cleave and swear [05 DEU 10 20](#) # Thou shalt fear the LORD thy God; him shalt thou serve, and to him shalt thou cleave, and swear by his name.

cleave fast together [18 JOB 38 38](#) # When the dust groweth into hardness, and the clods cleave fast together?

cleave in the [38 ZEC 14 04](#) # And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which [is] before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, [and there shall be] a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

cleave it with [03 LEV 01 17](#) # And he shall cleave it with the wings thereof, [but] shall not divide [it] asunder: and the priest shall burn it upon the altar, upon the wood that [is] upon the fire: it [is] a burnt sacrifice, an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

cleave nought of [05 DEU 13 17](#) # And there shall cleave nought of the cursed thing to thine hand: that the LORD may turn from the fierceness of his anger, and show thee mercy, and have compassion upon thee, and multiply thee, as he hath sworn unto thy fathers;

cleave the fountain [19 PSA 74 15](#) # Thou didst cleave the fountain and the flood: thou driedst up mighty rivers.

cleave to his [41 MAR 10 07](#) # For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and cleave to his wife;

cleave to his [40 MAT 19 05](#) # And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh?

cleave to me [19 PSA 101 03](#) # I will set no wicked thing before mine eyes: I hate the work of them that turn aside; [it] shall not cleave to me.

cleave to my [19 PSA 102 05](#) # By reason of the voice of my groaning my bones cleave to my skin.

cleave to that [45 ROM 12 09](#) # [Let] love be without dissimulation. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good.

cleave to the [26 EZE 03 26](#) # And I will make thy tongue cleave to the roof of thy mouth, that thou shalt be dumb, and shalt not be to them a reprover: for they [are] a rebellious house.

cleave to the [23 ISA 14 01](#) # For the LORD will have mercy on Jacob, and will yet choose Israel, and set them in their own land: and the strangers shall be joined with them, and they shall cleave to the house of

cleaveth wood shall [21_ECC_10_09](#) # Whoso removeth stones shall be hurt therewith; [and] he that cleaveth wood shall be endangered thereby.

cleaveth wood upon [19_PSA_141_07](#) # Our bones are scattered at the grave's mouth, as when one cutteth and cleaveth [wood] upon the earth.

leave a blessing [29_JOE_02_14](#) # Who knoweth [if] he will return and repent, and leave a blessing behind him; [even] a meat offering and a drink offering unto the LORD your God?

leave a few [26_EZE_12_16](#) # But I will leave a few men of them from the sword, from the famine, and from the pestilence; that they may declare all their abominations among the heathen whither they come; and they shall know that I [am] the LORD.

leave a man [09_1SA_14_36](#) # And Saul said, Let us go down after the Philistines by night, and spoil them until the morning light, and let us not leave a man of them. And they said, Do whatsoever seemeth good unto thee. Then said the priest, Let us draw near hither unto God.

leave a remnant [26 EZE 06 08](#) # Yet will I leave a remnant, that ye may have [some] that shall escape the sword among the nations, when ye shall be scattered through the countries.

leave an hundred [30 AMO 05 03](#) # For thus saith the Lord GOD; The city that went out [by] a thousand shall leave an hundred, and that which went forth [by] an hundred shall leave ten, to the house of Israel.

leave And the [41 MAR 05 13](#) # And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. And the unclean spirits went out, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, [they were about two thousand;] and were choked in the sea.

leave him in [19 PSA 37 33](#) # The LORD will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is judged.

leave him [46 1CO 07 13](#) # And the woman which hath an husband that believeth not, and if he be pleased to dwell with her, let her not leave him.

leave his blood [28 HOS 12 14](#) # Ephraim provoked [him] to anger most bitterly: therefore shall he leave his blood upon him, and his reproach shall his Lord return unto him.

leave his father [49 EPH 05 31](#) # For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh.

leave his father [01 GEN 02 24](#) # Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

leave his father [01 GEN 44 22](#) # And we said unto my lord, The lad cannot leave his father: for [if] he should leave his father, [his father] would die.

leave in the [36 ZEP 03 12](#) # I will also leave in the midst of thee an afflicted and poor people, and they shall trust in the name of the LORD.

leave in thee [42 LUK 19 44](#) # And shall lay thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation.

leave my complaint [18 JOB 10 01](#) # My soul is weary of my life; I will leave my complaint upon myself; I will speak in the bitterness of my soul.

leave my fatness [07 JUD 09 09](#) # But the olive tree said unto them, Should I leave my fatness, wherewith by me they honour God and man, and go to be promoted over the trees?

leave my people [24 JER 09 02](#) # Oh that I had in the wilderness a lodging place of wayfaring men; that I might leave my people, and go from them! for they [be] all adulterers, an assembly of treacherous men.

leave my soul [44 ACT 02 27](#) # Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

leave my soul [19 PSA 16 10](#) # For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

leave my wine [07 JUD 09 13](#) # And the vine said unto them, Should I leave my wine, which cheereth God and man, and go to be promoted over the trees?

leave no children [41 MAR 12 19](#) # Master, Moses wrote unto us, If a man's brother die, and leave [his] wife [behind him], and leave no children, that his brother should take his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother.

leave none of [03_LEV_22_30](#) # On the same day it shall be eaten up; ye shall leave none of it until the morrow: I [am] the LORD.

leave none of [04_NUM_09_12](#) # They shall leave none of it unto the morning, nor break any bone of it: according to all the ordinances of the passover they shall keep it.

leave not my [19_PSA_141_08](#) # But mine eyes [are] unto thee, O GOD the Lord: in thee is my trust; leave not my soul destitute.

leave not thy [21_ECC_10_04](#) # If the spirit of the ruler rise up against thee, leave not thy place; for yielding pacifieth great offences.

leave of all [09_ISA_25_22](#) # So and more also do God unto the enemies of David, if I leave of all that [pertain] to him by the morning light any that pisseth against the wall.

leave of it [02_EXO_16_19](#) # And Moses said, Let no man leave of it till the morning.

leave of me [09_ISA_20_06](#) # If thy father at all miss me, then say, David earnestly asked [leave] of me that he might run to Bethlehem his city: for [there is] a yearly sacrifice there for all the family.

leave of me [09_ISA_20_28](#) # And Jonathan answered Saul, David earnestly asked [leave] of me [to go] to Bethlehem:

leave of the [12_2KI_13_07](#) # Neither did he leave of the people to Jehoahaz but fifty horsemen, and ten chariots, and ten thousand footmen; for the king of Syria had destroyed them, and had made them like the dust by threshing.

leave one of [44_ACT_21_06](#) # And when we had taken our leave one of another, we took ship; and they returned home again.

leave one of [01_GEN_42_33](#) # And the man, the lord of the country, said unto us, Hereby shall I know that ye [are] true [men]; leave one of your brethren [here] with me, and take [food for] the famine of your households, and be gone:

leave out and [66 REV 11 02](#) # But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty [and] two months.

leave some gleanings [24 JER 49 09](#) # If grapegatherers come to thee, would they not leave [some] gleanings grapes? if thieves by night, they will destroy till they have enough.

leave some grapes [31 OBA 01 05](#) # If thieves came to thee, if robbers by night, [how art thou cut off!] would they not have stolen till they had enough? if the grapegatherers came to thee, would they not leave [some] grapes?

leave ten to [30 AMO 05 03](#) # For thus saith the Lord GOD; The city that went out [by] a thousand shall leave an hundred, and that which went forth [by] an hundred shall leave ten, to the house of Israel.

leave the beasts [02 EXO 23 11](#) # But the seventh [year] thou shalt let it rest and lie still; that the poor of thy people may eat: and what they leave the beasts of the field shall eat. In like manner thou shalt deal with thy vineyard, [and] with thy oliveyard.

leave the cities [24 JER 48 28](#) # O ye that dwell in Moab, leave the cities, and dwell in the rock, and be like the dove [that] maketh her nest in the sides of the hole's mouth.

leave the ninety [42 LUK 15 04](#) # What man of you, having an hundred sheep, if he lose one of them, doth not leave the ninety and nine in the wilderness, and go after that which is lost, until he find it?

leave the ninety [40 MAT 18 12](#) # How think ye? if a man have an hundred sheep, and one of them be gone astray, doth he not leave the ninety and nine, and goeth into the mountains, and seeketh that which is gone astray?

leave the other [42 LUK 11 42](#) # But woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and pass over judgment and the love of God: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

leave the other [40 MAT 23 23](#) # Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier [matters] of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

leave the seventh [16 NEH 10 31](#) # And [if] the people of the land bring ware or any victuals on the sabbath day to sell, [that] we would not buy it of them on the sabbath, or on the holy day: and [that] we would leave the seventh year, and the exaction of every debt.

leave the snow [24 JER 18 14](#) # Will [a man] leave the snow of Lebanon [which cometh] from the rock of the field? [or] shall the cold flowing waters that come from another place be forsaken?

leave the stump [27 DAN 04 15](#) # Nevertheless leave the stump of his roots in the earth, even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and [let] his portion [be] with the beasts in the grass of the earth:

leave the stump [27 DAN 04 23](#) # And whereas the king saw a watcher and an holy one coming down from heaven, and saying, Hew the tree down, and destroy it; yet leave the stump of the roots thereof in the earth,

even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and [let] his portion [be] with the beasts of the field, till seven times pass over him;

leave the stump [27 DAN 04 26](#) # And whereas they commanded to leave the stump of the tree roots; thy kingdom shall be sure unto thee, after that thou shalt have known that the heavens do rule.

leave the word [44 ACT 06 02](#) # Then the twelve called the multitude of the disciples [unto them], and said, It is not reason that we should leave the word of God, and serve tables.

leave the world [43 JOH 16 28](#) # I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world: again, I leave the world, and go to the Father.

leave thee altogether [24 JER 30 11](#) # For I [am] with thee, saith the LORD, to save thee: though I make a full end of all nations whither I have scattered thee, yet will I not make a full end of thee: but I will correct thee in measure, and will not leave thee altogether unpunished.

leave thee And [12 2KI 02 06](#) # And Elijah said unto him, Tarry, I pray thee, here; for the LORD hath sent me to Jordan. And he said, [As] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. And they two went on.

leave thee naked [26 EZE 16 39](#) # And I will also give thee into their hand, and they shall throw down thine eminent place, and shall break down thy high places: they shall strip thee also of thy clothes, and shall take thy fair jewels, and leave thee naked and bare.

leave thee naked [26 EZE 23 29](#) # And they shall deal with thee hatefully, and shall take away all thy labour, and shall leave thee naked and bare: and the nakedness of thy whoredoms shall be discovered, both thy lewdness and thy whoredoms.

leave thee thrown [26 EZE 29 05](#) # And I will leave thee [thrown] into the wilderness, thee and all the fish of thy rivers: thou shalt fall upon the open fields; thou shalt not be brought together, nor gathered: I have given thee for meat to the beasts of the field and to the fowls of the heaven.

leave thee until [01 GEN 28 15](#) # And, behold, I [am] with thee, and will keep thee in all [places] whither

thou goest, and will bring thee again into this land; for I will not leave thee, until I have done [that] which I have spoken to thee of.

leave thee upon [26 EZE 32 04](#) # Then will I leave thee upon the land, I will cast thee forth upon the open field, and will cause all the fowls of the heaven to remain upon thee, and I will fill the beasts of the whole earth with thee.

leave thee wholly [24 JER 46 28](#) # Fear thou not, O Jacob my servant, saith the LORD: for I [am] with thee; for I will make a full end of all the nations whither I have driven thee: but I will not make a full end of thee, but correct thee in measure; yet will I not leave thee wholly unpunished.

leave their wealth [19 PSA 49 10](#) # For he seeth [that] wise men die, likewise the fool and the brutish person perish, and leave their wealth to others.

leave them for [03 LEV 19 10](#) # And thou shalt not glean thy vineyard, neither shalt thou gather [every] grape of thy vineyard; thou shalt leave them for the poor and stranger: I [am] the LORD your God.

unleavened bread [02_EXO_12_20](#) # Ye shall eat nothing leavened; in all your habitations shall ye eat unleavened bread.

unleavened bread [03_LEV_08_02](#) # Take Aaron and his sons with him, and the garments, and the anointing oil, and a bullock for the sin offering, and two rams, and a basket of unleavened bread;

unleavened bread [03_LEV_23_06](#) # And on the fifteenth day of the same month [is] the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

unleavened cake and [03_LEV_08_26](#) # And out of the basket of unleavened bread, that [was] before the LORD, he took one unleavened cake, and a cake of oiled bread, and one wafer, and put [them] on the fat, and upon the right shoulder:

unleavened cake out [04_NUM_06_19](#) # And the priest shall take the sodden shoulder of the ram, and one unleavened cake out of the basket, and one unleavened wafer, and shall put [them] upon the hands of the Nazarite, after [the hair of] his separation is shaven:

unleavened cakes and [13_1CH_23_29](#) # Both for the showbread, and for the fine flour for meat offering, and for the unleavened cakes, and for [that which is baked in] the pan, and for that which is fried, and for all manner of measure and size;

unleavened cakes of [02_EXO_12_39](#) # And they baked unleavened cakes of the dough which they brought forth out of Egypt, for it was not leavened; because they were thrust out of Egypt, and could not tarry,

neither had they prepared for themselves any victual.

unleavened cakes of [07 JUD 06 19](#) # And Gideon went in, and made ready a kid, and unleavened cakes of an ephah of flour: the flesh he put in a basket, and he put the broth in a pot, and brought [it] out unto him under the oak, and presented [it].
