oppressed a refuge [19 PSA 09 09](#) # The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble.

oppressed and broken [28 HOS 05 11](#) # Ephraim [is] oppressed [and] broken in judgment, because he willingly walked after the commandment.

oppressed and crushed [05 DEU 28 33](#) # The fruit of thy land, and all thy labours, shall a nation which thou knowest not eat up; and thou shalt be only oppressed and crushed always:

oppressed and hath [18 JOB 20 19](#) # Because he hath oppressed [and] hath forsaken the poor; [because] he hath violently taken away an house which he builded not;

oppressed and he [23 ISA 53 07](#) # He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

oppressed and smote [44 ACT 07 24](#) # And seeing one [of them] suffer wrong, he defended [him], and avenged him that was oppressed, and smote the Egyptian:

oppressed and spoiled [05 DEU 28 29](#) # And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways: and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save [thee].

oppressed and they [21 ECC 04 01](#) # So I returned, and considered all the oppressions that are done under the sun: and behold the tears of [such as were] oppressed, and they had no comforter; and on the side of their oppressors [there was] power; but they had no comforter.

oppressed any but [26 EZE 18 07](#) # And hath not oppressed any, [but] hath restored to the debtor his pledge, hath spoiled none by violence, hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment;

oppressed any hath [26 EZE 18 16](#) # Neither hath oppressed any, hath not withholden the pledge, neither hath spoiled by violence, [but] hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment,

oppressed every one [23 ISA 03 05](#) # And the people shall be oppressed, every one by another, and every one by his neighbour: the child shall behave himself proudly against the ancient, and the base against the honourable.

oppressed go free [23 ISA 58 06](#) # [Is] not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?

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oppressed in the [30 AMO 03 09](#) # Publish in the palaces at Ashdod, and in the palaces in the land of Egypt, and say, Assemble yourselves upon the mountains of Samaria, and behold the great tumults in the midst thereof, and the oppressed in the midst thereof.

oppressed Israel all [12 2KI 13 22](#) # But Hazael king of Syria oppressed Israel all the days of Jehoahaz.

oppressed judge the [23 ISA 01 17](#) # Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow.

oppressed of the [44 ACT 10 38](#) # How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

oppressed or of [09 ISA 12 03](#) # Behold, here I [am]: witness against me before the LORD, and before his anointed: whose ox have I taken? or whose ass have I taken? or whom have I defrauded? whom have I oppressed? or of whose hand have I received [any] bribe to blind mine eyes therewith? and I will restore it you.

oppressed return ashamed [19 PSA 74 21](#) # O let not the oppressed return ashamed: let the poor and needy praise thy name.

oppressed some of [14 2CH 16 10](#) # Then Asa was wroth with the seer, and put him in a prison house; for [he was] in a rage with him because of this [thing]. And Asa oppressed [some] of the people the same time.

oppressed spoiled his [26 EZE 18 18](#) # [As for] his father, because he cruelly oppressed, spoiled his brother by violence, and did [that] which [is] not good among his people, lo, even he shall die in his iniquity.

oppressed that the [19 PSA 10 18](#) # To judge the fatherless and the oppressed, that the man of the earth may no more oppress.

oppressed the children [07 JUD 04 03](#) # And the children of Israel cried unto the LORD: for he had nine hundred chariots of iron; and twenty years he mightily oppressed the children of Israel.

oppressed the children [07 JUD 10 08](#) # And that year they vexed and oppressed the children of Israel: eighteen years, all the children of Israel that [were] on the other side Jordan in the land of the Amorites, which [is] in Gilead.

oppressed the poor [26 EZE 18 12](#) # Hath oppressed the poor and needy, hath spoiled by violence, hath not restored the pledge, and hath lifted up his eyes to the idols, hath committed abomination,

oppressed the stranger [26 EZE 22 29](#) # The people of the land have used oppression, and exercised robbery, and have vexed the poor and needy: yea, they have oppressed the stranger wrongfully.

oppressed them and [07 JUD 02 18](#) # And when the LORD raised them up judges, then the LORD was with the judge, and delivered them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge: for it repented the LORD because of their groanings by reason of them that oppressed them and vexed them.

oppressed them and [19 PSA 106 42](#) # Their enemies also oppressed them, and they were brought into subjection under their hand.

oppressed them without [23 ISA 52 04](#) # For thus saith the Lord GOD, My people went down aforetime into Egypt to sojourn there; and the Assyrian oppressed them without cause.

oppressed them [12 2KI 13 04](#) # And Jehoahaz besought the LORD, and the LORD hearkened unto him: for he saw the oppression of Israel, because the king of Syria oppressed them.

oppressed to cry [18 JOB 35 09](#) # By reason of the multitude of oppressions they make [the oppressed] to cry: they cry out by reason of the arm of the mighty.

oppressed together and [24 JER 50 33](#) # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The children of Israel and the children of Judah [were] oppressed together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go.

oppressed undertake for [23 ISA 38 14](#) # Like a crane [or] a swallow, so did I chatter: I did mourn as a dove: mine eyes fail [with looking] upward: O LORD, I am oppressed; undertake for me.

oppressed us neither [09 ISA 12 04](#) # And they said, Thou hast not defrauded us, nor oppressed us, neither hast thou taken ought of any man's hand.

oppressed virgin daughter [23 ISA 23 12](#) # And he said, Thou shalt no more rejoice, O thou oppressed virgin, daughter of Zidon: arise, pass over to Chittim; there also shalt thou have no rest.

oppressed which giveth [19 PSA 146 07](#) # Which executeth judgment for the oppressed: which giveth food to the hungry. The LORD looseth the prisoners:

oppressed you and [07 JUD 06 09](#) # And I delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out of the hand of all that oppressed you, and drave them out from before you, and gave you their land;

oppressed you [09 ISA 10 18](#) # And said unto the children of Israel, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I brought up Israel out of Egypt, and delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out of the hand of all kingdoms, [and] of them that oppressed you:

oppressed [19 PSA 103 06](#) # The LORD executeth righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed.
