neighbours a scorn 19 PSA 44 13 # Thou makest us a reproach to our neighbours, a scorn and a derision to them that are round about us.

neighbours a scorn 19 PSA 79 04.# We are become a reproach to our neighbours, a scorn and derision to them that are round about us.

neighbours and a 19 PSA 31 11# I was a reproach among all mine enemies, but especially among my neighbours, and a fear to mine acquaintance: they that did see me without fled from me.

neighbours and he 24 JER 49 10 # But I have made Esau bare, I have uncovered his secret places, and he shall not be able to hide himself: his seed is spoiled, and his brethren, and his neighbours, and he [is] not.

neighbours and her 42 LUK 01 58 # And her neighbours and her cousins heard how the Lord had showed great mercy upon her; and they rejoiced with her.

neighbours and our 19 PSA 80 06 # Thou makest us a strife unto our neighbours: and our enemies laugh among themselves.

neighbours and that 06 JOS 09 16 # And it came to pass at the end of three days after they had made a league with them, that they heard that they [were] their neighbours, and [that] they dwelt among them.

neighbours but mischief 19 PSA 28 03 # Draw me not away with the wicked, and with the workers of iniquity, which speak peace to their neighbours, but mischief [is] in their hearts.

neighbours by extortion 26 EZE 22 12 # In thee have they taken gifts to shed blood; thou hast taken usury and increase, and thou hast greedily gained of thy neighbours by extortion, and hast forgotten me, saith the Lord GOD.

neighbours captains and 26 EZE 23 12 # She doted upon the Assyrians [her] neighbours, captains and rulers clothed most gorgeously, horsemen riding upon horses, all of them desirable young men.

neighbours even empty 12 2KI 04 03 # Then he said, Go, borrow thee vessels abroad of all thy neighbours, [even] empty vessels; borrow not a few.

neighbours gave it 08 RUT 04 17 # And the women her neighbours gave it a name, saying, There is a son born to Naomi; and they called his name Obed: he [is] the father of Jesse, the father of David.

neighbours great of 26 EZE 16 26 # Thou hast also committed fornication with the Egyptians thy neighbours, great of flesh; and hast increased thy whoredoms, to provoke me to anger.

neighbours lest they <u>42 LUK 14 12</u> # Then said he also to him that bade him, When thou makest a dinner or a supper, call not thy friends, nor thy brethren, neither thy kinsmen, nor [thy] rich neighbours; lest they also bid thee again, and a recompense be made thee.

neighbours wives and 24 JER 29 23 # Because they have committed villany in Israel, and have committed adultery with their neighbours' wives, and have spoken lying words in my name, which I have not commanded them; even I know, and [am] a witness, saith the LORD.
