intermeddle with his [20 PRO 14 10](#) # The heart knoweth his own bitterness; and a stranger doth not intermeddle with his joy.

intermeddleth with all [20 PRO 18 01](#) # Through desire a man, having separated himself, seeketh [and] intermeddleth with all wisdom.

Meddle not with [05 DEU 02 05](#) # Meddle not with them; for I will not give you of their land, no, not so much as a foot breadth; because I have given mount Seir unto Esau [for] a possession.

meddle not with [20 PRO 20 19](#) # He that goeth about [as] a talebearer revealeth secrets: therefore meddle not with him that flattereth with his lips.

meddle not with [20 PRO 24 21](#) # My son, fear thou the LORD and the king: [and] meddle not with them that are given to change:

meddle to thine [14 2CH 25 19](#) # Thou sayest, Lo, thou hast smitten the Edomites; and thine heart lifteth thee up to boast: abide now at home; why shouldest thou meddle to [thine] hurt, that thou shouldest fall, [even] thou, and Judah with thee?

meddle to thy [12 2KI 14 10](#) # Thou hast indeed smitten Edom, and thine heart hath lifted thee up: glory [of this], and tarry at home: for why shouldest thou meddle to [thy] hurt, that thou shouldest fall, [even] thou, and Judah with thee?

meddle with them [05 DEU 02 19](#) # And [when] thou comest nigh over against the children of Ammon, distress them not, nor meddle with them: for I will not give thee of the land of the children of Ammon [any] possession; because I have given it unto the children of Lot [for] a possession.

meddled with [20 PRO 17 14](#) # The beginning of strife [is as] when one letteth out water: therefore leave off contention, before it be meddled with.

meddleth with strife [20 PRO 26 17](#) # He that passeth by, [and] meddleth with strife [belonging] not to him, [is like] one that taketh a dog by the ears.
