languish and the [23 ISA 16 08](#) # For the fields of Heshbon languish, [and] the vine of Sibmah: the lords of the heathen have broken down the principal plants thereof, they are come [even] unto Jazer, they wandered [through] the wilderness: her branches are stretched out, they are gone over the sea.

languish they are [24 JER 14 02](#) # Judah mourneth, and the gates thereof languish; they are black unto the ground; and the cry of Jerusalem is gone up.

languish with the [28 HOS 04 03](#) # Therefore shall the land mourn, and every one that dwelleth therein shall languish, with the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven; yea, the fishes of the sea also shall be taken away.

languish [23 ISA 19 08](#) # The fishers also shall mourn, and all they that cast angle into the brooks shall lament, and they that spread nets upon the waters shall languish.

languish [23 ISA 24 04](#) # The earth mourneth [and] fadeth away, the world languisheth [and] fadeth away, the haughty people of the earth do languish.

languished together [25 LAM 02 08](#) # The LORD hath purposed to destroy the wall of the daughter of Zion: he hath stretched out a line, he hath not withdrawn his hand from destroying: therefore he made the rampart and the wall to lament; they languished together.

languisheth all the [23 ISA 24 07](#) # The new wine mourneth, the vine languisheth, all the merryhearted do sigh.

languisheth and Carmel [34 NAH 01 04](#) # He rebuketh the sea, and maketh it dry, and drieth up all the rivers: Bashan languisheth, and Carmel, and the flower of Lebanon languisheth.

languisheth and fadeth [23 ISA 24 04](#) # The earth mourneth [and] fadeth away, the world languisheth [and] fadeth away, the haughty people of the earth do languish.

languisheth Lebanon is [23 ISA 33 09](#) # The earth mourneth [and] languisheth: Lebanon is ashamed [and] hewn down: Sharon is like a wilderness; and Bashan and Carmel shake off [their fruits].

languisheth she hath [24 JER 15 09](#) # She that hath borne seven languisheth: she hath given up the ghost; her sun is gone down while [it was] yet day: she hath been ashamed and confounded: and the residue of them will I deliver to the sword before their enemies, saith the LORD.

languisheth the pomegranate [29 JOE 01 12](#) # The vine is dried up, and the fig tree languisheth; the pomegranate tree, the palm tree also, and the apple tree, [even] all the trees of the field, are withered: because joy is withered away from the sons of men.

languisheth [29 JOE 01 10](#) # The field is wasted, the land mourneth; for the corn is wasted: the new wine is dried up, the oil languisheth.

languisheth [34 NAH 01 04](#) # He rebuketh the sea, and maketh it dry, and drieth up all the rivers: Bashan languisheth, and Carmel, and the flower of Lebanon languisheth.
