maimed and many [40\\_MAT\\_15\\_30](#) # And great multitudes came unto him, having with them [those that were] lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them:

maimed and the [42\\_LUK\\_14\\_21](#) # So that servant came, and showed his lord these things. Then the master of the house being angry said to his servant, Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in hither the poor, and the maimed, and the halt, and the blind.

maimed or having [03\\_LEV\\_22\\_22](#) # Blind, or broken, or maimed, or having a wen, or scurvy, or scabbed, ye shall not offer these unto the LORD, nor make an offering by fire of them upon the altar unto the LORD.

maimed rather than [40\\_MAT\\_18\\_08](#) # Wherefore if thy hand or thy foot offend thee, cut them off, and cast [them] from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life halt or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet to be cast into everlasting fire.

maimed than having [41\\_MAR\\_09\\_43](#) # And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:

maimed the lame [42\\_LUK\\_14\\_13](#) # But when thou makest a feast, call the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind:
