Ophir and fetched <u>11\_1KI\_09\_28</u># And they came to Ophir, and fetched from thence gold, four hundred and twenty talents, and brought [it] to king Solomon.

Ophir and Havilah <u>13\_1CH\_01\_23</u># And Ophir, and Havilah, and Jobab. All these [were] the sons of Joktan.

Ophir and Havilah <u>01\_GEN\_10\_29</u> # And Ophir, and Havilah, and Jobab: all these [were] the sons of Joktan.

Ophir and seven <u>13\_1CH\_29\_04</u> # [Even] three thousand talents of gold, of the gold of Ophir, and seven thousand talents of refined silver, to overlay the walls of the houses [withal]:
