overtook her between <u>25_LAM_01_03</u># Judah is gone into captivity because of affliction, and because of great servitude: she dwelleth among the heathen, she findeth no rest: all her persecutors overtook her between the straits.

overtook him in 12 2KI 25 05 # And the army of the Chaldees pursued after the king, and overtook him in the plains of Jericho: and all his army were scattered from him.

overtook him in <u>01_GEN_31_23</u># And he took his brethren with him, and pursued after him seven days' journey; and they overtook him in the mount Gilead.

overtook Jacob Now <u>01_GEN_31_25</u># Then Laban overtook Jacob. Now Jacob had pitched his tent in the mount: and Laban with his brethren pitched in the mount of Gilead.

overtook the children <u>07_JUD_18_22</u> # [And] when they were a good way from the house of Micah, the men that [were] in the houses near to Micah's house were gathered together, and overtook the children of Dan.

overtook them and 01_GEN_44_06 # And he overtook them, and he spake unto them these same words.

overtook them and <u>07_JUD_20_42</u># Therefore they turned [their backs] before the men of Israel unto the way of the wilderness; but the battle overtook them; and them which [came] out of the cities they destroyed in the midst of them.

overtook them encamping <u>02 EXO 14 09</u> # But the Egyptians pursued after them, all the horses [and] chariots of Pharaoh, and his horsemen, and his army, and overtook them encamping by the sea, beside Pihahiroth, before Baalzephon.

overtook Zedekiah in <u>24_JER_39_05</u># But the Chaldeans' army pursued after them, and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho: and when they had taken him, they brought him up to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon to Riblah in the land of Hamath, where he gave judgment upon him.

overtook Zedekiah in 24_JER_52_08 # But the army of the Chaldeans pursued after the king, and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho; and all his army was scattered from him.
