loves My heart [19_PSA_45_01](#) # To the chief Musician upon Shoshannim, for the sons of Korah, Maschil, A Song of loves. My heart is inditing a good matter: I speak of the things which I have made touching the king: my tongue [is] the pen of a ready writer.

loves [20_PRO_07_18](#) # Come, let us take our fill of love until the morning: let us solace ourselves with loves.

loves [22_SON_07_12](#) # Let us get up early to the vineyards; let us see if the vine flourish, [whether] the tender grape appear, [and] the pomegranates bud forth: there will I give thee my loves.

lovest all devouring [19_PSA_52_04](#) # Thou lovest all devouring words, O [thou] deceitful tongue.
