marred in the [24 JER 18 04](#) # And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter: so he made it again another vessel, as seemed good to the potter to make [it].

marred it was [24 JER 13 07](#) # Then I went to Euphrates, and digged, and took the girdle from the place where I had hid it: and, behold, the girdle was marred, it was profitable for nothing.

marred more than [23 ISA 52 14](#) # As many were astonished at thee; his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men:
