Gilead is a 28\_HOS\_06\_08 # Gilead [is] a city of them that work iniquity, [and is] polluted with blood.

Gilead is mine 19\_PSA\_108\_08 # Gilead [is] mine; Manasseh [is] mine; Ephraim also [is] the strength of mine head; Judah [is] my lawgiver;

Gilead is mine 19\_PSA\_60\_07 # Gilead [is] mine, and Manasseh [is] mine; Ephraim also [is] the strength of mine head; Judah [is] my lawgiver;

Gilead is ours 11\_1KI\_22\_03# And the king of Israel said unto his servants, Know ye that Ramoth in Gilead [is] ours, and we [be] still, [and] take it not out of the hand of the king of Syria?

Gilead is there 24\_JER\_08\_22 # [Is there] no balm in Gilead; [is there] no physician there? why then is not the health of the daughter of my people recovered?

Gilead of Gilead <u>04\_NUM\_26\_29</u> # Of the sons of Manasseh: of Machir, the family of the Machirites: and Machir begat Gilead: of Gilead [come] the family of the Gileadites.

Gilead 10\_2SA\_17\_26 # So Israel and Absalom pitched in the land of Gilead.

Ramothgilead And one <u>14\_2CH\_18\_19</u># And the LORD said, Who shall entice Ahab king of Israel, that he may go up and fall at Ramothgilead? And one spake saying after this manner, and another saying after that manner.

Ramothgilead and prosper 11\_1KI\_22\_12# And all the prophets prophesied so, saying, Go up to Ramothgilead, and prosper: for the LORD shall deliver [it] into the king's hand.

Ramothgilead and prosper 14\_2CH\_18\_11 # And all the prophets prophesied so, saying, Go up to Ramothgilead, and prosper: for the LORD shall deliver [it] into the hand of the king.

Ramothgilead and the 14\_2CH\_22\_05 # He walked also after their counsel, and went with Jehoram the son of Ahab king of Israel to war against Hazael king of Syria at Ramothgilead: and the Syrians smote Joram.

Ramothgilead and the 12\_2KI\_08\_28 # And he went with Joram the son of Ahab to the war against Hazael king of Syria in Ramothgilead; and the Syrians wounded Joram.

Ramothgilead he and 12\_2KI\_09\_14 # So Jehu the son of Jehoshaphat the son of Nimshi conspired against Joram. [Now Joram had kept Ramothgilead, he and all Israel, because of Hazael king of Syria.

Ramothgilead to battle <u>11\_1KI\_22\_06</u># Then the king of Israel gathered the prophets together, about four hundred men, and said unto them, Shall I go against Ramothgilead to battle, or shall I forbear? And they said, Go up; for the Lord shall deliver [it] into the hand of the king.

ringleader of the <u>44\_ACT\_24\_05</u># For we have found this man [a] pestilent [fellow], and a mover of sedition among all the Jews throughout the world, and a ringleader of the sect of the Nazarenes:
