talents of silver 14\_2CH\_27\_05 # He fought also with the king of the Ammonites, and prevailed against them. And the children of Ammon gave him the same year an hundred talents of silver, and ten thousand measures of wheat, and ten thousand of barley. So much did the children of Ammon pay unto him, both the second year, and the third.

talents of silver <u>14\_2CH\_36\_03</u># And the king of Egypt put him down at Jerusalem, and condemned the land in an hundred talents of silver and a talent of gold.

talents of silver <u>12\_2KI\_05\_05</u># And the king of Syria said, Go to, go, and I will send a letter unto the king of Israel. And he departed, and took with him ten talents of silver, and six thousand [pieces] of gold, and ten changes of raiment.

talents of silver 12 2KI 05 23 # And Naaman said, Be content, take two talents. And he urged him, and bound two talents of silver in two bags, with two changes of garments, and laid [them] upon two of his servants; and they bare [them] before him.

talents of silver 12\_2KI\_15\_19 # [And] Pul the king of Assyria came against the land: and Menahem gave Pul a thousand talents of silver, that his hand might be with him to confirm the kingdom in his hand.

talents of silver 12 2KI 18 14 # And Hezekiah king of Judah sent to the king of Assyria to Lachish, saying, I have offended; return from me: that which thou puttest on me will I bear. And the king of Assyria appointed unto Hezekiah king of Judah three hundred talents of silver and thirty talents of gold.

talents of silver <u>12 2KI 23 33 #</u> And Pharaohnechoh put him in bands at Riblah in the land of Hamath, that he might not reign in Jerusalem; and put the land to a tribute of an hundred talents of silver, and a talent of gold.

talents of silver <u>17\_EST\_03\_09</u># If it please the king, let it be written that they may be destroyed: and I will pay ten thousand talents of silver to the hands of those that have the charge of the business, to bring [it] into the king's treasuries.

talents of silver <u>02\_EXO\_38\_27</u> # And of the hundred talents of silver were cast the sockets of the sanctuary, and the sockets of the veil; an hundred sockets of the hundred talents, a talent for a socket.

talents of silver <u>15\_EZR\_07\_22</u> # Unto an hundred talents of silver, and to an hundred measures of wheat, and to an hundred baths of wine, and to an hundred baths of oil, and salt without prescribing [how much].

talents of silver <u>15\_EZR\_08\_26</u> # I even weighed unto their hand six hundred and fifty talents of silver, and silver vessels an hundred talents, [and] of gold an hundred talents;

talents saying Lord <u>40\_MAT\_25\_20</u># And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saying, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more.

talents to another <u>40\_MAT\_25\_15</u># And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

talents went and <u>40\_MAT\_25\_16</u># Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made [them] other five talents.

talents which I <u>14\_2CH\_25\_09</u># And Amaziah said to the man of God, But what shall we do for the hundred talents which I have given to the army of Israel? And the man of God answered, The LORD is able to give thee much more than this.

talents <u>14\_2CH\_03\_08</u># And he made the most holy house, the length whereof [was] according to the breadth of the house, twenty cubits, and the breadth thereof twenty cubits: and he overlaid it with fine gold, [amounting] to six hundred talents.

talents <u>15\_EZR\_08\_26</u> # I even weighed unto their hand six hundred and fifty talents of silver, and silver vessels an hundred talents, [and] of gold an hundred talents;

talents <u>40\_MAT\_18\_24</u># And when he had begun to reckon, one was brought unto him, which owed him ten thousand talents.

talents <u>40\_MAT\_25\_16</u># Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made [them] other five talents.

violent dealing shall <u>19\_PSA\_07\_16</u># His mischief shall return upon his own head, and his violent dealing shall come down upon his own pate.

violent man enticeth <u>20\_PRO\_16\_29</u> # A violent man enticeth his neighbour, and leadeth him into the way [that is] not good.

violent man to 19\_PSA\_140\_11 # Let not an evil speaker be established in the earth: evil shall hunt the violent man to overthrow [him].

violent man who 19\_PSA\_140\_04 # Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; preserve me from the violent man; who have purposed to overthrow my goings.

violent man 10\_2SA\_22\_49 # And that bringeth me forth from mine enemies: thou also hast lifted me up on high above them that rose up against me: thou hast delivered me from the violent man.

violent man <u>19\_PSA\_140\_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. Deliver me, O LORD, from the evil man: preserve me from the violent man;

violent man 19 PSA 18 48 # He delivereth me from mine enemies: yea, thou liftest me up above those that rise up against me: thou hast delivered me from the violent man.

violent men have <u>19\_PSA\_86\_14</u># O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent [men] have sought after my soul; and have not set thee before them.

violent perverting of <u>21\_ECC\_05\_08</u># If thou seest the oppression of the poor, and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter: for [he that is] higher than the highest regardeth; and [there be] higher than they.

violent take it <u>40\_MAT\_11\_12</u># And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.

violently away or <u>03\_LEV\_06\_04</u> # Then it shall be, because he hath sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath deceitfully gotten, or that which was

delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found,

violently down a 42\_LUK\_08\_33 # Then went the devils out of the man, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the lake, and were choked.

violently down a <u>41\_MAR\_05\_13</u> # And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. And the unclean spirits went out, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, [they were about two thousand;] and were choked in the sea.

violently down a <u>40\_MAT\_08\_32</u># And he said unto them, Go. And when they were come out, they went into the herd of swine: and, behold, the whole herd of swine ran violently down a steep place into the sea, and perished in the waters.

violently take away <u>18\_JOB\_24\_02</u> # [Some] remove the landmarks; they violently take away flocks, and feed [thereof].

violently taken away <u>05\_DEU\_28\_31</u> # Thine ox [shall be] slain before thine eyes, and thou shalt not eat thereof: thine ass [shall be] violently taken away from before thy face, and shall not be restored to thee: thy sheep [shall be] given unto thine enemies, and thou shalt have none to rescue [them].

violently taken away <u>01\_GEN\_21\_25</u># And Abraham reproved Abimelech because of a well of water, which Abimelech's servants had violently taken away.

violently taken away <u>18\_JOB\_20\_19</u> # Because he hath oppressed [and] hath forsaken the poor; [because] he hath violently taken away an house which he builded not;

violently taken away <u>25\_LAM\_02\_06</u># And he hath violently taken away his tabernacle, as [if it were of] a garden: he hath destroyed his places of the assembly: the LORD hath caused the solemn feasts and sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion, and hath despised in the indignation of his anger the king and the priest.

violently turn and <u>23\_ISA\_22\_18</u># He will surely violently turn and toss thee [like] a ball into a large country: there shalt thou die, and there the chariots of thy glory [shall be] the shame of thy lord's house.
