named Abiathar escaped <u>09\_1SA\_22\_20</u> # And one of the sons of Ahimelech the son of Ahitub, named Abiathar, escaped, and fled after David.

named AEneas which 44\_ACT\_09\_33 # And there he found a certain man named AEneas, which had kept his bed eight years, and was sick of the palsy.

named Agabus and <u>44\_ACT\_11\_28</u># And there stood up one of them named Agabus, and signified by the Spirit that there should be great dearth throughout all the world: which came to pass in the days of Claudius Caesar.

named Agabus <u>44\_ACT\_21\_10</u> # And as we tarried [there] many days, there came down from Judaea a certain prophet, named Agabus.

named already and <u>21\_ECC\_06\_10</u># That which hath been is named already, and it is known that it [is] man: neither may he contend with him that is mightier than he.

named among the <u>46\_1CO\_05\_01</u># It is reported commonly [that there is] fornication among you, and such fornication as is not so much as named among the Gentiles, that one should have his father's wife.

named among you <u>49\_EPH\_05\_03</u> # But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints;

named Ananias and 44\_ACT\_09\_10 # And there was a certain disciple at Damascus, named Ananias; and to him said the Lord in a vision, Ananias. And he said, Behold, I [am here], Lord.

named Ananias coming 44\_ACT\_09\_12 # And hath seen in a vision a man named Ananias coming in, and putting [his] hand on him, that he might receive his sight.

named Ananias with 44\_ACT\_05\_01 # But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession,

named Apollos born <u>44\_ACT\_18\_24</u># And a certain Jew named Apollos, born at Alexandria, an eloquent man, [and] mighty in the scriptures, came to Ephesus.

named apostles <u>42\_LUK\_06\_13</u> # And when it was day, he called [unto him] his disciples: and of them he chose twelve, whom also he named apostles;

named Aquila born <u>44\_ACT\_18\_02</u># And found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, lately come from Italy, with his wife Priscilla; [because that Claudius had commanded all Jews to depart from Rome:] and came unto them.

named Barabbas which <u>41\_MAR\_15\_07</u># And there was [one] named Barabbas, [which lay] bound with them that had made insurrection with him, who had committed murder in the insurrection.

named Belteshazzar now <u>27\_DAN\_05\_12</u># Forasmuch as an excellent spirit, and knowledge, and understanding, interpreting of dreams, and showing of hard sentences, and dissolving of doubts, were found in the same Daniel, whom the king named Belteshazzar: now let Daniel be called, and he will show the interpretation.

named Caiaphas being 43\_JOH\_11\_49 # And one of them, [named] Caiaphas, being the high priest that same year, said unto them, Ye know nothing at all,

named chief of <u>30\_AMO\_06\_01</u> # Woe to them [that are] at ease in Zion, and trust in the mountain of Samaria, [which are] named chief of the nations, to whom the house of Israel came!

named Damaris and <u>44\_ACT\_17\_34</u> # Howbeit certain men clave unto him, and believed: among the which [was] Dionysius the Areopagite, and a woman named Damaris, and others with them.

named Demetrius a <u>44\_ACT\_19\_24</u> # For a certain [man] named Demetrius, a silversmith, which made silver shrines for Diana, brought no small gain unto the craftsmen;

named Eutychus being <u>44\_ACT\_20\_09</u># And there sat in a window a certain young man named Eutychus, being fallen into a deep sleep: and as Paul was long preaching, he sunk down with sleep, and fell down from the third loft, and was taken up dead.

named Gamaliel a <u>44\_ACT\_05\_34</u># Then stood there up one in the council, a Pharisee, named Gamaliel, a doctor of the law, had in reputation among all the people, and commanded to put the apostles forth a little space;

named Gethsemane and 41\_MAR\_14\_32 # And they came to a place which was named Gethsemane: and he saith to his disciples, Sit ye here, while I shall pray.

named Goliath of <u>09\_1SA\_17\_04</u># And there went out a champion out of the camp of the Philistines, named Goliath, of Gath, whose height [was] six cubits and a span.

named in the <u>01\_GEN\_23\_16</u># And Abraham hearkened unto Ephron; and Abraham weighed to Ephron the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current [money] with the merchant.

named in the 24\_JER\_44\_26# Therefore hear ye the word of the LORD, all Judah that dwell in the land of Egypt; Behold, I have sworn by my great name, saith the LORD, that my name shall no more be named in the mouth of any man of Judah in all the land of Egypt, saying, The Lord GOD liveth.

named Israel 12 2KI 17 34 # Unto this day they do after the former manners: they fear not the LORD, neither do they after their statutes, or after their ordinances, or after the law and commandment which the LORD commanded the children of Jacob, whom he named Israel;

named Jacob for <u>01\_GEN\_27\_36</u># And he said, Is not he rightly named Jacob? for he hath supplanted me these two times: he took away my birthright; and, behold, now he hath taken away my blessing. And he said, Hast thou not reserved a blessing for me?

named Jairus and 42\_LUK\_08\_41 # And, behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue: and he fell down at Jesus' feet, and besought him that he would come into his house:

named Joseph a <u>42\_LUK\_23\_50</u> # And, behold, [there was] a man named Joseph, a counsellor; [and he was] a good man, and a just:

named Joseph who 40\_MAT\_27\_57 # When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathaea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus' disciple:

named Julius a <u>44\_ACT\_27\_01</u> # And when it was determined that we should sail into Italy, they delivered Paul and certain other prisoners unto [one] named Julius, a centurion of Augustus' band.

named Justus one <u>44\_ACT\_18\_07</u># And he departed thence, and entered into a certain [man's] house, named Justus, [one] that worshipped God, whose house joined hard to the synagogue.

named Lazarus of 43\_JOH\_11\_01# Now a certain [man] was sick, [named] Lazarus, of Bethany, the town of Mary and her sister Martha.

named Lazarus which <u>42\_LUK\_16\_20</u># And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores,

named lest I <u>45\_ROM\_15\_20</u> # Yea, so have I strived to preach the gospel, not where Christ was named, lest I should build upon another man's foundation:

named Levi sitting 42\_LUK\_05\_27 # And after these things he went forth, and saw a publican, named Levi, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he said unto him, Follow me.

named Lydia a <u>44\_ACT\_16\_14</u># And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard [us]: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.

named Martha received <u>42\_LUK\_10\_38</u># Now it came to pass, as they went, that he entered into a certain village: and a certain woman named Martha received him into her house.

named Matthew sitting 40 MAT\_09 09 # And as Jesus passed forth from thence, he saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he saith unto him, Follow me. And he arose, and followed him.

named Nazareth <u>42\_LUK\_01\_26</u># And in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God unto a city of Galilee, named Nazareth,

named Nicodemus a <u>43\_JOH\_03\_01</u># There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews:

named not only <u>49\_EPH\_01\_21</u> # Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

named of the 13\_1CH\_23\_14 # Now [concerning] Moses the man of God, his sons were named of the tribe of Levi.

named of the <u>42\_LUK\_02\_21</u># And when eight days were accomplished for the circumcising of the child, his name was called JESUS, which was so named of the angel before he was conceived in the womb.

named on them <u>01\_GEN\_48\_16</u># The Angel which redeemed me from all evil, bless the lads; and let my name be named on them, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.

named Peter and <u>42\_LUK\_06\_14</u># Simon, [whom he also named Peter,] and Andrew his brother, James and John, Philip and Bartholomew,

named Rahab and <u>06\_JOS\_02\_01</u># And Joshua the son of Nun sent out of Shittim two men to spy secretly, saying, Go view the land, even Jericho. And they went, and came into an harlot's house, named Rahab, and lodged there.

named Rhoda <u>44\_ACT\_12\_13</u># And as Peter knocked at the door of the gate, a damsel came to hearken, named Rhoda.

named Tabitha which <u>44\_ACT\_09\_36</u> # Now there was at Joppa a certain disciple named Tabitha, which by interpretation is called Dorcas: this woman was full of good works and almsdeeds which she did.

named Tertullus who 44\_ACT\_24\_01 # And after five days Ananias the high priest descended with the elders, and [with] a certain orator [named] Tertullus, who informed the governor against Paul.

named the child <u>09\_1SA\_04\_21</u># And she named the child Ichabod, saying, The glory is departed from Israel: because the ark of God was taken, and because of her father in law and her husband.

named the house <u>33\_MIC\_02\_07</u># O [thou that art] named the house of Jacob, is the spirit of the LORD straitened? [are] these his doings? do not my words do good to him that walketh uprightly?

named the Priests 23 ISA 61 06 # But ye shall be named the Priests of the LORD: [men] shall call you the Ministers of our God: ye shall eat the riches of the Gentiles, and in their glory shall ye boast yourselves.

named Timotheus the <u>44\_ACT\_16\_01</u># Then came he to Derbe and Lystra: and, behold, a certain disciple was there, named Timotheus, the son of a certain woman, which was a Jewess, and believed; but his father [was] a Greek:

named Zacchaeus which <u>42\_LUK\_19\_02</u># And, behold, [there was] a man named Zacchaeus, which was the chief among the publicans, and he was rich.

named Zacharias of <u>42\_LUK\_01\_05</u># There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judaea, a certain priest named Zacharias, of the course of Abia: and his wife [was] of the daughters of Aaron, and her name [was] Elisabeth.

named 49\_EPH\_03\_15 # Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,

surnamed Barnabas which <u>44\_ACT\_04\_36</u> # And Joses, who by the apostles was surnamed Barnabas, [which is, being interpreted, The son of consolation,] a Levite, [and] of the country of Cyprus,

surnamed Barsabas and <u>44\_ACT\_15\_22</u> # Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; [namely], Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren:

surnamed Iscariot being <u>42\_LUK\_22\_03</u># Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.

surnamed Justus and <u>44\_ACT\_01\_23</u># And they appointed two, Joseph called Barsabas, who was surnamed Justus, and Matthias.

surnamed Peter were <u>44\_ACT\_10\_18</u># And called, and asked whether Simon, which was surnamed Peter, were lodged there.

surnamed Peter 41\_MAR\_03\_16 # And Simon he surnamed Peter;

surnamed thee though <u>23\_ISA\_45\_04</u> # For Jacob my servant's sake, and Israel mine elect, I have even called thee by thy name: I have surnamed thee, though thou hast not known me.

surnamed them Boanerges <u>41\_MAR\_03\_17</u> # And James the [son] of Zebedee, and John the brother of James; and he surnamed them Boanerges, which is, The sons of thunder:
