

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

loins according to <u>44\_ACT\_02\_30</u> # Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne;

loins and arise <u>24\_JER\_01\_17</u># Thou therefore gird up thy loins, and arise, and speak unto them all that I command thee: be not dismayed at their faces, lest I confound thee before them.

loins and arise <u>24\_JER\_13\_04</u> # Take the girdle that thou hast got, which [is] upon thy loins, and arise, go to Euphrates, and hide it there in a hole of the rock.

loins and baldness <u>30\_AMO\_08\_10</u> # And I will turn your feasts into mourning, and all your songs into lamentation; and I will bring up sackcloth upon all loins, and baldness upon every head; and I will make it as the mourning of an only [son], and the end thereof as a bitter day.

loins and faithfulness <u>23\_ISA\_11\_05</u># And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and faithfulness the girdle of his reins.

loins And he <u>12\_2KI\_01\_08</u># And they answered him, [He was] an hairy man, and girt with a girdle of leather about his loins. And he said, It [is] Elijah the Tishbite.

loins and he <u>41\_MAR\_01\_06</u># And John was clothed with camel's hair, and with a girdle of a skin about his loins; and he did eat locusts and wild honey;

loins and his <u>18\_JOB\_40\_16</u># Lo now, his strength [is] in his loins, and his force [is] in the navel of his belly.

loins and his <u>40\_MAT\_03\_04</u># And the same John had his raiment of camel's hair, and a leathern girdle about his loins; and his meat was locusts and wild honey.

loins and in <u>11\_1KI\_02\_05</u># Moreover thou knowest also what Joab the son of Zeruiah did to me, [and] what he did to the two captains of the hosts of Israel, unto Abner the son of Ner, and unto Amasa the son of Jether, whom he slew, and shed the blood of war in peace, and put the blood of war upon his girdle that [was] about his loins, and in his shoes that [were] on his feet.

loins and mourned <u>01\_GEN\_37\_34</u># And Jacob rent his clothes, and put sackcloth upon his loins, and mourned for his son many days.

loins and put <u>11\_1KI\_20\_32</u># So they girded sackcloth on their loins, and [put] ropes on their heads, and came to the king of Israel, and said, Thy servant Benhadad saith, I pray thee, let me live. And he said, [Is] he yet alive? he [is] my brother.

loins and put <u>23\_ISA\_20\_02</u> # At the same time spake the LORD by Isaiah the son of Amoz, saying, Go and loose the sackcloth from off thy loins, and put off thy shoe from thy foot. And he did so, walking naked and barefoot.

loins and put <u>24\_JER\_13\_01</u> # Thus saith the LORD unto me, Go and get thee a linen girdle, and put it upon thy loins, and put it not in water.

loins and ran <u>11\_1KI\_18\_46</u># And the hand of the LORD was on Elijah; and he girded up his loins, and ran before Ahab to the entrance of Jezreel.

loins and ropes <u>11\_1KI\_20\_31</u># And his servants said unto him, Behold now, we have heard that the kings of the house of Israel [are] merciful kings: let us, I pray thee, put sackcloth on our loins, and ropes upon our heads, and go out to the king of Israel: peradventure he will save thy life.

loins and take <u>12\_2KI\_04\_29</u># Then he said to Gehazi, Gird up thy loins, and take my staff in thine hand, and go thy way: if thou meet any man, salute him not; and if any salute thee, answer him not again: and lay my staff upon the face of the child.

loins and take <u>12\_2KI\_09\_01</u> # And Elisha the prophet called one of the children of the prophets, and said unto him, Gird up thy loins, and take this box of oil in thine hand, and go to Ramothgilead:

loins and the <u>34\_NAH\_02\_10</u># She is empty, and void, and waste: and the heart melteth, and the knees smite together, and much pain [is] in all loins, and the faces of them all gather blackness.

loins and with <u>26 EZE 21 06</u># Sigh therefore, thou son of man, with the breaking of [thy] loins; and with bitterness sigh before their eyes.

loins are filled <u>19\_PSA\_38\_07</u># For my loins are filled with a loathsome [disease]: and [there is] no soundness in my flesh.

loins as a <u>24\_JER\_30\_06</u> # Ask ye now, and see whether a man doth travail with child? wherefore do I see every man with his hands on his loins, as a woman in travail, and all faces are turned into paleness?

loins be girded <u>42\_LUK\_12\_35</u> # Let your loins be girded about, and [your] lights burning;

loins be loosed 23\_ISA\_05\_27 # None shall be weary nor stumble among them; none shall slumber nor sleep; neither shall the girdle of their loins be loosed, nor the latchet of their shoes be broken:

loins besides Jacob's <u>01\_GEN\_46\_26</u># All the souls that came with Jacob into Egypt, which came out of his loins, besides Jacob's sons' wives, all the souls [were] threescore and six;

loins continually to <u>19\_PSA\_69\_23</u># Let their eyes be darkened, that they see not; and make their loins continually to shake.

loins even downward <u>26\_EZE\_01\_27</u> # And I saw as the colour of amber, as the appearance of fire round about within it, from the appearance of his loins even upward, and from the appearance of his loins even downward, I saw as it were the appearance of fire, and it had brightness round about.

loins even downward <u>26\_EZE\_08\_02</u> # Then I beheld, and lo a likeness as the appearance of fire: from the appearance of his loins even downward, fire; and from his loins even upward, as the appearance of brightness, as the colour of amber.

loins even unto <u>02\_EXO\_28\_42</u> # And thou shalt make them linen breeches to cover their nakedness; from the loins even unto the thighs they shall reach:

loins exceeding in <u>26\_EZE\_23\_15</u> # Girded with girdles upon their loins, exceeding in dyed attire upon their heads, all of them princes to look to, after the manner of the Babylonians of Chaldea, the land of their nativity:

loins filled with <u>23\_ISA\_21\_03</u># Therefore are my loins filled with pain: pangs have taken hold upon me, as the pangs of a woman that travaileth: I was bowed down at the hearing [of it]; I was dismayed at the seeing [of it].

loins girded your <u>02\_EXO\_12\_11</u># And thus shall ye eat it; [with] your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it [is] the LORD'S passover.

loins girt about <u>49\_EPH\_06\_14</u> # Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

loins have not <u>18\_JOB\_31\_20</u> # If his loins have not blessed me, and [if] he were [not] warmed with the fleece of my sheep;

loins he shall <u>11\_1KI\_08\_19</u># Nevertheless thou shalt not build the house; but thy son that shall come forth out of thy loins, he shall build the house unto my name.

loins he shall <u>14\_2CH\_06\_09</u># Notwithstanding thou shalt not build the house; but thy son which shall come forth out of thy loins, he shall build the house for my name.

loins in the <u>10\_2SA\_20\_08</u> # When they [were] at the great stone which [is] in Gibeon, Amasa went before them. And Joab's garment that he had put on was girded unto him, and upon it a girdle [with] a sword fastened upon his loins in the sheath thereof; and as he went forth it fell out.

loins like a <u>18\_JOB\_38\_03</u># Gird up now thy loins like a man; for I will demand of thee, and answer thou me.

loins now like <u>18\_JOB\_40\_07</u># Gird up thy loins now like a man: I will demand of thee, and declare thou unto me.

loins of a <u>24\_JER\_13\_11</u># For as the girdle cleaveth to the loins of a man, so have I caused to cleave unto me the whole house of Israel and the whole house of Judah, saith the LORD; that they might be unto me for a people, and for a name, and for a praise, and for a glory: but they would not hear.

loins of Abraham <u>58\_HEB\_07\_05</u> # And verily they that are of the sons of Levi, who receive the office of the priesthood, have a commandment to take tithes of the people according to the law, that is, of their brethren, though they come out of the loins of Abraham:

loins of his <u>58\_HEB\_07\_10</u># For he was yet in the loins of his father, when Melchisedec met him.

loins of Jacob <u>02\_EXO\_01\_05</u># And all the souls that came out of the loins of Jacob were seventy souls: for Joseph was in Egypt [already].

loins of kings <u>23\_ISA\_45\_01</u> # Thus saith the LORD to his anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have holden, to subdue nations before him; and I will loose the loins of kings, to open before him the two leaved gates; and the gates shall not be shut;

loins of them <u>05\_DEU\_33\_11</u># Bless, LORD, his substance, and accept the work of his hands: smite through the loins of them that rise against him, and of them that hate him, that they rise not again.

loins of your 60\_1PE\_01\_13 # Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for

the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

loins sackcloth <u>24\_JER\_48\_37</u> # For every head [shall be] bald, and every beard clipped: upon all the hands [shall be] cuttings, and upon the loins sackcloth.

loins strong fortify <u>34\_NAH\_02\_01</u> # He that dasheth in pieces is come up before thy face: keep the munition, watch the way, make [thy] loins strong, fortify [thy] power mightily.

loins they shall <u>26\_EZE\_44\_18</u> # They shall have linen bonnets upon their heads, and shall have linen breeches upon their loins; they shall not gird [themselves] with any thing that causeth sweat.

loins to be <u>26\_EZE\_29\_07</u> # When they took hold of thee by thy hand, thou didst break, and rend all their shoulder: and when they leaned upon thee, thou brakest, and madest all their loins to be at a stand.

loins were girded <u>27\_DAN\_10\_05</u># Then I lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a certain man clothed in linen, whose loins [were] girded with fine gold of Uphaz:

loins were loosed <u>27\_DAN\_05\_06</u> # Then the king's countenance was changed, and his thoughts troubled him, so that the joints of his loins were loosed, and his knees smote one against another.

loins with a <u>18\_JOB\_12\_18</u># He looseth the bond of kings, and girdeth their loins with a girdle.

loins with strength <u>20\_PRO\_31\_17</u># She girdeth her loins with strength, and strengtheneth her arms.

loins <u>11\_1KI\_12\_10</u># And the young men that were grown up with him spake unto him, saying, Thus shalt thou speak unto this people that spake unto thee, saying, Thy father made our yoke heavy, but make thou [it] lighter unto us; thus shalt thou say unto them, My little [finger] shall be thicker than my father's loins.

loins <u>14\_2CH\_10\_10</u> # And the young men that were brought up with him spake unto him, saying, Thus shalt thou answer the people that spake unto thee, saying, Thy father made our yoke heavy, but make thou [it] somewhat lighter for us; thus shalt thou say unto them, My little [finger] shall be thicker than my father's loins.

loins <u>26\_EZE\_47\_04</u> # Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through the waters; the waters [were] to the knees. Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through; the waters [were] to the loins.

loins <u>01\_GEN\_35\_11</u># And God said unto him, I [am] God Almighty: be fruitful and multiply; a nation and a company of nations shall be of thee, and kings shall come out of thy loins;

loins <u>23\_ISA\_32\_11</u># Tremble, ye women that are at ease; be troubled, ye careless ones: strip you, and make you bare, and gird [sackcloth] upon [your] loins.

loins <u>24\_JER\_13\_02</u> # So I got a girdle according to the word of the LORD, and put [it] on my loins.

loins <u>19\_PSA\_66\_11</u># Thou broughtest us into the net; thou laidst affliction upon our loins.
