neighbour and every <u>58\_HEB\_08\_11</u># And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest.

neighbour and every 23\_ISA\_41\_06 # They helped every one his neighbour; and [every one] said to his brother, Be of good courage.

neighbour and every 24\_JER\_23\_35 # Thus shall ye say every one to his neighbour, and every one to his brother, What hath the LORD answered? and, What hath the LORD spoken?

neighbour with his <u>24\_JER\_09\_08</u># Their tongue [is as] an arrow shot out; it speaketh deceit: [one] speaketh peaceably to his neighbour with his mouth, but in heart he layeth his wait.

neighbour without cause <u>20\_PRO\_24\_28</u># Be not a witness against thy neighbour without cause; and deceive [not] with thy lips.

neighbour wrong thrust 44\_ACT\_07\_27 # But he that did his neighbour wrong thrust him away, saying, Who made thee a ruler and a judge over us?

neighbour's <u>02\_EXO\_20\_17</u># Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that [is] thy neighbour's.

neighbours a scorn 19 PSA 44 13 # Thou makest us a reproach to our neighbours, a scorn and a derision to them that are round about us.

neighbours a scorn 19\_PSA\_79\_04 # We are become a reproach to our neighbours, a scorn and derision to them that are round about us.

neighbours and a 19 PSA 31 11 # I was a reproach among all mine enemies, but especially among my neighbours, and a fear to mine acquaintance: they that did see me without fled from me.

neighbours and he <u>24\_JER\_49\_10</u># But I have made Esau bare, I have uncovered his secret places, and he shall not be able to hide himself: his seed is spoiled, and his brethren, and his neighbours, and he [is] not.

neighbours and her <u>42\_LUK\_01\_58</u># And her neighbours and her cousins heard how the Lord had showed great mercy upon her; and they rejoiced with her.

neighbours and our <u>19\_PSA\_80\_06</u># Thou makest us a strife unto our neighbours: and our enemies laugh among themselves.

neighbours that touch 24 JER\_12 14 # Thus saith the LORD against all mine evil neighbours, that touch the inheritance which I have caused my people Israel to inherit; Behold, I will pluck them out of their land, and pluck out the house of Judah from among them.

neighbours therefore and <u>43\_JOH\_09\_08</u> # The neighbours therefore, and they which before had seen him that he was blind, said, Is not this he that sat and begged?

neighbours together saying 42\_LUK\_15\_09 # And when she hath found [it], she calleth [her] friends and [her] neighbours together, saying, Rejoice with me; for I have found the piece which I had lost.

neighbours wives and 24 JER 29 23 # Because they have committed villany in Israel, and have committed adultery with their neighbours' wives, and have spoken lying words in my name, which I have not commanded them; even I know, and [am] a witness, saith the LORD.

neighbours <u>26\_EZE\_23\_05</u> # And Aholah played the harlot when she was mine; and she doted on her lovers, on the Assyrians [her] neighbours,

neighbours 19\_PSA\_89\_41 # All that pass by the way spoil him: he is a reproach to his neighbours.
