Philip findeth Nathanael <u>43_JOH_01_45</u># Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.

Philip Go near 44_ACT_08_29 # Then the Spirit said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this chariot.

Philip he that 43 JOH 14 09 # Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou [then], Show us the Father?

Philip opened his <u>44_ACT_08_35</u># Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus.

Philip preaching the <u>44_ACT_08_12</u> # But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.

Philip ran thither 44_ACT_08_30 # And Philip ran thither to [him], and heard him read the prophet Esaias, and said, Understandest thou what thou readest?

Philip said If <u>44_ACT_08_37</u> # And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

Philip saith unto 43_JOH_01_46 # And Nathanael said unto him, Can there any good thing come out of Nazareth? Philip saith unto him, Come and see.

Philip saith unto 43_JOH_14_08 # Philip saith unto him, Lord, show us the Father, and it sufficeth us.

Philip saying Arise 44_ACT_08_26 # And the angel of the Lord spake unto Philip, saying, Arise, and go toward the south unto the way that goeth down from Jerusalem unto Gaza, which is desert.

Philip spake hearing 44_ACT_08_06 # And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.

Philip tell Jesus 43_JOH_12_22# Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus.

Philip tetrarch of <u>42_LUK_03_01</u> # Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judaea, and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of Ituraea and of the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias the tetrarch of Abilene,

Philip that he <u>44_ACT_08_31</u> # And he said, How can I, except some man should guide me? And he desired Philip that he would come up and sit with him.

Philip that the 44_ACT_08_39 # And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.

Philip the evangelist <u>44_ACT_21_08</u> # And the next [day] we that were of Paul's company departed, and came unto Caesarea: and we entered into the house of Philip the evangelist, which was [one] of the seven; and abode with him.

Philip was found <u>44_ACT_08_40</u> # But Philip was found at Azotus: and passing through he preached in all the cities, till he came to Caesarea.

Philip was of 43_JOH_01_44 # Now Philip was of Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.

Philip went down 44_ACT_08_05 # Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them.

Philip Whence shall <u>43_JOH_06_05</u> # When Jesus then lifted up [his] eyes, and saw a great company come unto him, he saith unto Philip, Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat?

Philip which was 43_JOH_12_21 # The same came therefore to Philip, which was of Bethsaida of Galilee, and desired him, saying, Sir, we would see Jesus.

Philip's wife and <u>42_LUK_03_19</u> # But Herod the tetrarch, being reproved by him for Herodias his brother Philip's wife, and for all the evils which Herod had done,

Philip's wife for 41_MAR_06_17 # For Herod himself had sent forth and laid hold upon John, and bound him in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife: for he had married her.

Philip's wife <u>40_MAT_14_03</u># For Herod had laid hold on John, and bound him, and put [him] in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife.

Philippi after the <u>44_ACT_20_06</u># And we sailed away from Philippi after the days of unleavened bread, and came unto them to Troas in five days; where we abode seven days.

Philippi and by 41_MAR_08_27 # And Jesus went out, and his disciples, into the towns of Caesarea Philippi: and by the way he asked his disciples, saying unto them, Whom do men say that I am?

Philippi he asked 40_MAT_16_13# When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, Whom do men say that I the Son of man am?

Philippi we were <u>52_1TH_02_02</u># But even after that we had suffered before, and were shamefully entreated, as ye know, at Philippi, we were bold in our God to speak unto you the gospel of God with much contention.

Philippi which is <u>44_ACT_16_12</u># And from thence to Philippi, which is the chief city of that part of Macedonia, [and] a colony: and we were in that city abiding certain days.

Philippi with the <u>50_PHP_01_01</u># Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, to all the saints in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons:

Philippians know also <u>50_PHP_04_15</u> # Now ye Philippians know also, that in the beginning of the gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church communicated with me as concerning giving and receiving, but ye only.

slip not 19_PSA_17_05 # Hold up my goings in thy paths, [that] my footsteps slip not.

slip with his <u>18_JOB_12_05</u># He that is ready to slip with [his] feet [is as] a lamp despised in the thought of him that is at ease.

slip 10_2SA_22_37 # Thou hast enlarged my steps under me; so that my feet did not slip.

slip <u>58_HEB_02_01</u># Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let [them] slip.

slip 19_PSA_18_36 # Thou hast enlarged my steps under me, that my feet did not slip.

slipped away out <u>09_1SA_19_10</u># And Saul sought to smite David even to the wall with the javelin; but he slipped away out of Saul's presence, and he smote the javelin into the wall: and David fled, and escaped that night.

slipped 19_PSA_73_02 # But as for me, my feet were almost gone; my steps had well nigh slipped.

slippery and let 19_PSA_35_06 # Let their way be dark and slippery: and let the angel of the LORD persecute them.

slippery places thou <u>19_PSA_73_18</u># Surely thou didst set them in slippery places: thou castedst them down into destruction.

slippery ways in <u>24_JER_23_12</u> # Wherefore their way shall be unto them as slippery [ways] in the darkness: they shall be driven on, and fall therein: for I will bring evil upon them, [even] the year of their visitation, saith the LORD.

slippeth from the <u>05_DEU_19_05</u># As when a man goeth into the wood with his neighbour to hew wood, and his hand fetcheth a stroke with the ax to cut down the tree, and the head slippeth from the helve, and lighteth upon his neighbour, that he die; he shall flee unto one of those cities, and live:

slippeth they magnify 19_PSA_38_16 # For I said, [Hear me], lest [otherwise] they should rejoice over me: when my foot slippeth, they magnify [themselves] against me.

slippeth thy mercy 19_PSA_94_18 # When I said, My foot slippeth; thy mercy, O LORD, held me up.

slips <u>23_ISA_17_10</u># Because thou hast forgotten the God of thy salvation, and hast not been mindful of the rock of thy strength, therefore shalt thou plant pleasant plants, and shalt set it with strange slips:
