Ophir and fetched [11\\_1KI\\_09\\_28](#) # And they came to Ophir, and fetched from thence gold, four hundred and twenty talents, and brought [it] to king Solomon.

Ophir and Havilah [13\\_1CH\\_01\\_23](#) # And Ophir, and Havilah, and Jobab. All these [were] the sons of Joktan.

Ophir and Havilah [01\\_GEN\\_10\\_29](#) # And Ophir, and Havilah, and Jobab: all these [were] the sons of Joktan.

Ophir and seven [13\\_1CH\\_29\\_04](#) # [Even] three thousand talents of gold, of the gold of Ophir, and seven thousand talents of refined silver, to overlay the walls of the houses [withal]:
