mourned and no [02\\_EXO\\_33\\_04](#) # And when the people heard these evil tidings, they mourned: and no man did put on him his ornaments.

mourned and wept [10\\_2SA\\_01\\_12](#) # And they mourned, and wept, and fasted until even, for Saul, and for Jonathan his son, and for the people of the LORD, and for the house of Israel; because they were fallen by the sword.

mourned and wept [41\\_MAR\\_16\\_10](#) # [And] she went and told them that had been with him, as they mourned and wept.

mourned because of [15\\_EZR\\_10\\_06](#) # Then Ezra rose up from before the house of God, and went into the chamber of Johanan the son of Eliashib: and [when] he came thither, he did eat no bread, nor drink water: for he mourned because of the transgression of them that had been carried away.

mourned certain days [16\\_NEH\\_01\\_04](#) # And it came to pass, when I heard these words, that I sat down and wept, and mourned [certain] days, and fasted, and prayed before the God of heaven,

mourned for Aaron [04\\_NUM\\_20\\_29](#) # And when all the congregation saw that Aaron was dead, they mourned for Aaron thirty days, [even] all the house of Israel.

mourned for her [10\\_2SA\\_11\\_26](#) # And when the wife of Uriah heard that Uriah her husband was dead, she mourned for her husband.

mourned for him [11\\_1KI\\_14\\_18](#) # And they buried him; and all Israel mourned for him, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by the hand of his servant Ahijah the prophet.

mourned for him [01\\_GEN\\_50\\_03](#) # And forty days were fulfilled for him; for so are fulfilled the days of those which are embalmed: and the Egyptians mourned for him threescore and ten days.

mourned for his [10\\_2SA\\_13\\_37](#) # But Absalom fled, and went to Talmai, the son of Ammihud, king of Geshur. And [David] mourned for his son every day.

mourned for his [01\\_GEN\\_37\\_34](#) # And Jacob rent his clothes, and put sackcloth upon his loins, and mourned for his son many days.

mourned for Josiah [14\\_2CH\\_35\\_24](#) # His servants therefore took him out of that chariot, and put him in the second chariot that he had; and they brought him to Jerusalem, and he died, and was buried in [one of] the sepulchres of his fathers. And all Judah and Jerusalem mourned for Josiah.

mourned for Saul [09\\_1SA\\_15\\_35](#) # And Samuel came no more to see Saul until the day of his death: nevertheless Samuel mourned for Saul: and the LORD repented that he had made Saul king over Israel.

mourned for the [10\\_2SA\\_14\\_02](#) # And Joab sent to Tekoah, and fetched thence a wise woman, and said unto her, I pray thee, feign thyself to be a mourner, and put on now mourning apparel, and anoint not thyself with oil, but be as a woman that had a long time mourned for the dead:

mourned greatly [04\\_NUM\\_14\\_39](#) # And Moses told these sayings unto all the children of Israel: and the people mourned greatly.

mourned in the [38\\_ZEC\\_07\\_05](#) # Speak unto all the people of the land, and to the priests, saying, When ye fasted and mourned in the fifth and seventh [month], even those seventy years, did ye at all fast unto me, [even] to me?

mourned many days [13\\_1CH\\_07\\_22](#) # And Ephraim their father mourned many days, and his brethren came to comfort him.

mourned over him [11\\_1KI\\_13\\_30](#) # And he laid his carcase in his own grave; and they mourned over him, [saying], Alas, my brother!

mourned that he [46\\_ICO\\_05\\_02](#) # And ye are puffed up, and have not rather mourned, that he that hath done this deed might be taken away from among you.

mourned to you [42\\_LUK\\_07\\_32](#) # They are like unto children sitting in the marketplace, and calling one to another, and saying, We have piped unto you, and ye have not danced; we have mourned to you, and ye have not wept.

mourned unto you [40\\_MAT\\_11\\_17](#) # And saying, We have piped unto you, and ye have not danced; we have mourned unto you, and ye have not lamented.

mourned with a [01\\_GEN\\_50\\_10](#) # And they came to the threshingfloor of Atad, which [is] beyond Jordan, and there they mourned with a great and very sore lamentation: and he made a mourning for his father seven days.
