the king to build this house of God at Jerusalem, and let the king send his pleasure to us concerning this matter.

king's treasure house <u>15\_EZR\_07\_20</u> # And whatsoever more shall be needful for the house of thy God, which thou shalt have occasion to bestow, bestow [it] out of the king's treasure house.

king's treasures was 13 1CH 27 25 # And over the king's treasures [was] Azmaveth the son of Adiel: and over the storehouses in the fields, in the cities, and in the villages, and in the castles, [was] Jehonathan the son of Uzziah:

king's treasuries for <u>17\_EST\_04\_07</u># And Mordecai told him of all that had happened unto him, and of the sum of the money that Haman had promised to pay to the king's treasuries for the Jews, to destroy them.

king's treasuries <u>17\_EST\_03\_09</u> # If it please the king, let it be written that they may be destroyed: and I will pay ten thousand talents of silver to the hands of those that have the charge of the business, to bring [it] into the king's treasuries.

king's tribute and <u>16\_NEH\_05\_04</u># There were also that said, We have borrowed money for the king's tribute, [and that upon] our lands and vineyards.

king's weight 10\_2SA\_14\_26# And when he polled his head, [for it was at every year's end that he polled [it]: because [the hair] was heavy on him, therefore he polled it:] he weighed the hair of his head at two hundred shekels after the king's weight.

king's winepresses <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_10</u># All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate unto the place of the first gate, unto the corner gate, and [from] the tower of Hananeel unto the king's winepresses.

king's wise men <u>27\_DAN\_05\_08</u> # Then came in all the king's wise [men]: but they could not read the writing, nor make known to the king the interpretation thereof.

king's wives and 12\_2KI\_24\_15 # And he carried away Jehoiachin to Babylon, and the king's mother, and the king's wives, and his officers, and the mighty of the land, [those] carried he into captivity from Jerusalem to Babylon.

king's word and <u>27\_DAN\_03\_28</u># [Then] Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed [be] the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God.

king's word prevailed <u>13\_1CH\_21\_04</u># Nevertheless the king's word prevailed against Joab. Wherefore Joab departed, and went throughout all Israel, and came to Jerusalem.

king's word prevailed <u>10\_2SA\_24\_04</u> # Notwithstanding the king's word prevailed against Joab, and against the captains of the host. And Joab and the captains of the host went out from the presence of the king, to number the people of Israel.

king's word was 13\_1CH\_21\_06 # But Levi and Benjamin counted he not among them: for the king's word was abominable to Joab.

king's words that <u>16\_NEH\_02\_18</u># Then I told them of the hand of my God which was good upon me; as also the king's words that he had spoken unto me. And they said, Let us rise up and build. So they strengthened their hands for [this] good [work].

king's work offered 13\_1CH\_29\_06 # Then the chief of the fathers and princes of the tribes of Israel, and the captains of thousands and of hundreds, with the rulers of the king's work, offered willingly,

king's wrath arise 10\_2SA\_11\_20# And if so be that the king's wrath arise, and he say unto thee, Wherefore approached ye so nigh unto the city when ye did fight? knew ye not that they would shoot from the wall?

king's wrath is 20\_PRO\_19\_12# The king's wrath [is] as the roaring of a lion; but his favour [is] as dew upon the grass.

king's wrath pacified <u>17\_EST\_07\_10</u># So they hanged Haman on the gallows that he had prepared for Mordecai. Then was the king's wrath pacified.
