fodder [18 JOB 06 05](#) # Doth the wild ass bray when he hath grass? or loweth the ox over his fodder?

goddess Diana and [44 ACT 19 35](#) # And when the townclerk had appeased the people, he said, [Ye] men of Ephesus, what man is there that knoweth not how that the city of the Ephesians is a worshipper of the great goddess Diana, and of the [image] which fell down from Jupiter?
