intermeddle with his <u>20_PRO_14_10</u># The heart knoweth his own bitterness; and a stranger doth not intermeddle with his joy.

intermeddleth with all <u>20_PRO_18_01</u># Through desire a man, having separated himself, seeketh [and] intermeddleth with all wisdom.

Meddle not with <u>05_DEU_02_05</u> # Meddle not with them; for I will not give you of their land, no, not so much as a foot breadth; because I have given mount Seir unto Esau [for] a possession.

meddle not with <u>20_PRO_20_19</u># He that goeth about [as] a talebearer revealeth secrets: therefore meddle not with him that flattereth with his lips.

meddle not with <u>20_PRO_24_21</u># My son, fear thou the LORD and the king: [and] meddle not with them that are given to change:

meddle to thine <u>14_2CH_25_19</u> # Thou sayest, Lo, thou hast smitten the Edomites; and thine heart lifteth thee up to boast: abide now at home; why shouldest thou meddle to [thine] hurt, that thou shouldest fall, [even] thou, and Judah with thee?

meddle to thy <u>12_2KI_14_10</u># Thou hast indeed smitten Edom, and thine heart hath lifted thee up: glory [of this], and tarry at home: for why shouldest thou meddle to [thy] hurt, that thou shouldest fall, [even] thou, and Judah with thee?

meddle with them <u>05_DEU_02_19</u> # And [when] thou comest nigh over against the children of Ammon, distress them not, nor meddle with them: for I will not give thee of the land of the children of Ammon [any] possession; because I have given it unto the children of Lot [for] a possession.

meddled with <u>20_PRO_17_14</u># The beginning of strife [is as] when one letteth out water: therefore leave off contention, before it be meddled with.

meddleth with strife <u>20_PRO_26_17</u> # He that passeth by, [and] meddleth with strife [belonging] not to him, [is like] one that taketh a dog by the ears.
