clay and anointed [43 JOH 09 11](#) # He answered and said, A man that is called Jesus made clay, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight.

clay and brake [27 DAN 02 34](#) # Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet [that were] of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces.

clay and opened [43 JOH 09 14](#) # And it was the sabbath day when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes.

clay and part [27 DAN 02 41](#) # And whereas thou sawest the feet and toes, part of potter's clay, and part of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay.

clay and set [19 PSA 40 02](#) # He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, [and] established my goings.

clay for shall [23 ISA 29 16](#) # Surely your turning of things upside down shall be esteemed as the potter's clay: for shall the work say of him that made it, He made me not? or shall the thing framed say of him that framed it, He had no understanding?

clay ground between [11 1KI 07 46](#) # In the plain of Jordan did the king cast them, in the clay ground between Succoth and Zarthan.

clay ground between [14 2CH 04 17](#) # In the plain of Jordan did the king cast them, in the clay ground between Succoth and Zeredathah.

clay in the [24 JER 43 09](#) # Take great stones in thine hand, and hide them in the clay in the brickkiln, which [is] at the entry of Pharaoh's house in Tahpanhes, in the sight of the men of Judah;

clay is in [24 JER 18 06](#) # O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? saith the LORD. Behold, as the clay [is] in the potter's hand, so [are] ye in mine hand, O house of Israel.

clay of the [43 JOH 09 06](#) # When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay,

clay of the [45 ROM 09 21](#) # Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?

clay say to [23 ISA 45 09](#) # Woe unto him that striveth with his Maker! [Let] the potsherd [strive] with the potsherds of the earth. Shall the clay say to him that fashioneth it, What makest thou? or thy work, He hath no hands?

clay so the [27 DAN 02 42](#) # And [as] the toes of the feet [were] part of iron, and part of clay, [so] the kingdom shall be partly strong, and partly broken.

clay the brass [27 DAN 02 35](#) # Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the stone that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.

clay was marred [24 JER 18 04](#) # And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter: so he made it again another vessel, as seemed good to the potter to make [it].

clay whose foundation [18 JOB 04 19](#) # How much less [in] them that dwell in houses of clay, whose foundation [is] in the dust, [which] are crushed before the moth?

clay [27 DAN 02 33](#) # His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay.

clay [27 DAN 02 41](#) # And whereas thou sawest the feet and toes, part of potter's clay, and part of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay.

clay [18 JOB 27 16](#) # Though he heap up silver as the dust, and prepare raiment as the clay;

clay [18 JOB 33 06](#) # Behold, I [am] according to thy wish in God's stead: I also am formed out of the clay.

clay [43 JOH 09 06](#) # When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay,

delayed to come [02 EXO 32 01](#) # And when the people saw that Moses delayed to come down out of the mount, the people gathered themselves together unto Aaron, and said unto him, Up, make us gods, which shall go before us; for [as for] this Moses, the man that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him.

delayeth his coming [42 LUK 12 45](#) # But and if that servant say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; and shall begin to beat the menservants and maidens, and to eat and drink, and to be drunken;

delayeth his coming [40 MAT 24 48](#) # But and if that evil servant shall say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming;

displayed because of [19 PSA 60 04](#) # Thou hast given a banner to them that fear thee, that it may be displayed because of the truth. Selah.

flay all the [14 2CH 29 34](#) # But the priests were too few, so that they could not flay all the burnt offerings: wherefore their brethren the Levites did help them, till the work was ended, and until the [other] priests had sanctified themselves: for the Levites [were] more upright in heart to sanctify themselves than the priests.

flay the burnt [03 LEV 01 06](#) # And he shall flay the burnt offering, and cut it into his pieces.

flay their skin [33 MIC 03 03](#) # Who also eat the flesh of my people, and flay their skin from off them; and they break their bones, and chop them in pieces, as for the pot, and as flesh within the caldron.

lay a snare [23 ISA 29 21](#) # That make a man an offender for a word, and lay a snare for him that reproveth in the gate, and turn aside the just for a thing of nought.

lay a stumblingblock [26 EZE 03 20](#) # Again, When a righteous [man] doth turn from his righteousness, and commit iniquity, and I lay a stumblingblock before him, he shall die: because thou hast not given him

warning, he shall die in his sin, and his righteousness which he hath done shall not be remembered; but his blood will I require at thine hand.

lay all night [10\\_2SA\\_12\\_16](#) # David therefore besought God for the child; and David fasted, and went in, and lay all night upon the earth.

lay all night [18\\_JOB\\_29\\_19](#) # My root [was] spread out by the waters, and the dew lay all night upon my branch.

lay along in [07\\_JUD\\_07\\_12](#) # And the Midianites and the Amalekites and all the children of the east lay along in the valley like grasshoppers for multitude; and their camels [were] without number, as the sand by the sea side for multitude.

lay and Abner [09\\_1SA\\_26\\_05](#) # And David arose, and came to the place where Saul had pitched: and David beheld the place where Saul lay, and Abner the son of Ner, the captain of his host: and Saul lay in the trench, and the people pitched round about him.

lay and departed [42\\_LUK\\_05\\_25](#) # And immediately he rose up before them, and took up that whereon he lay, and departed to his own house, glorifying God.

lay and hatch [23\\_ISA\\_34\\_15](#) # There shall the great owl make her nest, and lay, and hatch, and gather under her shadow: there shall the vultures also be gathered, every one with her mate.

lay apart all [59\\_JAM\\_01\\_21](#) # Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

lay aside every [58\\_HEB\\_12\\_01](#) # Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset [us], and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,

lay at his [08\\_RUT\\_03\\_08](#) # And it came to pass at midnight, that the man was afraid, and turned himself: and, behold, a woman lay at his feet.

lay bound with [41 MAR 15 07](#) # And there was [one] named Barabbas, [which lay] bound with them that had made insurrection with him, who had committed murder in the insurrection.

lay dead and [07 JUD 04 22](#) # And, behold, as Barak pursued Sisera, Jael came out to meet him, and said unto him, Come, and I will show thee the man whom thou seekest. And when he came into her [tent], behold, Sisera lay dead, and the nail [was] in his temples.

lay desolate for [33 MIC 01 07](#) # And all the graven images thereof shall be beaten to pieces, and all the hires thereof shall be burned with the fire, and all the idols thereof will I lay desolate: for she gathered [it] of the hire of an harlot, and they shall return to the hire of an harlot.

lay desolate in [26 EZE 36 34](#) # And the desolate land shall be tilled, whereas it lay desolate in the sight of all that passed by.

lay desolate she [14 2CH 36 21](#) # To fulfil the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had enjoyed her sabbaths: [for] as long as she lay desolate she kept sabbath, to fulfil threescore and ten years.

lay down among [26 EZE 19 02](#) # And say, What [is] thy mother? A lioness: she lay down among lions, she nourished her whelps among young lions.

lay down and [10 2SA 13 06](#) # So Amnon lay down, and made himself sick: and when the king was come to see him, Amnon said unto the king, I pray thee, let Tamar my sister come, and make me a couple of cakes in my sight, that I may eat at her hand.

lay down as [04 NUM 24 09](#) # He couched, he lay down as a lion, and as a great lion: who shall stir him up? Blessed [is] he that blesseth thee, and cursed [is] he that curseth thee.

lay down at [07 JUD 05 27](#) # At her feet he bowed, he fell, he lay down: at her feet he bowed, he fell: where he bowed, there he fell down dead.

lay down his [43 JOH 15 13](#) # Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.

lay down in [09 1SA 03 09](#) # Therefore Eli said unto Samuel, Go, lie down: and it shall be, if he call thee, that thou shalt say, Speak, LORD; for thy servant heareth. So Samuel went and lay down in his place.

lay down in [01 GEN 28 11](#) # And he lighted upon a certain place, and tarried there all night, because the sun was set; and he took of the stones of that place, and put [them for] his pillows, and lay down in that place to sleep.

lay down my [43 JOH 10 15](#) # As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my

life for the sheep.

lay down my [43 JOH 10 17](#) # Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again.

lay down my [43 JOH 13 37](#) # Peter said unto him, Lord, why cannot I follow thee now? I will lay down my life for thy sake.

lay down naked [09 ISA 19 24](#) # And he stripped off his clothes also, and prophesied before Samuel in like manner, and lay down naked all that day and all that night. Wherefore they say, [Is] Saul also among the prophets?

lay down nor [01 GEN 19 33](#) # And they made their father drink wine that night: and the firstborn went in, and lay with her father; and he perceived not when she lay down, nor when she arose.

lay down nor [01 GEN 19 35](#) # And they made their father drink wine that night also: and the younger arose, and lay with him; and he perceived not when she lay down, nor when she arose.

Lay down now [18 JOB 17 03](#) # Lay down now, put me in a surety with thee; who [is] he [that] will strike hands with me?

lay down our [62 1JO 03 16](#) # Hereby perceive we the love [of God], because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down [our] lives for the brethren.

lay down the [01 GEN 19 04](#) # But before they lay down, the men of the city, [even] the men of Sodom, compassed the house round, both old and young, all the people from every quarter:

lay down thy [43 JOH 13 38](#) # Jesus answered him, Wilt thou lay down thy life for my sake? Verily, verily, I say unto thee, The cock shall not crow, till thou hast denied me thrice.

lay down [09 ISA 03 05](#) # And he ran unto Eli, and said, Here [am] I; for thou calledst me. And he said, I called not; lie down again. And he went and lay down.

lay field to [23 ISA 05 08](#) # Woe unto them that join house to house, [that] lay field to field, till [there be] no place, that they may be placed alone in the midst of the earth!

lay frankincense thereon [03 LEV 02 15](#) # And thou shalt put oil upon it, and lay frankincense thereon: it [is] a meat offering.

lay hand on [17 EST 02 21](#) # In those days, while Mordecai sat in the king's gate, two of the king's chamberlains, Bigthan and Teresh, of those which kept the door, were wroth, and sought to lay hand on the king Ahasuerus.

lay hand on [17 EST 06 02](#) # And it was found written, that Mordecai had told of Bigthana and Teresh, two of the king's chamberlains, the keepers of the door, who sought to lay hand on the king Ahasuerus.

lay hand on [17 EST 09 02](#) # The Jews gathered themselves together in their cities throughout all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus, to lay hand on such as sought their hurt: and no man could withstand them; for the fear of them fell upon all people.

lay hands he [44 ACT 08 19](#) # Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.

lay hands on [17 EST 03 06](#) # And he thought scorn to lay hands on Mordecai alone; for they had showed him the people of Mordecai: wherefore Haman sought to destroy all the Jews that [were] throughout the

whole kingdom of Ahasuerus, [even] the people of Mordecai.

lay hands on [42\\_LUK\\_20\\_19](#) # And the chief priests and the scribes the same hour sought to lay hands on him; and they feared the people: for they perceived that he had spoken this parable against them.

lay hands on [41\\_MAR\\_16\\_18](#) # They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

lay hands on [40\\_MAT\\_21\\_46](#) # But when they sought to lay hands on him, they feared the multitude, because they took him for a prophet.

lay hands on [16\\_NEH\\_13\\_21](#) # Then I testified against them, and said unto them, Why lodge ye about the wall? if ye do [so] again, I will lay hands on you. From that time forth came they no [more] on the sabbath.

Lay hands suddenly [54\\_1TI\\_05\\_22](#) # Lay hands suddenly on no man, neither be partaker of other men's sins: keep thyself pure.

lay her young [19\\_PSA\\_84\\_03](#) # Yea, the sparrow hath found an house, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may lay her young, [even] thine altars, O LORD of hosts, my King, and my God.

lay him before [42\\_LUK\\_05\\_18](#) # And, behold, men brought in a bed a man which was taken with a palsy: and they sought [means] to bring him in, and to lay [him] before him.

lay his hand [18\\_JOB\\_09\\_33](#) # Neither is there any daysman betwixt us, [that] might lay his hand upon us both.

lay his hand [03\\_LEV\\_03\\_02](#) # And he shall lay his hand upon the head of his offering, and kill it [at] the door of the tabernacle of the congregation: and Aaron's sons the priests shall sprinkle the blood upon the altar round about.

lay his hand [03\\_LEV\\_03\\_08](#) # And he shall lay his hand upon the head of his offering, and kill it before the tabernacle of the congregation: and Aaron's sons shall sprinkle the blood thereof round about upon the altar.

lay his hand [03\\_LEV\\_03\\_13](#) # And he shall lay his hand upon the head of it, and kill it before the tabernacle of the congregation: and the sons of Aaron shall sprinkle the blood thereof upon the altar round about.

lay his hand [03\\_LEV\\_04\\_04](#) # And he shall bring the bullock unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD; and shall lay his hand upon the bullock's head, and kill the bullock before the LORD.

lay his hand [03\\_LEV\\_04\\_24](#) # And he shall lay his hand upon the head of the goat, and kill it in the place where they kill the burnt offering before the LORD: it [is] a sin offering.

lay his hand [03\\_LEV\\_04\\_29](#) # And he shall lay his hand upon the head of the sin offering, and slay the sin offering in the place of the burnt offering.

lay his hand [03\\_LEV\\_04\\_33](#) # And he shall lay his hand upon the head of the sin offering, and slay it for a sin offering in the place where they kill the burnt offering.

lay his head [42\\_LUK\\_09\\_58](#) # And Jesus said unto him, Foxes have holes, and birds of the air [have] nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay [his] head.

lay his head [40\\_MAT\\_08\\_20](#) # And Jesus saith unto him, The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air [have] nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay [his] head.

lay hold every [38\\_ZEC\\_14\\_13](#) # And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] a great tumult from the LORD shall be among them; and they shall lay hold every one on the hand of his neighbour, and his hand shall rise up against the hand of his neighbour.

lay hold of [23\\_ISA\\_05\\_29](#) # Their roaring [shall be] like a lion, they shall roar like young lions: yea, they shall roar, and lay hold of the prey, and shall carry [it] away safe, and none shall deliver [it].

Lay hold on [11\\_1KI\\_13\\_04](#) # And it came to pass, when king Jeroboam heard the saying of the man of God, which had cried against the altar in Bethel, that he put forth his hand from the altar, saying, Lay hold on him. lay hold on [54\\_1TI\\_06\\_12](#) # Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.

lay hold on [54\\_1TI\\_06\\_19](#) # Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

lay hold on [05\\_DEU\\_21\\_19](#) # Then shall his father and his mother lay hold on him, and bring him out unto the elders of his city, and unto the gate of his place;

lay hold on [05\\_DEU\\_22\\_28](#) # If a man find a damsel [that is] a virgin, which is not betrothed, and lay hold on her, and lie with her, and they be found;

lay hold on [21\\_ECC\\_02\\_03](#) # I sought in mine heart to give myself unto wine, yet acquainting mine heart with wisdom; and to lay hold on folly, till I might see what [was] that good for the sons of men, which they should do under the heaven all the days of their life.

lay hold on [24\\_JER\\_06\\_23](#) # They shall lay hold on bow and spear; they [are] cruel, and have no mercy; their voice roareth like the sea; and they ride upon horses, set in array as men for war against thee, O daughter of Zion.

lay hold on [41\\_MAR\\_03\\_21](#) # And when his friends heard [of it], they went out to lay hold on him: for they said, He is beside himself.

slay David without [09\\_1SA\\_19\\_05](#) # For he did put his life in his hand, and slew the Philistine, and the LORD wrought a great salvation for all Israel: thou sawest [it], and didst rejoice: wherefore then wilt thou sin against innocent blood, to slay David without a cause?

slay David [09\\_1SA\\_20\\_33](#) # And Saul cast a javelin at him to smite him: whereby Jonathan knew that it was determined of his father to slay David.

slay even the [28\\_HOS\\_09\\_16](#) # Ephraim is smitten, their root is dried up, they shall bear no fruit: yea, though they bring forth, yet will I slay [even] the beloved [fruit] of their womb.

slay every man [02\\_EXO\\_32\\_27](#) # And he said unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, [and] go in and out from gate to gate throughout the camp, and slay every man his brother, and every man his companion, and every man his neighbour.

slay her before [04\\_NUM\\_19\\_03](#) # And ye shall give her unto Eleazar the priest, that he may bring her forth without the camp, and [one] shall slay her before his face:

Slay her not [14\\_2CH\\_23\\_14](#) # Then Jehoiada the priest brought out the captains of hundreds that were set over the host, and said unto them, Have her forth of the ranges: and whoso followeth her, let him be slain with the sword. For the priest said, Slay her not in the house of the LORD.

slay her with [28\\_HOS\\_02\\_03](#) # Lest I strip her naked, and set her as in the day that she was born, and make her as a wilderness, and set her like a dry land, and slay her with thirst.

slay him and [11\\_1KI\\_15\\_28](#) # Even in the third year of Asa king of Judah did Baasha slay him, and reigned in his stead.

slay him and [01\\_GEN\\_37\\_20](#) # Come now therefore, and let us slay him, and cast him into some pit, and we will say, Some evil beast hath devoured him: and we shall see what will become of his dreams.

slay him because [43\\_JOH\\_05\\_16](#) # And therefore did the Jews persecute Jesus, and sought to slay him, because he had done these things on the sabbath day.

slay him in [09\\_1SA\\_19\\_11](#) # Saul also sent messengers unto David's house, to watch him, and to slay him in the morning: and Michal David's wife told him, saying, If thou save not thy life to night, to morrow thou shalt be slain.

slay him whereas [05\\_DEU\\_19\\_06](#) # Lest the avenger of the blood pursue the slayer, while his heart is hot, and overtake him, because the way is long, and slay him; whereas he [was] not worthy of death, inasmuch as he hated him not in time past.

slay him with [02\\_EXO\\_21\\_14](#) # But if a man come presumptuously upon his neighbour, to slay him with guile; thou shalt take him from mine altar, that he may die.

slay him [18\\_JOB\\_20\\_16](#) # He shall suck the poison of asps: the viper's tongue shall slay him.

slay him [04\\_NUM\\_35\\_19](#) # The revenger of blood himself shall slay the murderer: when he meeteth him, he shall slay him.

slay him [19\\_PSA\\_37\\_32](#) # The wicked watcheth the righteous, and seeketh to slay him.

slay his servant [11\\_1KI\\_01\\_51](#) # And it was told Solomon, saying, Behold, Adonijah feareth king Solomon: for, lo, he hath caught hold on the horns of the altar, saying, Let king Solomon swear unto me to day that

he will not slay his servant with the sword.

slay his son [01\\_GEN\\_22\\_10](#) # And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son.

slay Ishmael the [24\\_JER\\_40\\_15](#) # Then Johanan the son of Kareah spake to Gedaliah in Mizpah secretly, saying, Let me go, I pray thee, and I will slay Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and no man shall know [it]: wherefore should he slay thee, that all the Jews which are gathered unto thee should be scattered, and the remnant in Judah perish?

slay it But [11\\_1KI\\_03\\_26](#) # Then spake the woman whose the living child [was] unto the king, for her bowels yearned upon her son, and she said, O my lord, give her the living child, and in no wise slay it. But the other said, Let it be neither mine nor thine, [but] divide [it].

slay it for [03\\_LEV\\_04\\_33](#) # And he shall lay his hand upon the head of the sin offering, and slay it for a sin offering in the place where they kill the burnt offering.

slay it she [11\\_1KI\\_03\\_27](#) # Then the king answered and said, Give her the living child, and in no wise slay it: she [is] the mother thereof.

slay me and [01\\_GEN\\_34\\_30](#) # And Jacob said to Simeon and Levi, Ye have troubled me to make me to stink among the inhabitants of the land, among the Canaanites and the Perizzites: and I [being] few in number, they shall gather themselves together against me, and slay me; and I shall be destroyed, I and my house.

slay me but [11\\_1KI\\_18\\_12](#) # And it shall come to pass, [as soon as] I am gone from thee, that the spirit of the LORD shall carry thee whither I know not; and [so] when I come and tell Ahab, and he cannot find thee, he shall slay me: but I thy servant fear the LORD from my youth.

slay me for [10\\_2SA\\_01\\_09](#) # He said unto me again, Stand, I pray thee, upon me, and slay me: for anguish is come upon me, because my life [is] yet whole in me.

slay me yet [18\\_JOB\\_13\\_15](#) # Though he slay me, yet will I trust in him: but I will maintain mine own ways before him.

slay me [11\\_1KI\\_18\\_09](#) # And he said, What have I sinned, that thou wouldest deliver thy servant into the hand of Ahab, to slay me?

slay me [11\\_1KI\\_18\\_14](#) # And now thou sayest, Go, tell thy lord, Behold, Elijah [is here]: and he shall slay me.

slay me [01\\_GEN\\_04\\_14](#) # Behold, thou hast driven me out this day from the face of the earth; and from thy

face shall I be hid; and I shall be a fugitive and a vagabond in the earth; and it shall come to pass, [that] every one that findeth me shall slay me.

slay Moses But [02\\_EXO\\_02\\_15](#) # Now when Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh, and dwelt in the land of Midian: and he sat down by a well.

slay my brother [01\\_GEN\\_27\\_41](#) # And Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing wherewith his father blessed him: and Esau said in his heart, The days of mourning for my father are at hand; then will I slay my brother Jacob.

slay my son [11\\_1KI\\_17\\_18](#) # And she said unto Elijah, What have I to do with thee, O thou man of God? art thou come unto me to call my sin to remembrance, and to slay my son?

Slay my two [01\\_GEN\\_42\\_37](#) # And Reuben spake unto his father, saying, Slay my two sons, if I bring him not to thee: deliver him into my hand, and I will bring him to thee again.

slay our brother [01\\_GEN\\_37\\_26](#) # And Judah said unto his brethren, What profit [is it] if we slay our brother, and conceal his blood?

slay such as [19\\_PSA\\_37\\_14](#) # The wicked have drawn out the sword, and have bent their bow, to cast down the poor and needy, [and] to slay such as be of upright conversation.

slay suddenly he [18\\_JOB\\_09\\_23](#) # If the scourge slay suddenly, he will laugh at the trial of the innocent.

slay the beast [03\\_LEV\\_20\\_15](#) # And if a man lie with a beast, he shall surely be put to death: and ye shall slay the beast.

slay the broken [19\\_PSA\\_109\\_16](#) # Because that he remembered not to show mercy, but persecuted the poor and needy man, that he might even slay the broken in heart.

slay the burnt [26\\_EZE\\_44\\_11](#) # Yet they shall be ministers in my sanctuary, [having] charge at the gates of the house, and ministering to the house: they shall slay the burnt offering and the sacrifice for the people, and they shall stand before them to minister unto them.

slay the murderer [04\\_NUM\\_35\\_21](#) # Or in enmity smite him with his hand, that he die: he that smote [him] shall surely be put to death; [for] he [is] a murderer: the revenger of blood shall slay the murderer, when he meeteth him.

slay the nations [35\\_HAB\\_01\\_17](#) # Shall they therefore empty their net, and not spare continually to slay the nations?

slay the priests [09 ISA 22 17](#) # And the king said unto the footmen that stood about him, Turn, and slay the priests of the LORD; because their hand also [is] with David, and because they knew when he fled, and did not show it to me. But the servants of the king would not put forth their hand to fall upon the priests of the LORD.

slay the ram [02 EXO 29 16](#) # And thou shalt slay the ram, and thou shalt take his blood, and sprinkle [it] round about upon the altar.

slay the righteous [01 GEN 18 25](#) # That be far from thee to do after this manner, to slay the righteous with the wicked: and that the righteous should be as the wicked, that be far from thee: Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?

slay the sin [03 LEV 04 29](#) # And he shall lay his hand upon the head of the sin offering, and slay the sin offering in the place of the burnt offering.

slay the souls [26 EZE 13 19](#) # And will ye pollute me among my people for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, to slay the souls that should not die, and to save the souls alive that should not live, by your lying to my people that hear [your] lies?

slay the third [66 REV 09 15](#) # And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men.

slay the wicked [23 ISA 11 04](#) # But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked.

slay the wicked [19 PSA 139 19](#) # Surely thou wilt slay the wicked, O God: depart from me therefore, ye bloody men.

slay the wicked [19 PSA 34 21](#) # Evil shall slay the wicked: and they that hate the righteous shall be desolate.

slay the widow [19 PSA 94 06](#) # They slay the widow and the stranger, and murder the fatherless.

slay the wise [27 DAN 02 14](#) # Then Daniel answered with counsel and wisdom to Arioch the captain of the king's guard, which was gone forth to slay the wise [men] of Babylon:

slay thee And [11 1KI 20 36](#) # Then said he unto him, Because thou hast not obeyed the voice of the LORD, behold, as soon as thou art departed from me, a lion shall slay thee. And as soon as he was departed from him, a lion found him, and slew him.

slay thee and [23 ISA 65 15](#) # And ye shall leave your name for a curse unto my chosen: for the Lord GOD shall slay thee, and call his servants by another name:

slay thee But [24 JER 40 14](#) # And said unto him, Dost thou certainly know that Baalis the king of the Ammonites hath sent Ishmael the son of Nethaniah to slay thee? But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam believed them not.

slay thee that [24 JER 40 15](#) # Then Johanan the son of Kareah spake to Gedaliah in Mizpah secretly, saying, Let me go, I pray thee, and I will slay Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and no man shall know [it]: wherefore should he slay thee, that all the Jews which are gathered unto thee should be scattered, and the remnant in Judah perish?

slay thee [16\\_NEH\\_06\\_10](#) # Afterward I came unto the house of Shemaiah the son of Delaiah the son of Mehetebeel, who [was] shut up; and he said, Let us meet together in the house of God, within the temple, and let us shut the doors of the temple: for they will come to slay thee; yea, in the night will they come to slay thee.

slay their sons [26\\_EZE\\_23\\_47](#) # And the company shall stone them with stones, and dispatch them with their swords; they shall slay their sons and their daughters, and burn up their houses with fire.

And he answered, Because I know the evil that thou wilt do unto the children of Israel: their strong holds wilt thou set on fire, and their young men wilt thou slay with the sword, and wilt dash their children, and rip up their women with child.

slay with the [26\\_EZE\\_26\\_08](#) # He shall slay with the sword thy daughters in the field: and he shall make a fort against thee, and cast a mount against thee, and lift up the buckler against thee.

slay with the [06\\_JOS\\_13\\_22](#) # Balaam also the son of Beor, the soothsayer, did the children of Israel slay with the sword among them that were slain by them.

Slay ye every [04\\_NUM\\_25\\_05](#) # And Moses said unto the judges of Israel, Slay ye every one his men that were joined unto Baalpeor.

slay you [07\\_JUD\\_08\\_19](#) # And he said, They [were] my brethren, [even] the sons of my mother: [as] the LORD liveth, if ye had saved them alive, I would not slay you.

slay [11\\_1KI\\_19\\_17](#) # And it shall come to pass, [that] him that escapeth the sword of Hazael shall Jehu slay: and him that escapeth from the sword of Jehu shall Elisha slay.

slayer and Beeshterah [06\\_JOS\\_21\\_27](#) # And unto the children of Gershon, of the families of the Levites, out of the [other] half tribe of Manasseh [they gave] Golan in Bashan with her suburbs, [to be] a city of refuge for the slayer; and Beeshterah with her suburbs; two cities.

slayer and Gezer [06\\_JOS\\_21\\_21](#) # For they gave them Shechem with her suburbs in mount Ephraim, [to be] a city of refuge for the slayer; and Gezer with her suburbs,

slayer and Hammothdor [06\\_JOS\\_21\\_32](#) # And out of the tribe of Naphtali, Kedesh in Galilee with her suburbs, [to be] a city of refuge for the slayer; and Hammothdor with her suburbs, and Kartan with her suburbs; three cities.

slayer and Libnah [06\\_JOS\\_21\\_13](#) # Thus they gave to the children of Aaron the priest Hebron with her suburbs, [to be] a city of refuge for the slayer; and Libnah with her suburbs,

slayer and Mahanaim [06\\_JOS\\_21\\_38](#) # And out of the tribe of Gad, Ramoth in Gilead with her suburbs, [to be] a city of refuge for the slayer; and Mahanaim with her suburbs,

slayer and the [04\\_NUM\\_35\\_24](#) # Then the congregation shall judge between the slayer and the revenger of blood according to these judgments:

slayer he shall [04\\_NUM\\_35\\_27](#) # And the revenger of blood find him without the borders of the city of his refuge, and the revenger of blood kill the slayer; he shall not be guilty of blood:

slayer may flee [05\\_DEU\\_19\\_03](#) # Thou shalt prepare thee a way, and divide the coasts of thy land, which the LORD thy God giveth thee to inherit, into three parts, that every slayer may flee thither.

slayer may flee [04\\_NUM\\_35\\_11](#) # Then ye shall appoint you cities to be cities of refuge for you; that the slayer may flee thither, which killeth any person at unawares.

slayer might flee [05\\_DEU\\_04\\_42](#) # That the slayer might flee thither, which should kill his neighbour unawares, and hated him not in times past; and that fleeing unto one of these cities he might live:

slayer out of [04\\_NUM\\_35\\_25](#) # And the congregation shall deliver the slayer out of the hand of the revenger of blood, and the congregation shall restore him to the city of his refuge, whither he was fled: and he shall abide in it unto the death of the high priest, which was anointed with the holy oil.

slayer return and [06\\_JOS\\_20\\_06](#) # And he shall dwell in that city, until he stand before the congregation for judgment, [and] until the death of the high priest that shall be in those days: then shall the slayer return, and come unto his own city, and unto his own house, unto the city from whence he fled.

slayer shall at [04\\_NUM\\_35\\_26](#) # But if the slayer shall at any time come without the border of the city of his refuge, whither he was fled;

slayer shall return [04\\_NUM\\_35\\_28](#) # Because he should have remained in the city of his refuge until the death of the high priest: but after the death of the high priest the slayer shall return into the land of his possession.

slayer that killeth [06\\_JOS\\_20\\_03](#) # That the slayer that killeth [any] person unawares [and] unwittingly may flee thither: and they shall be your refuge from the avenger of blood.

slayer up into [06\\_JOS\\_20\\_05](#) # And if the avenger of blood pursue after him, then they shall not deliver the slayer up into his hand; because he smote his neighbour unwittingly, and hated him not beforetime.

slayer which shall [05\\_DEU\\_19\\_04](#) # And this [is] the case of the slayer, which shall flee thither, that he may live: Whoso killeth his neighbour ignorantly, whom he hated not in time past;
