Michaiah and Shaphan [12 2KI 22 12](#) # And the king commanded Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Achbor the son of Michaiah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asahiah a servant of the king's, saying,

Michaiah declared unto [24 JER 36 13](#) # Then Michaiah declared unto them all the words that he had heard, when Baruch read the book in the ears of the people.

Michaiah Elioenai Zechariah [16 NEH 12 41](#) # And the priests; Eliakim, Maaseiah, Miniamin, Michaiah, Elioenai, Zechariah, [and] Hananiah, with trumpets;

Michaiah the daughter [14 2CH 13 02](#) # He reigned three years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Michaiah the daughter of Uriel of Gibeah. And there was war between Abijah and Jeroboam.

Michaiah the son [24 JER 36 11](#) # When Michaiah the son of Gemariah, the son of Shaphan, had heard out of the book all the words of the LORD,

Michaiah the son [16 NEH 12 35](#) # And [certain] of the priests' sons with trumpets; [namely], Zechariah the son of Jonathan, the son of Shemaiah, the son of Mattaniah, the son of Michaiah, the son of Zaccur, the son of Asaph:

Michaiah to teach [14 2CH 17 07](#) # Also in the third year of his reign he sent to his princes, [even] to Benhail, and to Obadiah, and to Zechariah, and to Nethaneel, and to Michaiah, to teach in the cities of Judah.
