Menahem and all [12_2KI_15_21](#) # And the rest of the acts of Menahem, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Menahem began to [12_2KI_15_23](#) # In the fiftieth year of Azariah king of Judah Pekahiah the son of Menahem began to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] two years.

Menahem exacted the [12_2KI_15_20](#) # And Menahem exacted the money of Israel, [even] of all the mighty men of wealth, of each man fifty shekels of silver, to give to the king of Assyria. So the king of Assyria turned back, and stayed not there in the land.

Menahem gave Pul [12_2KI_15_19](#) # [And] Pul the king of Assyria came against the land: and Menahem gave Pul a thousand talents of silver, that his hand might be with him to confirm the kingdom in his hand.

Menahem slept with [12_2KI_15_22](#) # And Menahem slept with his fathers; and Pekahiah his son reigned in his stead.

Menahem smote Tiphseh [12_2KI_15_16](#) # Then Menahem smote Tiphseh, and all that [were] therein, and the coasts thereof from Tirzah: because they opened not [to him], therefore he smote [it; and] all the women therein that were with child he ripped up.

Menahem the son [12_2KI_15_14](#) # For Menahem the son of Gadi went up from Tirzah, and came to Samaria, and smote Shallum the son of Jabesh in Samaria, and slew him, and reigned in his stead.

Menahem the son [12_2KI_15_17](#) # In the nine and thirtieth year of Azariah king of Judah began Menahem the son of Gadi to reign over Israel, [and reigned] ten years in Samaria.
