Micaiah and carry [11 1KI 22 26](#) # And the king of Israel said, Take Micaiah, and carry him back unto Amon the governor of the city, and to Joash the king's son;

Micaiah and carry [14 2CH 18 25](#) # Then the king of Israel said, Take ye Micaiah, and carry him back to Amon the governor of the city, and to Joash the king's son;

Micaiah on the [11 1KI 22 24](#) # But Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah went near, and smote Micaiah on the cheek, and said, Which way went the spirit of the LORD from me to speak unto thee?

Micaiah said As [11 1KI 22 14](#) # And Micaiah said, [As] the LORD liveth, what the LORD saith unto me, that will I speak.

Micaiah said As [14 2CH 18 13](#) # And Micaiah said, [As] the LORD liveth, even what my God saith, that will I speak.

Micaiah said Behold [11 1KI 22 25](#) # And Micaiah said, Behold, thou shalt see in that day, when thou shalt go into an inner chamber to hide thyself.

Micaiah said Behold [14 2CH 18 24](#) # And Micaiah said, Behold, thou shalt see on that day when thou shalt go into an inner chamber to hide thyself.

Micaiah said If [11 1KI 22 28](#) # And Micaiah said, If thou return at all in peace, the LORD hath not spoken by me. And he said, Hearken, O people, every one of you.

Micaiah said If [14 2CH 18 27](#) # And Micaiah said, If thou certainly return in peace, [then] hath not the LORD spoken by me. And he said, Hearken, all ye people.

Micaiah shall we [11 1KI 22 15](#) # So he came to the king. And the king said unto him, Micaiah, shall we go against Ramothgilead to battle, or shall we forbear? And he answered him, Go, and prosper: for the LORD shall deliver [it] into the hand of the king.

Micaiah spake unto [11 1KI 22 13](#) # And the messenger that was gone to call Micaiah spake unto him, saying, Behold now, the words of the prophets [declare] good unto the king with one mouth: let thy word, I pray thee, be like the word of one of them, and speak [that which is] good.
