Lystra and behold [44 ACT 16 01](#) # Then came he to Derbe and Lystra: and, behold, a certain disciple was there, named Timotheus, the son of a certain woman, which was a Jewess, and believed; but his father [was] a Greek:

Lystra and Derbe [44 ACT 14 06](#) # They were ware of [it], and fled unto Lystra and Derbe, cities of Lycaonia, and unto the region that lieth round about:

Lystra and Iconium [44 ACT 16 02](#) # Which was well reported of by the brethren that were at Lystra and Iconium.

Lystra and to [44 ACT 14 21](#) # And when they had preached the gospel to that city, and had taught many, they returned again to Lystra, and [to] Iconium, and Antioch,

Lystra impotent in [44 ACT 14 08](#) # And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked:

Lystra what persecutions [55 2TI 03 11](#) # Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of [them] all the Lord delivered me.
