quiver hath he [23 ISA 49 02](#) # And he hath made my mouth like a sharp sword; in the shadow of his hand hath he hid me, and made me a polished shaft; in his quiver hath he hid me;

quiver is as [24 JER 05 16](#) # Their quiver [is] as an open sepulchre, they [are] all mighty men.
