

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Akrabbim and pass <u>04\_NUM\_34\_04</u> # And your border shall turn from the south to the ascent of Akrabbim, and pass on to Zin: and the going forth thereof shall be from the south to Kadeshbarnea, and shall go on to Hazaraddar, and pass on to Azmon:

Akrabbim from the <u>07\_JUD\_01\_36</u> # And the coast of the Amorites [was] from the going up to Akrabbim, from the rock, and upward.

Bathrabbim thy nose <u>22\_SON\_07\_04</u> # Thy neck [is] as a tower of ivory; thine eyes [like] the fishpools in Heshbon, by the gate of Bathrabbim: thy nose [is] as the tower of Lebanon which looketh toward Damascus.

Maalehacrabbim and passed <u>06\_JOS\_15\_03</u> # And it went out to the south side to Maalehacrabbim, and passed along to Zin, and ascended up on the south side unto Kadeshbarnea, and passed along to Hezron, and went up to Adar, and fetched a compass to Karkaa:
