oppressed a refuge 19\_PSA\_09\_09 # The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble.

oppressed and broken <u>28\_HOS\_05\_11</u># Ephraim [is] oppressed [and] broken in judgment, because he willingly walked after the commandment.

oppressed and crushed <u>05\_DEU\_28\_33</u># The fruit of thy land, and all thy labours, shall a nation which thou knowest not eat up; and thou shalt be only oppressed and crushed alway:
